And the aforesaid fees are payable by the person having possession, custody, or control of the vehicle or animal in two half-yearly instalments on or before January 31 and July 31 in each year.

OTICE is hereby given to persons residing within the limits of the Local Board, Negombo, that the Board, acting under the provisions of section 35 of Ordinance No. 13 of 1898, has imposed an annual tax pavable in six days' labour upon all persons residing within the limits of the Local Board, who would have been liable under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1861 to the performance of labour for the maintenance of the roads or other public means of communication by land or by water if the Ordinance No. 31 of 1884 had not been passed: Such labour may be commuted by a money payment of Rs. 2 in the town of Negombo and the islands of Pitipana and Munnakkara, and Re. 1 50 in the island of Duwa, on or before the 28th day of February, 1899. After that date the payment will be Rs. 4 and Rs. 3, respectively, per head.
