#### MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

OTICE is hereby given that the Municipal Council of Galle, acting under the authority of section 127 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, have made and assessed, with the sanction of the Governor in Executive Council, the following rates for the year 1900:-

A rate of 5 per centum on the annual value of all houses, buildings, lands, and tenements within the police limits of the Municipality of Galle, for the maintenance of the police.
 A rate of 2 per centum on the annual value of all houses, buildings, lands, and tenements within the police limits of the Municipality of Galle, for the lighting of the public streets, places, and buildings.
