## ROAD COMMITTEE NOTICES.

NOTICE is hereby given that an application having been made to the Provincial Road Committee, that the provisions of "The Branch Roads Ordinance, 1874," be extended to the Rattota-Laggala division of the Matale East District for the construction of a branch road to connect the Government cart road at Rattota, a distance of about five miles.

The Provincial Road Committee will on Thursday, May 16, 1895, at 2 o'clock P.M., at their office in Kandy, proceed to define the limits of the district the estates in which will, if the proposal for the construction of the said branch road be assented to by the proprietors of two-thirds of the acreage in the said district, be assessed for the construction and maintenance of the said road.
