## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on December 17, 1894.

*Present:*—E. Elliott, Esq., Chairman; R. L. Symes, Esq.; Wm. Abeyasundera, Esq.; C. P. Hayley, Esq.; Hon. P. Anthonisz; D. G. Goonewardena, Esq.; H. E. H. Hayes, Esq.; Dr. J. Attygalle; and N. Dias Abayesinha, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on November 17 last.

2. Pursuant to notice Mr. D. G. Goonewardena asked "Why the Council paid the Committee of the Galle Volunteer and Public Band the usual monthly payment when the band did not play for the benefit of the public since the services of the late Bandmaster Venigo were dispensed with?"

The Chairman expressed his inability to give any information.

The Member for the Galupiyadde Ward stated that he was informed by the Secretary of the Band Committee in a letter he held in his hands, and which he read to the Council, that the band did play to the public on some occasions.

3. By leave of Council Mr. D. G. Goonewardena withdrew the motion notice of which he had given, and substituted the following: "That the Secretary of the Band Committee be written to for information as to the prospects of the band being able to serve the public, and as to how often the band played in public since September 1 last, and that the payment for the month of December be deferred until this information be received."

Seconded by Mr. N. Dias Abayesinha.—Carried by 5 against 3.

4. Submitted letter No. 33 of November 27, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, forwarding for any observations the Council may desire to offer copy of a report by the Special Committee of the Ceylon National Association on the proposed amendments of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance.

Resolved,—That the report, with the remarks made thereon by the Councillors, be referred to the Standing Committee to frame a reply.

5. Read a letter No. 34 of December 5, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, intimating, in regard to the drainage of the Police Station grounds, that the Government is prepared to pay half the cost of the general drainage works proposed by the Council.

6. Submitted an application from the Chetty merchants residing at Kaluwella for additional lights opposite the kittingies and in Ward street Bazaar, with a recommendation by the Councillor of the Ward.

Resolved,—That the Council is prepared to provide two lamps if the Chetties will give a written guarantee that they will bear the cost of lighting them.

7. Submitted the following reports:—Auditor's Report for November, 1894; Report on Permanent Repair of Roads in November, 1894; Report on General upkeep of Roads in November, 1894; Report on Progress of Works in November, 1894.

Ordered that the reports be circulated.

8. Submitted accounts for November, 1894.

9. Submitted report of the guardian of the Bikke reservoir reporting it to be full.

Resolved,—That no action be taken until the result of the analysis of the water be received from the Analyst to the Colombo Municipality.

(a) Metalled 258½ lines and gravelled 425 lines of road.

(b) Repaired superficially 1,874 squares of road; trimmed sides 211 lines; cleared side drains 720 lines; and filled ruts and holes in Old Gate road, New Gate road, Ward street, Sea street, Kitulanpitiya road, Circular road, and Hirimbure road.

(c) Repaired bridges at Miliduwe, Attoya, Herimbure cross road, Hume road, Kepu-ela, and Bope; supplied eight iron rails for foot-bridge in Victoria Park.

(d) Built two scavenging carts and one smallpox cart.

(e) Repaired two scavenging carts, six water carts, six iron hand carts, one wooden hand cart, and one latrine cart.

(f) Repaired slaughter-house, bathing wells, cattle-pound shed, Fort market, Kaluwella latrine, meat market, Balcony latrine, betel shed near Old Gate, and fish auction shed.

(g) Built a sewer in Pedlar street; cleared side drains; repaired drain in Great Moderbay street; built new side drains in Parava and Chando streets; repaired side drains in Rampart road.

(h) Repaired esplanade drain; building a groin at the mouth of the Pettigalla-ela.

(j) Embanked Parana-ela and made a road over the reclaimed ground; used 1,700 coconut stakes; cleared Kepu-ela; underpinning canal wall.

(k) Built a cart shed at Cotton Garden, two refreshment sheds at Havelock place, and one opposite the Police Court; set broken glass on Park wall; repaired railings near New Gate; cleared Fort sewers; formed a carriage stand opposite the Railway street; repaired clock tower; painted garden seats.

(l) Repaired and improved Fort market.

(m) Supplied iron gratings to arches over doors and windows, bolts to doors, a screen across the room, and railings to outer verandah.

(n) Repairing sea-bathing place near Eolus Bastion and at Victoria park.
