MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, April 5, 1895.

Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated March 30, 1895.

Present:—Mr. C. E. D. Pennycuik, Mayor and Chairman; Dr. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Hon. A. de Seneviratna, Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Walter Pereira; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of March 8, 1895, having been printed and a copy sent to each member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of March 8, 1895, be confirmed.

1. (a) Pursuant to notice, the Chairman laid on the table papers relating to incineration, and moved for the appointment of a Special Committee to consider the subject and report to the Council.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried unanimously.

Resolved that a Special Committee be appointed as above proposed, consisting of the Chairman (or Acting Chairman), Dr. Kynsey (or any Medical Officer nominated by Government in his place), Captain F. Bayley, Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna, Mr. C. Perera, and Mr. C. P. Dias—three Members to form a quorum.

(b) Pursuant to notice, the Chairman moved "that the horse allowance, which is at present personal to himself during his tenure of office, be given to his *locum tenens* during the absence of the Chairman on leave."

Dr. W. R. Kynsey seconded.—Carried.

2. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera moved "that Government be requested to furnish a return of the quantity of water supplied during 1894, showing separately the quantities supplied for the following purposes:—

- (1) For (a) Government buildings; (b) Railway; (c) Government gardens, &c.
- (2) For the military.
- (3) For public buildings and gardens in charge of the Municipality.
- (4) For the shipping.
- (5) For private gardens.
- (6) For trade purposes.
- (7) For horses, carriages kept for hire.
- (8) Other meter supplies.
- (9) Supplies without meter (approximate quantity).
- (10) For the gratuitous use of the inhabitants of the Municipality for domestic purposes."

Mr. Alvis seconded.—Carried.

3. A Supplemental Budget approved by the Standing Committee on March 22, 1895, was laid before the Council.

The Chairman proposed the addition of the following items:—

Rs. 800 on account of the 15-ton steam roller, for which the provision already made in the Budget was found insufficient; Rs. 60 on account of a level planimeter for the Superintendent of Works, for the same reason; and Rs. 60, for refunds of rents.

Mr. Alvis moved the adoption of the Supplemental Budget with the foregoing additions.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

4. A statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to March 31, 1895, was laid on the table.

A memorandum, No. 227 of March 29, 1895, from the Superintendent of Works, explaining why the Progress Report could not be submitted, was laid before the Council.

5. The Administration Report of the Chairman for 1894 was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the Report be referred to a Special Committee, consisting of Dr. Kynsey (or his successor), Captain F. Bailey, Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna, Mr. C. P. Dias, Mr. A. Alvis, Hon. P. Coomaraswamy, and Mr. C. Perera—three Members to form a quorum.

Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna seconded.—Carried.

6. A letter dated March 2, 1895, from Messrs. Boustead Brothers was laid before the Council, submitting a proposal for lighting the Fort with electricity, with connected papers including a letter No. 24/18 of April 2, 1895, from the Manager, Gas Company, on the subject of incandescent gas lamps.

Mr. Alvis moved "that Messrs. Boustead Brothers be requested to submit a scheme and estimate for utilizing the present gas lamps in the Fort of Colombo for electric lighting, each lamp to be of about 150 candle power."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved as an amendment (a) that Messrs. Boustead Brothers be informed that the Council is not prepared at present to accept their proposal; (b) that the papers and those on the question of incandescent gas lamps be referred to the Standing Committee.

Dr. Kynsey seconded.

Whereupon the amendment was carried.

7. A letter No. 1,727 of March 18, 1895, from Mr. S. J. Drieberg, Additional Municipal Magistrate, applying for six weeks' leave of absence, was laid before the Council, and a subsequent letter withdrawing the application, Mr. Drieberg having been appointed to act as District Judge of Ratnapura.

A letter No. 29 of April 4, 1895, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary was also laid before the Council, intimating the appointment of Mr. Peter de Saram to act temporarily as Additional Municipal Magistrate.

Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna moved "that the Council desire to record its appreciation of the good work done for it by Mr. Drieberg as Municipal Magistrate.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

8. A letter dated March 22, 1895, from Mr. H. J. Nichols, was laid before the Council, requesting to be allowed to liquidate his debt to the Council by payments of Rs. 5 instead of Rs. 10 per mensem.

Resolved,—That the application be allowed.

9. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for November and December, 1894, received with letters Nos. 13 and 18 of March 13 and 26, 1895, were laid on the table.

10. A further remark by the Auditor-General on the accounts for April, 1894, requiring the authority of the Council for charging the pay of a cooly on estimate No. 90 of 1894 to an item provided in the estimate for "Manure, Cabook earth, &c.," was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the charge be authorized.

11. The City Analyst's report dated April 2, 1895, on the town water for March, 1895, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

12. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for April, 1895, were laid on the table.

13. A letter dated March 29, 1895, from Messrs. Julius & Creasy, enclosing a medical certificate relating to Mr. E. D. Mathews, and asking for an extension of six months' time for beginning work on the tramway agreement, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that Mr. Mathews be allowed an extension of three months' time, as suggested by the Chairman, but that it be understood that this is absolutely final.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.
