DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

> An Ordinance for making provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1894.

W HEREAS by Ordinance No. 13 of 1893 it was enacted that a sum not exceeding Thirteen million Three hundred and forty-six thousand Three hundred and eighty-one rupees should be charged upon the revenue of this Island for the Contingent Service of the year One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-four, and it has become necessary to make further provision for the service of the said year: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :--

1 That a sum not exceeding One million Seven hundred and Two thousand Six hundred and fifty-one rupees and fifty-two cents shall be, and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this Island for the services hereinafter mentioned; and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the details of the

Treasurer to pay the above at such times as the Governor by warrant shall order.

And to receive credit in his accounts for the payments made in pursuance thereof. 2 The Treasurer of the said Island shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the revenues of the said Island.

3 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.
