MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on March 10, 1900, at 1.30 p.m.

Present:—The Chairman; Dr. W. G. Keith; E. Venning, Esq.; C. L. M. Abdul Carim, Esq.; Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G.; N. Dias Abeyesinghe, Esq.; D. G. Goonewardene, Esq.; Dr. E. Ludovici; and F. Abeyesundere, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on February 10, 1900.

2. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Ludovici moved—That a return be furnished to the Council showing (1) the amount of tax recovered for police purposes in each ward; and (2) the expenditure in each ward for maintenance of police. Seconded by Mr. D. G. Goonewardene—Carried.

The Chairman laid on the table a statement showing the amount of police assessment recoverable in each ward of the Municipality, and promised to procure from the Police Department the information asked for in the second part of the motion.

3. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Anthonisz moved—That a steam roller be obtained from England for the construction of the Municipal roads instead of the rollers now in use drawn by cattle.

Seconded by Dr. E. Ludovici.

The Chairman moved as an amendment—That a report be obtained from an engineer whether the bridges and culverts within the Municipality are capable of carrying a steam roller, and whether the saving in cost would be such as to justify the expenditure.

Seconded by Mr. C. L. M. Abdul Carim.

The amendment was put to the vote and carried by 7 against 2.

MUNICIPALITY OF KANDY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall, Kandy, on Saturday, March 17, 1900, at 8.30 o'clock a.m., in accordance with Notice dated March 12, 1900.

Present :—The Hon. Mr. H. Wace, Chairman; J. H. Sproule, Esq.; E. Beven, Esq.; W. D. Gibbon, Esq.; C. Vanderwall, Esq.; R. W. Jonklaas, Esq.; C. M. Fernando, Esq.; L. Creasy, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on February 17 were read, confirmed, and signed by the Chairman.

2. The following documents were submitted :—Statements of Receipts and Expenditure from close of 1899 to February 28, 1900, on account of the Municipal Fund, comprising the (No. 1) General Revenue, (No. 2) Consolidated Rate (Police and Lighting), and (No. 3) Water-rate Accounts; Progress Report of Works done brought up to the same date; Health Officer's Report for and Statement of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of February; Auditor's Report not received.

Resolved,—That the several statements, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, and the Health Officer's Report, be forwarded to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

Resolved,—That Auditor be requested to send in his report monthly in future.

3. The following papers were laid on the table :—

(a) Reports by the several Inspectors on laundries inspected during February, and register.

4. The following correspondence was submitted and read :—

(a) Letter No. 6 dated February 19, from the Colonial Secretary, intimating that the Governor in Executive Council has confirmed the amendment of by-law 20, chapter XII., Ordinance No. 19 of 1896.

(b) Letter No. 7 dated February 20, from the Colonial Secretary, stating that the Governor in Executive Council has sanctioned the levy, during 1900, of a rate of 5 per cent. to meet cost of police and lighting.

(c) Letter No. 8 dated March 6, from the Colonial Secretary, stating, in reply to Chairman's letter, that the Director of Public Works reports that the drainage scheme of Kandy has not advanced, and that he is awaiting certain information regarding the practical treatment of sludge.

(d) Letter No. 9 dated March 9, from the Colonial Secretary, respecting date from which amended by-law 20, chapter XII., should take effect.

Resolved,—That the by-law should take effect from April 1.

(e) Memorandum dated March 15, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding copy of a letter of same date to Mr. L. Creasy, intimating his nomination as a Member of the Municipal Council *vice* Mr. W. Pole Fletcher, resigned.

(f) Letter No. 17 dated February 20, from the Government Agent, forwarding a sum of Rs. 500-28, amount recovered by the Board of Health for the sanitary improvement of Katugastota.

(g) Letter No. 2,591 dated February 26, from the Superintendent of Police, in reply to Secretary's letter No. 247 of 21st ultimo respecting the re-arrangement of beats.

5. Question by Mr. C. M. Fernando, in accordance with notice—When it is likely that the Chairman's Administration Report for last year will be laid before the Council?

Reply—As soon as possible.

6. The following question was put by Mr. E. Beven, in accordance with notice—What the number of the clerks on the strength of the Establishment is; whether the offices they hold were created by the Council; and whether the Council has authorized the payment of their salary?

The Chairman submitted list of members of the office Establishment for whom provision had been made in the Budget. Provision had been made for pension to Mr. Weerasinghe, but his term of service had been prolonged by a recent resolution of the Council.

Resolved,—That the matter be referred to the Standing Committee.

7. Report by the Special Committee appointed on June 20 to consider the petition from some of the rate-payers relating to the water question and the installation of meters.

Resolved,—That the report, with connected papers, be circulated and considered at the next Meeting.

8. List of premises on which there has been consumption of water in excess of allowance was submitted.

Resolved,—That consideration of the same stand over for the next Meeting.

9. Considered recommendation by the Health Officer that the cesspit on premises No. 27, Hill street, be closed on sanitary grounds, and that a dry-earth closet be substituted.

Resolved,—That special authority be granted to the Chairman, in accordance with section 209 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, as amended by section 33 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896, to require the owner or occupant of premises No. 27, Hill street, to empty and close the cesspit on the said premises and to substitute a dry-earth closet therefor.

10. Read letter No. 19/14936 of March 9, from the Hon. the Government Agent, forwarding copy of letter dated January 22, from the Secretary, Planters' Association of Ceylon, applying for the right to conserve and make use of the piece of ground in Ward street, situated between the Club and the Jubilee Commemoration Buildings.

Resolved,—That the use of the ground be allowed on the following conditions :—

- (1) That no buildings be erected upon it.
- (2) That the land be fenced in.
- (3) That the land be ornamentally laid out.

11. There being a vacancy on the Standing Committee, in consequence of the resignation of Mr. W. Pole Fletcher, it was unanimously resolved that Mr. L. Creasy be elected a Member of the Standing Committee *vice* Mr. Pole Fletcher, resigned.

12. There being a vacancy for the same reason on the Special Committee appointed on January 20 to consider questions connected with the water supply, it was resolved that Mr. L. Creasy be elected a Member of the Special Committee *vice* Mr. Pole Fletcher.

13. On motion proposed by Mr. Fernando, in accordance with notice, seconded by Mr. Beven, it was resolved that as far as possible lake water be used for the purpose of watering streets in the town.

14. In pursuance of notice Mr. Fernando moved, seconded by Mr. Beven, "that a detailed statement of estimate No. 2 in Schedule A of the Budget (Kandy town streets) be circulated among the Members."

The estimate was submitted. The Chairman said that the estimate having been approved of by the Standing Committee, and been available at the Municipal Office for inspection of Members, there was no necessity for its circulation.

The motion was withdrawn.

Health Officer's Report for February, 1900.

SIR,—I HAVE the honour to submit my report for the month of February.

Scavenging.—The scavenging of the town was satisfactorily carried out.*Drainage.*—The surface drains, both paved and unpaved, were clean and well kept. The deeper barrel drains were frequently flushed and kept as clean as possible. I may add, all the same, that all the drains within the Municipality are in an unsatisfactory condition owing to defective construction.*Market.*—Clean and well kept, with the exception of the vegetable stalls, which require reconstruction. The food stuffs exposed for sale in the market were of good quality. During the month 435 head of cattle, 74 buffaloes, and 337 sheep and goats were slaughtered. The above were all inspected by me and passed as fit for human food.*Bakeries.*—Clean and well kept.*Dairies.*—In good order.*Laundries.*—All in good order, with the exception of those at Trincomalee street and Peradeniya road.*Latrines.*—Clean and well kept.*Alleys.*—Most of the alleys are in a very unsatisfactory and insanitary condition. Every effort is being made to keep them clean, but no improvement can be expected till they are taken in hand one by one, broken up, and rebuilt.*Slaughter House and Exposing Shed.*—Clean and in order.*Water Supply.*—Good and sufficient.*Cooly Lines.*—The permanent ones are in a satisfactory condition. The temporary ones, such as those at Bogambra, railway approach road, and Mahaiyawa, are in an unsatisfactory condition. These should be substituted by permanent buildings affording more ventilation and accommodation.*Filthy Premises.*—Eighty-seven cases were instituted against persons for keeping filthy premises, most of whom were fined.*Public Health.*—The health of the town during the month under review was exceptionally good.
