Centenary of our Alma Mater

I am pleased to write a few words for inclusion in the souvenir, we are bringing out, on the occasion of our centenary celebrations in the U.K. Our Alma Mater has been steadily growing through these hundred years and now occupies a proud place as one of the leading educational institutions of the country. At the time the school was founded the purpose was to serve as a feeder school to the premier Hindu educational institution in the north, viz Jaffna Hindu College. Education in the English Medium was then much sought after and our school satisfactorily served the community in Kokuvil and its surrounding villages. The founder principle late Mr. Chelliah and his carefully hand-picked assistant teachers like late Mr. N. Chellappa made vital contributions to the early success of the school.

For nearly forty years, our school had been functioning on the southern side of the temple and in that confined space, though the student population was growing all the time, the school despite all the efforts of the heads of the school, teachers' students and well wishes could not make much headway in terms of providing additional accommodations and equipments.

It is with a sense of great pride and privilege that we welcome all of you to the Kokuvil Hindu College Centenary Celebration in the United Kingdom. For the last 18 years many distinguished old students adopted this role and we thank the executive committee for honouring us to be the Chief Guest for this important historical event. We wish the United Kingdom committee to continue to help the Alma Maters as they have been doing for the last 18 years. Also we must thank each and every one of you for coming to our OSA's event to support KHCOSA, which meant we were able to carry out various valuable projects for our school.

A hundred years of remarkable growth:

A small English School, founded in 1910, has, over these hundred years has grown into one of the finest educational institutions of the country. She has a sprawling campus with high-rise buildings, well-equipped laboratories, a state of the art Learning Centre and an extended playground. She excels in studies and sports. Neither the founder of the school, Late Mr C. Chelliah, nor those who closely associated with him in that noble venture, would have foreseen this tremendous success.

Distinguished Principals, dedicated teachers, old students and well-wishers have all laboured selflessly and tirelessly to help the school attain this enviable status. Their contributions have all been well documented, on a number of occasions, in publications, brought out by the school and our old students' associations. The school has also expressed her gratitude to these great people by honouring them with buildings etc named after them. Meritorious services of a number of teachers have been recognised and rewarded at functions, organised and held in their honour.

For the first thirty years, the school, carefully nurtured first by the founder Principal Late Mr C. Chelliah and later by the principal Mr C. Karthigesu, grew slowly but steadily, ceased to be a feeder – school and finally she got raised to the status of a college.

What happened in the forties completely transformed the school. With the introduction of Free Education in 1945, there had been an influx of new admissions of students, most of them drawn from the poor homes of the local community. The school had to find accommodation, recruit fresh teachers and provide the necessary facilities. The appointment of a new Principal, late Mr V. Nagalingam, came at an apt moment. An inspiring leader, a popular educationist with a great vision, he was solely responsible for the accelerated all—round development that took place in the forties. As a student then, I watched, with considerable interest, all that unfolded there, so rapidly within the few years, he was at the helm. He organised fundraising activities, put up new buildings, furnished them and most importantly, acquired a large piece of land for the school playground and for the future extension of the school. He also recruited excellent talented teachers, who with the already serving dedicated teachers, helped raise the academic standard of the school. In return for his services, the school was soon recognised as a grade I school.

I would like to pay tribute to the teachers of my time. Although it would be invidious to mention names, I cannot resist my desire to recall a few names. Late Mr N. Chellappah, a founder teacher, had few equals as an excellent numeracy teacher, while Late Mr S.C.Thillainathan was held in high respect as a teacher of the written and spoken English language. A trio of ladies, Late Mrs P.P.Bhargavathiammah, Late Mrs G.Perumalpillai (nee Gnanambikai) and Mrs S.Supramaniam (nee Suhirthalaxshmi) were popular teachers of English and were also responsible for guiding the students in their reading habit. As science and mathematics teachers, Late Mr C.K.Kanthaswami and Late Mr E.Sabalingam were both held in high esteem. The Principals Late Mr V. Nagalingam and Late Mr S.H.Perinpanayagam were both veteran English teachers and all those who had the good fortune to learn under them, benefited greatly and they still cherish memories of their learning experience.

From the fifties to this day, notwithstanding the unexpected setbacks viz. arson attack and the dropping of shells, the school has relentlessly grown, reaping success after success. The hundredth year was celebrated over three days on a grand scale in July. The Principal, Mr A. Ahiladas, has implemented regeneration, redecoration, refurbishment and other related activities to give the school a fresh look, she richly deserved. The Principal expresses his sincere thanks to us all students for all our contributions so far and exhorts us to redouble our efforts to cooperate with him in his efforts to make the school step into the next century with renewed vigour and prosper as a premier institution.

We wish our Alma Mater another century of progress.

Our Chief Guests Mr K and Mrs B Kanthapillai

Mr K Kanthapillai had been at our Alma Mater for twenty five years back at home. From the early forties to the late sixties, a period considered the most important in the history of the school, presided over by three distinguished principals, served by hardworking dedicated well qualified teachers. The school recorded unprecedented growth achieving successes in both sports and studies. Mr K. Kanthapillai pays glowing tributes to Principal V. Nagalingam under whom he learnt English. He also has the greatest



respect for Mr S H Perinpalaayakam, his teacher and mentor. He has received help and guidance from Mr C K Kanthaswami, his mathematics teacher and has cherished memories of his conversation with him. He remembers with gratitude the guidance he received from Mr E Sabalingam who helped him to do well in mathematics. No wonder that with such great teachers taking lessons for him Kanthapillai achieved great success in the SSC in 1949. K Kanthapillai soon sought a short route to achieve a degree and sought guidance from the then Principal Mr S H Perinpanayagam. He went to Jaffna College, finished his Inter Arts in one year and got back to Kokuvil to teach and while teaching pursued his studies and attained his BA.

Teaching was a job much after his heart. He loved his students, loved the company of his fellow teachers and above all the guidance of his revered Gurus- the Principals. He was often entrusted with teaching mathematics and he accomplished the task well. In 1960, when Kanthapillai sought mutual transfer and left the school, the Principal gently rebuked him and such was his attachment he had for him, he brought him back. Kanthapillai went to Peradeniya to do his Diploma in Education, successfully completed it but to his dismay was transferred elsewhere.

Thanks to his former teacher, guide and mentor Mr E Sabalingam, he soon found a comfortable berth at Jaffna Hindu College. From Jaffna Hindu, he went abroad to Nigeria and served there for nearly eight years. He came to London in 1989 and from then on has been identified with the activities of the old students here. Founder member of the OSA, he helped us strengthen our membership, helped us collect funds for school developments and encouraged us to invite our Principals here and helped us organise grand functions. As the most senior of the old students here he also helps us contact Mrs Supramaniyam, his former teacher, respected guru and mentor and get first hand information about the OSA Canada.

Mrs B Kanthapillai BA

Mrs B Kanthapillai had her early education at our school. After a few years and as soon as a girls' school was founded at Vannarpannai she was moved to that school. From there she completed her school education. Obtaining the necessary qualification to travel to India and pursue her further education. She joined Holy Cross Convent, Trichi, and successfully completed her BA with English as her main subject.



Returning home, she found a teaching job at Urumpirai she served there for six years and in 1960 joined Kokuvil. There she served as a teacher until she prematurely retired in 1982.

As a teacher of English, English being her main subject, she earned the respect of the students and teachers. The Principal Mr Panchlingam recognised her aptitude for teaching and raised her to the position of Head of the English Dept. She had been instrumental in helping the school organise English Day and other inter school activities.

She also served for a short period as a teacher in Nigeria. In the UK she had identified with all the activities of the OSA and has been offering whatever help she could.

Highlights of my trip to Sri Lanka-July 2010



During my two week holiday to Sri Lanka I visited the capital, Colombo, and Jaffna, it is hard to say which I liked best but Jaffna's animal population, overwhelming friendliness and hospitality as well as the clean, unpolluted air won me over in the end.

My family and I spent roughly a week in Colombo altogether, the time flew by in a haze of going to the beach, the zoo, shopping and visiting relatives.

Colombo is a completely different environment from London, an interesting difference for me is the transport and roads. The dusty dirt streets are crammed with people and it is surprising how vehicles can navigate through the crowds without any casualties. Everywhere you go three wheelers/ auto rickshaws are driving as fast as possible and squeezing into minute gaps in order to avoid the traffic on the main streets. In traffic jams people let out their anger by horning as much as possible creating an ear splitting din. There aren't many cars but the amount of lorries and motorbikes make up for them.

The scenery is an obvious difference; rows of terraced houses in London are replaced by blocks of flats and bungalows in Colombo. Even in Colombo there aren't that many open spaces devoted to nature, but there are trees everywhere providing shade from the hot midday sun.

We travelled to Jaffna by a private van overnight. During the 10 hour journey I mainly watched the scenery change through the window. Eventually the shops and night life thinned until we reached the deserted forest around Vavuniya. I had been told that crocodiles and other jungle animals could be seen, but to my dismay the largest animal I saw was a stray dog searching for scraps of food.

In Jaffna we stayed in a guest house, we were only staying for a couple of days for the Kokuvil Hindu school ceremony (my daddy's highlight of the trip). In the mornings there were award presentations at the school, though I never went to one as my daddy thought that I would be constantly complaining that I was bored and disturbing the most enjoyable moments of his life.

In the evenings the cultural programmes were more enjoyable with many performances from the students, the dances were brilliant and original and even a short play (Solan Magan/the king's son) was performed on the last day. The events took place in the schools massive playing field, mini flags were draped everywhere and the stage was a mass of red and white (the school colours) material. The music could be heard from miles away, it's amazing how the local villagers didn't turn up to complain as they would in London. That's one of the reasons why the entire event seemed communal; it was celebrated by everyone in the neighbourhood.

The celebrations only lasted for three days, so on the fourth day there was a cricket match between the overseas KHC old students and the old students in Sri Lanka. To our disappointment the overseas students lost, all the cheering had been wasted. Nevertheless everyone had an enjoyable time, and in the end the results didn't matter.

Later in the day there was dinner arranged especially for the overseas students and their families. Everyone found the food delicious (with one exception, ME!!!) Though it was still a great opportunity to socialise and have fun.

We also went to Nallur Kandaswamy temple, which had massive mounds of sand not strictly to slide down but I did it anyway. My favourite pastime in Jaffna was catching puppies from the house next door and attempting to give them a bath, feeding goats and tormenting chained up guard dogs by making 'woof' noises. Going to Casurina Beach was also enjoyable, the sea water was clear, a nice change from the murky water of England beaches. The long stretch of white sand was also free of litter, another surprise!

As this was my first visit to Jaffna, I found it fascinating visiting my parents' old houses and seeing how they lived.

Jaffna's roads are free of congestion with only a couple of school children riding home on their bikes in the evenings. When we went to the town, I found that there weren't that many shops, but there were plenty of stalls selling various foods.

The only down side of Jaffna was the heat and the lack of fast food restaurants, like Mc Donalds and Pizza Hut!

Nevertheless I thoroughly enjoyed my trip to Jaffna and must thank KHC for celebrating at such a convenient time. I can't wait to go back again!

The sorrow of 2004 Indian Ocean Tsunami



The 2004 Indian Ocean tsunami occurred at 00:58:53 Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) and 18.6 miles underwater, on December 26th 2004. The tsunami had an epicentre off the coast of Sumatra, Indonesia. These were the top 5 worst hit countries in the tsunami: (In order) Indonesia, Sri Lanka, India, Thailand and The Maldives.

With a magnitude of 9.3, it is the second largest earthquake recorded on a seismograph. The earthquake had the longest duration of faulting ever, about 10 minutes. It caused the entire planet to vibrate as much as 1cm. The tsunami triggered an earthquake in Alaska! Aftershocks were reported off the coast of the Andaman and Nicobar islands. The largest aftershock however was recorded of the Sumatran island Nias with a magnitude of $8.7M_{\rm w}$.

The tsunami's energy was 23,000 Hiroshima bombs exploding at once. The tsunami travelled 5,000 kilometres to Africa, even in Africa it arrived with the satisfactory force to kill people and destroy property. Tsunamis can extend inland by a thousand feet (300 meters) or more. The enormous force and weight of so much water sweeps away almost everything in its path.

In total there were 184,167 confirmed deaths and 230,210 estimated deaths. There were 125,000 people injured, 45,752 missing and 1.69 million displaced. Adding to this is significant number of tourists were also killed (most of which were Europeans). It was the peak holiday travel season in which the tsunami struck. The hardest hit nation was Sweden with 543 dead as of the tsunami, followed by Germany.

Governments and non-governmental organisations fear the final death toll may double as a result of diseases. As many as a third of the people who died in the Indian Ocean tsunami were children; many of them would not have been strong enough to resist the force of the water. Many people were crushed by debris or when the sea hurled them against structures.

States of emergency were declared in Sri Lanka, Indonesia and the Maldives. The United Nations (UN) estimated that the relief operation (which at present, is still happening) could be the priciest in history. In total, the world community had donated \$7bn (£4,386,200,000) for relief operation. UN says that rebuilding could take between 5-10 years.

The 2004 tsunami has claimed many lives but the real death toll will probably be never known. This could be just the beginning of the end. Another more deadly tsunami could strike anytime now. After all, humans should be prepared for the worst. But for now our hopes and sympathy should be with those who have lost their lives.


Recalling my memory of the 50s at KHC


It was the Grand Linga Carnival at Kokuvil Hindu College in 1950 that inspired me to join KHC after completing my 'fifth standard' at the junior school Naamagal Vithyasaalai.in East Kokuvil. It was also customary at that time for the students who passed the grade five at Naamagal to join Kokuvil Hindu.

It was an anticlimax when I found that my class room at KHC was a new hut with a cemented floor, a coconut palm leaf thatched roof and thatched partitions. Also this place was located on the north side of the Puthukovil temple, while the main school was located on the south side of the temple where the Principal had his office. The main school was big and had a tiled roof.

There were a few classmates from my old school in my class and others were from other feeder schools. Compared to my junior

other feeder schools. Compared to my junior school, KHC was very big and there were many students, both boys and girls up to the age of 18.





He was very angry with my action and told me that he was going to report me to the Principal. I, without thinking, replied "I don't care", thinking that he wouldn't say anything. He ran out of the class and came back few minutes later and told me that the Principal wanted me to come to his office. I did not belief that he had gone all the way to the Principal's office, replying "I have no intention to go to his office and if the Principal wants, he can come and see me". He ran out of the class and returned a few minutes later and told me that the Principal would be coming to see me. I didn't belief a word of what he said. After about 15 minutes, I saw the Principal coming with his umbrella and to my horror; he was coming towards our class room. I was so worried and frightened that I thought of running out of the class room. It was a hot day and the Principal closed his umbrella as he entered our class room and asked, "Who is the boy (யார் மோனை) who asked me to come in this hot weather to see him". I was petrified and, nearly wetting my pants, stood up and told him exactly what had happened with tears. He asked me for my name and my father's name. I told him pathetically that, if he wanted to punish me, to do so and not to tell my father. The Principal told me firmly without raising his voice, "If you have come here to study, then you should do that and not try to sort out other people's problems", and he walked away. I was numbed and couldn't belief that the Principal could be that nice. If it had been my father instead, I think a few of my bones may have needed to be attended to afterwards. This incident somehow never reached my parents' ears.

That Principal was Handy Perinpanayagam. Handy Master taught us General Knowledge at A-Level, and the lessons were once a week, usually interrupted by a telephone call from the education department or someone wanting to see him urgently. He taught us about governments, constitutions and the way of life generally and expected us to write a short summary; we enjoyed his lectures. One afternoon Handy Master started to explain a topic which was too difficult for me to understand. Within a few minutes of his arrival, Thambinathan, the handy man of the school, called him to attend to an urgent phone call. Handy Master asked us to read about that topic from the library and wanted us to write it as homework and left the room in a hurry.

The next week, as usual, Handy Master came to our class room late carrying files, papers and books and asked, "Has any one written about last week's topic?". He was expecting at least one of us may have written something. It was total silence and he asked a second time and there was no reply from anyone. He took his files and quietly said to himself. "You all seem to be busy with other work and I also have important matters to attend", and walked away. There was total silence in our class for the next five minutes at least. Usually a few girls in our class used to be prompt with homework. If one person had written about that topic, Handy Master would have stayed; for that, we all were angry with each other.

Everyone turned up with their homework for the next week's class. Handy Master was able to bring awareness and responsibility within us with minimum words.

During my A-Level days, one day, I cycled towards Inuvil, and Handy Master was standing outside his house along KKS Road. I was in a hurry to return back to the class within the 45 mins break; I pretended that I hadn't seen him and cycled fast without looking at him. He called to me and asked me whether I was in a hurry. I replied, "No Sir". He asked me whether I wouldn't mind telling Thambinathan to come to see him and to continue with my journey. I expected him to tell me off for leaving the school during school hours, but he didn't. May be, Handy Master may have known about my free period or because he was about to retire that year and he was also preparing for his retirement by taking it easy- I still ponder over it.


When C K Kanthaswamy master was house bound in Australia, my wife and I visited him during our travels. Although he was the Vice-Principal during my whole period at KHC, I was in his class for only six months studying Physics at A-Level.

When I asked him whether he could remember me during my KHC days in the late 50s, he reacted mildly saying, "What do you mean? I can remember not only you but also your brothers and sister as well!". He quoted an incident in the physics lab where I was struggling to do an experiment from the wrong end. Whilst I was struggling to remember few names, my teacher was able to recall facts about me and my family.

There were also teachers like A Nagalingam, V.Sinnathamby, K Kanthapillai and Mylvaganam, who have left a lasting legacy in my life.

There were many incidents and experiences during my KHC days and these memories have kept my mind inspired and stimulated – more now than ever before.



STROKE: Remember the 1st Three Letters.... S.T.R.

My nurse friend sent this and encouraged me to post it and spread the word. I agree. If everyone can remember something this simple, we could save some folks. Seriously..

Please read:

STROKE IDENTIFICATION:

During a BBQ, a friend stumbled and took a little fall - she assured everyone that she was fine (they offered to call paramedics) .She said she had just tripped over a brick because of her new shoes.

They got her cleaned up and got her a new plate of food. While she appeared a bit shaken up, Maria went about enjoying herself the rest of the evening.

Maria's husband called later telling everyone that his wife had been taken to the hospital - (at 6:00 PM Maria passed away.) She had suffered a stroke at the BBQ. Had they known how to identify the signs of a stroke, perhaps Maria would be with us today. Some don't die. They end up in a helpless, hopeless condition instead..

It only takes a minute to read this

A neurologist says that if he can get to a stroke victim within 3 hours he can totally reverse the effects of a stroke.....totally. He said the trick was getting a stroke recognized, diagnosed, and then getting the patient medically cared for within 3 hours, which is tough.

RECOGNIZING A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. Unfortunately, the lack of awareness spells disaster. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke.

Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking three simple questions:

S *Ask the individual to SMILE.

T *Ask the person to TALK and SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE (Coherently) (i.e. It is sunny out today.)

R *Ask him or her to RAISE BOTH ARMS.

If he or she has trouble with ANY ONE of these tasks, call emergency number immediately and describe the symptoms to the dispatcher.

New Sign of a Stroke ----- Stick out Your Tongue

NOTE: Another 'sign' of a stroke is this: Ask the person to 'stick' out his tongue. If the tongue is 'crooked', if it goes to one side or the other, that is also an indication of a stroke.

Burglary advice

We are reminding Londoners to keep their homes secure this summer to help reduce a seasonal increase in burglaries where thieves get in through open windows and doors.

In London last summer (between June and September) we saw an average monthly increase of about 34% where burglars entered homes without having forced entry. In the hotter summer months many people leave windows and back doors open to keep cool, often leaving their homes unsecured - and more attractive to burglars.

Burglary, on the whole, is an opportunist crime and a burglar will select his target because it offers him the best opportunity to carry out his crime undetected and with the fewest number of obstacles in his way. A building that presents itself as unoccupied and insecure is far more likely to be targeted than one which is properly secured.

Here are some signs that burglars look out for:

- 1. * Side gates open
- 2. * Accessible windows open
- 3. * Ladders left out, allowing access to otherwise inaccessible windows
- 4. * Untrimmed hedges or high fences preventing natural surveillance

We are advising Londoners to take a few measures that can reduce the chance of it happening to them. When leaving the property unoccupied, even for just a short time, householders should always lock all windows and doors. If fitted, alarms should be switched on. Whenever possible make it look as though your house is occupied, and don't leave any valuables on display. It's also worth remembering:

- * Never leave a spare key concealed anywhere near the front door burglars know all the hiding places
- 2. * Prevent letterbox burglaries by storing keys away from the front door
- 3. * Do not label your house keys in case you lose them and they fall into the wrong hands. If leaving the property for longer periods consider:
- 4. * Installing timers which switch lights or radios on and off automatically.
- * Having a neighbour or friend pop round to clear your letter box or doorstep.
- 6. * Encouraging a neighbour to park on your drive.
- 7. * If going out after dark, draw the curtains, leave some lights on and a radio playing.
