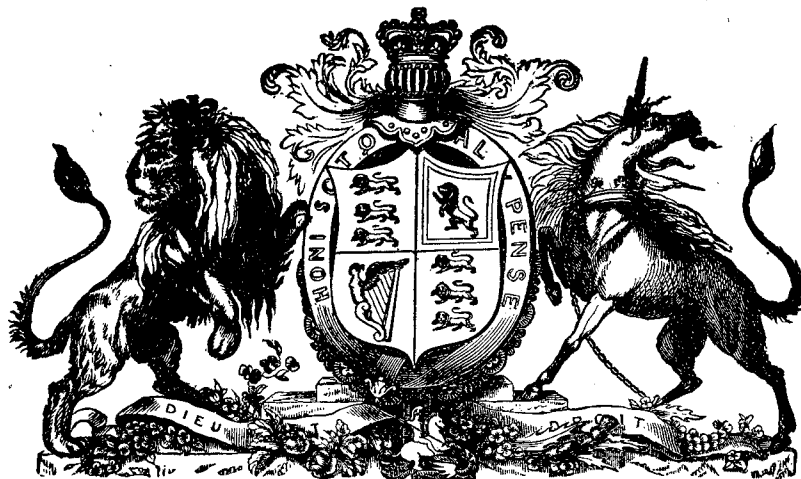

MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, November 16, 1894, at 3 p.m.

The Council met this day at 3 p.m., pursuant to notice dated November 10, 1894.

Present :—Mr. C. E. D. Pennycuik, Mayor and Chairman; Dr. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Captain F. Bayley; Mr. M. Finlay; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of October 12, 1894, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of October 12, 1894, be confirmed.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy presented a petition dated November 16, 1894, from I. L. Marikar Hadjar Noordin Hadjar, of New Moor street, with reference to the inconvenience caused by the want of water service to his house, and a letter dated October 10, 1894, from certain Hindu residents of Colombo, with reference to an additional cremation ground; and gave notice that he would move at the next Meeting of Council that the petition and letter be considered.

1. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to October 31, 1894, and a Progress Report of Work done during October, 1894, were laid on the table.

2. The following recommendations from the Standing Committee of October 26 and November 2, 1894, were laid before the Council :—

Resolved that a further sum of Rs. 1,000 be transferred from vote No. 59 in Budget for 1894 (Rs. 4,000, expenses of disinfection), from which these charges should be met.

November 2.

(6) To provide for metalling Armour street by transferring under section 114 of Ordinance 7 of 1887 a sum of Rs. 600 from estimate No. 83 to No. 82.

Estimate sanctioned. The Committee recommend the transfer under clause 114 of Ordinance 7 of 1887 of Rs. 600 from item No. 83 of Budget for 1894, "Salaries of Overseers" to 82, "Road Repairs."

Resolved,—That the foregoing recommendations of October 26, and November 2, 1894, be adopted.

3. A letter No. 152 of October 10, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, about the duplicate water main, together with a memorandum dated October 22, 1894, from the Chairman on the subject, was laid before the Council.

Mr. Alvis moved "That in reply to the inquiry made in Colonial Secretary's letter No. 152 of October 10 last (paragraph 2), this Council begs to state that it is unable at present to decide as to the amount of the annual contribution it could afford till, among other questions, an answer be given to the Chairman's inquiry referred to in the resolution of Council of July 14, 1893, in his letter of July 15, 1893."

Mr. C. M. Fernando seconded.

Mr. C. Perera moved as an amendment the appointment of a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman Dr. W. R. Kynsey, Captain F. Bayley, Hon. Sir J. J. Grinlinton, Mr. M. Finlay, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. C. M. Fernando, Mr. A. Alwis, and Mr. R. H. Morgan to report on the above question to the Council—five Members to form a quorum

Hon. P. Coomarswamy seconded.

The original motion was, by leave of Council, withdrawn, and Mr. C. Perera's amendment was carried.

4. A letter dated October 9, 1894, from Mr. J. F. Brunton, submitting for approval tracings of section of rail for tramways, was laid before the Council after previous circulation amongst members.

Resolved,—That the pattern of rail submitted be approved.

5. A letter No. 151 of October 9, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, forwarding report by the Attorney-General on the proposed by-laws relating to burial and cremation grounds, was laid before the Council after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the following be substituted for by-laws 2, 3, and 4, under clause 5 of Ordinance No. 2 of 1894, adopted on July 13, 1894:—

(2) The proprietor, trustee, or other person entitled to the possession of a burial or cremation ground shall apply in writing to the Chairman of the Municipal Council to have the same registered as such, stating the name of the keeper, if any, of the ground, and annexing to his application a figure of survey of the premises certified by the Surveyor-General or a duly licensed surveyor. And the person named as keeper in such application shall subscribe the same, in acknowledgment of his acceptance of the office and duties of such keeper.

(3) If no keeper be named, or if the keeper so named shall not have signed the application in manner aforesaid, then and in either of such cases the person on whose application registration of a burial or cremation ground is made shall be held to be the keeper of that ground, and to be responsible for any breach of regulations.

(4) In the event of the death or inability from any cause to fulfil his duties of the keeper of a burial or cremation ground, fresh registration of such ground shall be required, and no burial or cremation shall take place in such ground until such fresh registration has been effected, except on the special license of the Chairman of the Municipal Council, or in his absence, of the Assistant Chairman or the Sanitary Officer of the Municipality.

6. A letter No. 155 of October 16, 1894, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, proposing to set forward the boundary wall of Queen's House was laid before the Council after previous circulation.

Resolved,—That the Council have no objection to the proposed alteration.

7. Three tenders for the lease of the fish market, St. John's Road, for 1895, were laid before the Council, and a memorial dated October 18, 1894, from the present lessees (Albert Holmes and Sarangey Pauloe Appuhamy) praying to be allowed the continuance of the lease for 1895 on the same terms as at present.

Resolved,—That the application of the present lessees be acceded to.

8. Eight tenders for the lease of the Edinburgh vegetable market for 1895 were laid before the Council.

The highest tenderer (Rs. 3,024) having failed to furnish the required security, resolved that the next highest tender (Rs. 3,012), that of S. L. M. Usoof Lebbe Marikar, be accepted.

9. Twelve tenders for the lease of the boutiques in St. John's road were laid before the Council.
