REVISED STATISTICS OF MISSIONS IN INDIA AND CEYLON.

THE attempt made last year, to exhibit in statistical tables the present position and agency of Christian Missions in India, excited, as our readers are aware, considerable interest among the supporters of those missions and exhibited gratifying and unexpected results. At the same time it was well known that in some parts the tables published were of doubtful authority and in others incomplete. The *Calcutta Missionary Conference*, before whom the tables were first laid, desirous of seeing these defects removed, and of securing, as far as possible, a complete and authoritative collection of statistical details concerning Indian Missions, requested the compiler to undertake the task of getting those tables revised, and their information brought down to the commencement of the present year 1852. They offered at the same time to bear all the expense of the enquiry.

In order to secure a successful issue to the proposal, the tables of last year were reprinted on separate sheets, and to every missionary or body of missionaries at each station, a copy of the sheet describing that station was sent, with the request that all the particulars respecting it might be corrected and the paper returned to Calcutta. The co-operation of all missionaries was earnestly invited, that the statistics might be perfectly correct in every case. The papers thus sent through all the Presidencies of India and the Island of Ceylon were *two hundred and fifty* in number. The difficulty and expense of transmitting so many letters to such long distances were very great, but the willing aid of able co-adjutors considerably diminished both. The Rev. M. Winslow kindly took charge of those circulated in the Madras Presidency; and Sir A. Oliphant of those in the Island of Ceylon. To the kind interest and attention of these gentlemen, the enquiry in those distant parts of Hindustan is much indebted for the success with which it has met.

Of the two hundred and fifty papers issued no less than *one hundred and eighty-seven* were returned corrected. Concerning *forty-eight* of the stations described in the remainder, information on all chief points has been obtained from the printed Reports for 1851. The details of *nine* others exhibit those stations as they appeared at the end of 1850: the remaining

It would thus appear that of the whole number of stations (three hundred and fourteen) described in these papers, the details of THREE HUNDRED are furnished upon the best authority, that of missionaries upon the spot, and are brought down to the beginning of the present year. So much for the authority of the tables: a few words may be added upon their contents.

The STATIONS will be found enumerated pretty much in geographical order. In the *Presidency of Bengal*, after describing those in Orissa and the out-lying province of Assam, the tables take up the stations in Calcutta; next, those in the rice-districts south and east of that city, which are chiefly superintended by Calcutta missionaries; and then they pass along the Ganges, turning aside as occasion requires, as far as Berhampore. They then proceed to the south-east to the Krishnaghur zillah, Jessore, Chittagong, Dacca and other stations in the east of Bengal: thence going northward to the Himálaya, and coming down by Dinajpur to the Ganges again, they proceed to the north-west as far as Lahore. The Missionary stations of the *Madras Presidency* are ranged almost in three lines. Starting from Belgaum, the tables first enumerate those of the German Mission on the west coast of India going southwards: then return to Bellary in Central India, and coming along the plateau of Mysore, pass through Travancore from north to south; thence they move northward through Tinnevely, along the eastern plains of the Presidency as far as Vizagapatam. The stations in Bombay are enumerated from north to south-east and thence to Bombay itself: and those in Ceylon, having passed all round the sea-coast, terminate in the interior of the Island.

The TERMS contained in these tables are employed with the following meanings. Under the term *Missionaries* are included those who have been specially ordained to the work of preaching the gospel; together with a few, both from Europe and America, who though not strictly ordained, left their country in the spirit of missionaries and for the same end. All the missionaries are named, whether they were absent from ill-health, or labouring at their proper stations. The ordained Native Missionaries are distinguished by the term (*nat.*) except in cases where their name alone suffices to point them out. By *Native Catechists* are meant those Native Christians who have been appointed preachers. The term does not include *Readers* and *School-masters*, who form a different class of native agents. The term *Native Churches* refers not to the buildings wherein native congregations meet, but to the separate *bodies* of

resident in one place. *Admitted* points out the number who were admitted into church-fellowship and to the ordinance of the Lord's Supper *for the first time* during 1851; and *excluded* describes those put away from the body of communicants for misconduct in the same period.

The term *Native Christians* includes the whole body of natives, who by breaking their caste, have separated themselves from their fellow-idolaters, and are now placed under regular Christian instruction and influence. So far as they have any religion, it is the religion of the Bible. Some of this numerous class are the unbaptized children of Christian parents; others are unbaptized adults, who have broken caste; others have been baptized, but have not entered the body of communicants. All, however, are under regular Christian instruction. The best portion of these Native Christians are the church members or communicants, who are admitted to the ordinance of the Lord's supper. Of the varying degrees of knowledge and character by which such admission is regulated among different denominations of Christians, the compiler has of course taken no account.

Missionary Schools have been divided into three classes; the *Vernacular day*, the *Boarding* and the *English day* schools. This division is naturally suggested by the different values of these schools and the different classes which attend them. *Vernacular day* schools are attended chiefly by the poorer classes, and give but a simple education. In *English day* schools a much higher system of education is carried out; they are frequented by the children of most respectable and wealthy families, and their scholars often remain in them for eight or ten years. The *boarding* schools contain almost exclusively Christian children: who by residing on a missionary's premises, have the advantage of a superior Christian training. So different is the influence exercised by these different species of schools, that to class all their scholars in a lump as "receiving a Christian education" can only produce confusion and error.

The last item points to the efforts of missionaries to benefit their European countrymen, and shews the number of *services* maintained in the *English* language for their instruction. Other items might have been added to these tables, as the number of Readers, Christian School-masters and Teachers; but it was thought that those already given were enough to convey a pretty correct view of the agency employed in Indian Missions and its results. It would greatly facilitate the compilation of Missionary information, were all Societies to adopt some such *common items* in their tables, however much they

The result of this second and more complete enquiry, into the statistics of Christian Missions in Hindustán, exhibits those Missions as occupying a higher position and as being blest with larger fruits than previous researches had ever before shown, or their warmest friends had ever anticipated. Of this fact the following condensed summary will furnish striking evidence. At the commencement of the year 1852, there were labouring throughout India and Ceylon—

The entire *Bible* has been translated into *ten* languages; the New Testament into *five* others, and separate gospels into *four* others. Besides numerous works for Christians, 30, 40, and even 70 *Tracts* have been prepared in these different languages suitable for Hindus and Musalmáns. Missionaries maintain in India *twenty-five* printing establishments.

This vast missionary agency costs £190,000 annually: of which one sixth, or £33,500, is contributed by European Christians resident in the country.

By far the greater part of this agency has been brought into operation during the last twenty years. It is impossible to contemplate the high position which it occupies, and the results which it has already produced, without indulging the strongest expectations of its future perfect success; and without exclaiming with the most fervent gratitude,
