MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance No. 29 of 1884, intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Kandy Waterworks Loan Ordinance, 1884."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinance No. 29 of 1884, intituled "An Ordinance to amend 'The Kandy Waterworks Loan Ordinance, 1884'": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:

Ordinance to be read as one with Ordinance No. 18 of 1884 and Ordinance No. 29 of 1884. 1 This Ordinance, so far as is consistent with the tenour thereof, shall be read and construed as one with "The Kandy Waterworks Loan Ordinance, 1884," and the Ordinance No. 29 of 1884.

Amendment of schedule to Ordinance No. 29 of 1884. 2 From and after the passing of this Ordinance, the southern limit of the municipality of Kandy, as set forth and defined in the schedule to the said Ordinance No. 29 of 1884, shall be repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be inserted the words following; that is to say:

"The limits of the municipality as fixed by the Proclamation of March 27, 1877, up to the crossing over the railway of the path to Falmouth Lodge (now known as Wilhelm's Ruhe)";

and such schedule is hereby amended accordingly.
