## REVENUE NOTICES.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent for the Western Province will receive sealed tenders for the purchase of the under-mentioned Arrack Rents of the Western Province from July 1, 1895, to June 30, 1896 :-

1. Of the Four Gravets of Colombo (Fort excepted).
2. Of Lansiyawatta, including Wattala, Peliyagoda, and Ambatelenpahala.
3. Of Salpiti korale.
4. Of Siyane and Hewagam korales.
5. Of Negombo, Dunagaha, Ragam and Dasiya pattus of Alutkuru korale, and Hapitigam korale.
The tenders, which must be in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tender for Arrack Rents," should be handed to the Government Agent at the Colombo Kachchéri before 12 o'clock noon on Saturday, June 8, 1895, when any person making a tender should be present or should satisfy the Government Agent by some duly accredited agent that the tender made by him is made bonâ fide.

The person whose tender is selected by the Government Agent for submission to the Governor will be required to deposit at once one-tenth of the purchase amount in cash; and should the tender be accepted by His Excellency the Governor, to furnish approved security for one-half of the whole purchase amount, or in cash for one-third of the whole purchase amount, within thirty days of the date of the recejpt by him of the notification of the Governor's acceptance of his offer.

He will also be required to deposit money to pay the fees of the Crown Counsel for examining and giving his opinion on the title deeds of properties tendered by him as security, and for examining and settling the security bond, and the fees charged by the Crown Proctor for examining documents and drawing the security bond, and also the expenses of appraising the properties and of registering the security bond.
All title deeds tendered as security should be accompanied by a certificate obtained from the Registrar of Lands that the lands to which they relate are unencumbered. This certificate must be obiained at the cost of the party offering the security.
And notice is hereby further given that the purchaser of the arrack rent of the Four Gravets of Colombo (Fort excepted) will be required to pay, in terms of the provisions of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1892, a stamp duty of Rs. 500 for each and every license issued under the Ordinance No. 13 of 1891 to sell by retail arrack and rum at each and every tavern situated within the limits of the Municipality of Colombo ; and that the licenses for distillation of arrack and rum may be issued for 1896 from January 1 to December 31 of that year if the Government Agent sees fit.

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WITH reference to the foregoing notice，it is hereby notified that on Monday，June 10，1895，the Government Agent of the Western Province will put up far sale by public auction，at the Colombo Kachcheri，at 12 o＇clock noon，those rents tenders for which have not been received and accepted on or before 12 o＇clock noon on June 8，as called for by the notice referred to above．
The purchaser will be required to deposit on the day of sale one－tenth of the purchase amount in cash；and
should the offer be accepted by His Excellency the Governor，to furnish approved security for one－half of the whole purchase amount，or in cash for one－third of the whole purchase amount，within thirty days of the date of the receipt by him of the notification of the Governor＇s acceptance of his offer．
He will also be required to deposit money to pay the fees of the Crown Counsel for examining and giving his opinion on the title deeds of properties tendered by him as security，and for examining and settling the security bond，and the fees charged by the Crown Proctor for examining the documents and drawing the security bond， and also the expenses of appraising the properties and of registering the secnrity bond．
