Japan—Noto Peninsula—North Nanao Harbour—Nonexistence of Rock—Additional Soundings.

In continuation of Notice to Mariners No. 218, dated October 24 last, issued by this office, the British Admiralty has given further notice that an examination of the spot shows that the rock, with 3½ fathoms on it, reported to lie 2 cables southward of Fudou saki, Nanao harbour, does not exist, soundings of 9 fathoms having been obtained near the assigned position. The local fishermen, moreover, have no knowledge of any rock in that locality. It has therefore been erased from the Charts.

Approximate position : lat. 37° 10′ 50″ N., long. 136° 59′ 55″ E.

Also that the following shoal soundings have been obtained on the Okinami bank:—

- (a) A depth of 3 fathoms with Toyogadake bearing N.W. by N. $\frac{3}{6}$ N., distant $18\frac{1}{3}$ cables, and south extreme of Hechiwa saki W. $\frac{7}{6}$ S.
- (b) A depth of $5\frac{1}{4}$ fathoms with Toyogadake bearing N.W. $\frac{5}{8}$ N., distant $18\frac{1}{4}$ cables, and Hechiwa saki W. by S. $\frac{1}{4}$ S.
- (c) A depth of 5 fathoms with Toyogadake bearing N.W. by N. § N., distant 201 cables, and Kagata bana W. ½ S.
- (d) A depth of $6\frac{1}{4}$ fathoms with Toyogadake bearing N.W. by N., distant 29 $\frac{3}{4}$ cables, and Bagaura saki W. by S. $\frac{5}{8}$ S., or approximately in lat. 37° 10′ 45″ N., long. 137° 3′ 55″ E.

China Sea-Rhio Strait Approaches--Irene Rock Non-existence of.

The British Admiralty has given notice (No. 678 of 1898) that during a recent survey an unsuccessful search was made for the Irene rock in the approaches to Rhio strait. The area around its assigned position, for some miles, being sounded over without finding any indication of shoal water, and as moreover the masters of vessels trading between Linga and Singapore state that they have no knowledge of the existence of a fock hereabouts, and the original report has received no confirmation, this rock has therefore been erased from the Admiralty Charts.

Approximate position: lat. 0°24' 15" N., long. 104° 8' 45"

China-Pescadores Islands-Shoals discovered.

The British Admiralty has given notice (No. 685 of 1898) of the existence of the following shoals north-eastward of Pescadores islands, Formosa:—

(a) A rock named Ito sho, with a depth of 4 fathoms on it, lies with North island bearing N. 53° W., distant 51° miles, and North head, Pehu island, S. 65° W. Approximate position: lat. 23° 42′ 0″ N., long. 119° 40′ 50″ E.

(b) A rocky patch, with a depth of 21 fathoms on it, with North island bearing N. 39° W., distant 6 75 miles, and North head, Pehu island, S. 76° W.

Approximate position: lat. 23° 40′ 45" N., long. 119°

40′ ÎÛ″ E.
