Revision of the list of Detailed Accountable Drugs was a long felt need for the state sector health institutions. Since there is a remarkable increase in the consumption as well as in the cost of drugs, it has become very necessary to revise this list in order to reduce the workload of the staff responsible of accounting drugs so that they can pay more attention towards patient care.

Finally I wish to thank the staff of the Medical Supplies Division, Drug Regulatory Authority, National Drug Quality Assurance Laboratory and Department of Pharmacology, University of Colombo for their efforts in revising the list and producing this booklet.

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INTRODUCTION

The necessity for a revision of the "Detailed Accountable Drugs List" has been recognized by all those who have witnessed the sharp escalation of drug prices over the last decade. A generic drug which costs less than 75 cents did not fall into the category of Accountable Drugs may today cost Rs. 4.50 or more and fall into the category of Accountable Drugs.

As a consequence the number of drugs coming into the Accountable Drugs category has greatly increased over the last few years. Therefore it becomes necessary to revise this list every few years by an upward revision of the cost as a criterion. If this is not done an exhaustive list of accountable drugs will be created which will serve no purpose. On the contrary it will add an unnecessary work load to the pharmacists and to the non nursing duties of the nursing staff.

It is hoped that this workshop will make it possible to identify criteria other than price eg. Staff category doing the accounting - e.g. pharmacist or nurse, nature of drug, grade of institution etc. which also should have a bearing on preparing the Accountable Drugs List.

Accountability - an overview

Medical Supplies Division (MSD) supplies to all Government Health Institutions essential pharmaceuticals, devices and other supplies utilizing almost one third of the Health budget. This amount keeps on escalating due to introduction of new drugs and devices as a result of technological advancements. It is a great challenge for administrators and the end users to balance the funds apportioned for this task with the ever increasing demand for quantities and items so that the patients get the correct items at the required place when it is needed.

Financial accountability, though not so significant from the end users perspective is also one of the important aspects of management of supplies. A failure of this concept would result in the inability to purchase the required amount. In order to avoid such a situation, even the smallest unit purchased and transferred to the patient should be accounted for not only in numbers but also in financial terms.

The rising cost of pharmaceutical supplies is depicted in the following table. Major part of this expenditure is on pharmaceutical procurement and supply.

Out of the many factors, which contribute to rising cost of medical supplies, one is pilferage. In order to contain cost various means have been taken by the authorities, out of which accountability of drugs is one.

In order to achieve this end and also to have a count of the high value items from being pilfered, a system was adopted in the past where an item costing above a certain value had to be accounted for in detail. This process has added more work to the health staff, thus diminishing time available for patient care.

Over the years, inspite of the rising cost of drugs the value limit set for accountable drugs remained unchanged. This has led to a growing list of accountable drugs and countability has become a time consuming process for the staff assigned to this task. This is an opportune moment for the policy makers to identify and prioritize items, which should be countable, so that the health staff would not forget their mission.

I take this opportunity to thank the staff of M. S.D., N.D.Q.A.L., M.T.S., and Dept. of Pharmacology for their invaluable contribution in revising the list of countable drugs in keeping with present financial trends.

SELECTION CRITERIA OF DETAIL ACCOUNTABLE DRUGS

In developing this list all the existing rules, regulations and procedures with regard to management of drugs issued from time to time as departmental circulars were reviewed and taken into consideration. The circulars considered are:

1. General Circular 1064 of 28. 02. 1980
2. General Circular No.81 of 15. 01.1986
3. Manual on management of Drugs - First Revision 1993

The following criteria were taken into account.

- I. Price
- II. Nature of item (antibiotics, steroids etc.)
- III. Consumption & management
- IV. Place of issue (Pharmacy/Ward)
- V. Pharmaceutical factors (stability problems of various dosage forms eg: sugar coated etc.)

1. Price

- a). Tablets and capsules costing Rs. 4.50 or more per tablet or capsule.

- c). IV Fluids costing Rs. 30.00 or more per bottle.

- d). External preparations costing Rs. 30.00 or more per bottle of 60ml or less, tube or vial

NB: For tubes used for extemporaneous preparations (e.g. Betamethasone), such quantity may be taken to a bulk register. Head of the Institution/Superintendent pharmacist may decide and give approval for such items.

IV. Management

All special indented items and locally purchased items to be detail accounted
Exemption: External liquid preparations

V. General

With the approval of the Head of the Institution, bulk accounting to be done weekly till the Manual on Management is revised.

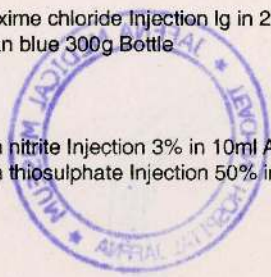
