# MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

#### Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, June 9, 1899, at 3 p.m.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated June 3, 1899.

Present :-- Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. Allan Perry; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa ; Mr. Charles Perera ; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy ; Mr. Charles P. Dias ; Mr. R. H. Morgan ; Mr. Arthur Alvis ; Mr. James Peiris ; and Mr. H. A. Jayewardene.

The Minutes of May 12, 1899, having been printed and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,-That the Minutes of May 12, 1899, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. Perera moved "that Mr. H. T. S. Ward's name be substituted in place of the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper's in the Special Committee appointed on April 28, 1899, to consider the matter of additional assistance to the Superintendent of Works."

Mr. A. Alvis seconded.—Carried unanimously.

2. The following recommendation from the Standing Committee of May 22, 1899, was laid before the Council :--

#### May 22, 1899.

(4) Application from Messrs. Cargills, Limited, to build at York street.

- The conditions specified in Superintendent of Works' letters No. 72 of January 25, 1899, and No. 308 of April 18, 1899, are approved, subject to the substitution of "Chairman" for "Superintendent of Works" in conditions (e) and (g).
- The Council is to be advised to apply for sanction under section 160 of Ordinance 7 of 1887 to stop up the street, and for sanction under section 165 of Ordinance 7 of 1887 to sell the part in question subject to the continuance of existing rights.

The conditions are to be submitted to Council with this recommendation.

These conditions are approved in respect of all similar applications in York street.

Mr. A. Alvis moved "that the recommendation contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted, and that the conditions do apply mutatis mutandis to Chatham street and Baillie street."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.-Carried unanimously.

3. A letter No. 37/6825 dated May 3, 1899, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding fresh by-laws drafted under Ordinance No. 2 of 1894, was laid before the Council, having been previously circulated. Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that the by-laws as now drafted be agreed to, subject to the insertion of a further proviso to the effect that in the absence of such order under the hand of the Chairman six hours previous notice of such removal to the Chairman, Secretary, or Sanitary Officer of the Municipal Council of the said town shall be sufficient authority for burial in a place outside the limits of the Municipality. The proof of service of such notice to be on the party removing." Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa seconded — Carried upor morely.

Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa seconded.-Carried unanimously.

A letter No. 41/08588 dated May 22, 1899, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the duplication of the water main throughout its entire length, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that Council do go into Committee."

M. J. Peiris seconded.

#### [Council in Committee.]

Council having resumed, Mr. C. Perera moved "that with reference to the second paragraph of the Colonial Secretary's letter No. 41 of May 22, 1899, the concurrence of the Municipal Council remains unchanged. The Council, however, considers that it should be understood that the use of Labugama water for purposes other than domestic supply and sale to shipping should not be increased without the consent of the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.-Carried unanimously.

An application from Mr. Nicholas de Silva, Accountant, Health Department, for extension of his leave for 5. one month from June 3, 1899, was allowed.

6. Statement of receipts and disbursements from January 1 to May 30, 1899, and a progress report of work done for May, 1899, were laid on the table.

7. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for January, 1899, were laid on the table.

8. The City Analyst's report on the town water for May, 1899, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

9. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poison, and gunpowder for May, 1899, were laid on the table.

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
