PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 10 of 1899.

An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Postal and Telegraph Ordinance, 1892."

WEST RIDGEWAY.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter and amend "The Ceylon Postal and Telegraph Ordinance, 1892," hereinafter called the principal Ordinance: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

To be read as one with Ordinance No. 13 of 1892.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Postal and Telegraph Amendment Ordinance, 1899," and shall be read as one with the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 17.

2 For section 17 of the principal Ordinance the following sections shall be substituted:

Opening of postal packets from foreign countries. (a) If the Postmaster-General shall have reason to believe that any postal packet received from beyond seas contains any articles subject to duty, or if he be so requested to do by the Principal Collector of Customs, he shall require the attendance at the general post office of the addressee of such postal packet or of some agent deputed in writing by such addressee. Such postal packet shall then be opened by the addressee or his agent in the presence of an officer of the post office deputed for the purpose by the Postmaster-General and of a customs officer. If the addressee or his agent fail to attend in pursuance of the notification, the packet shall be opened by a customs officer in the presence of such officer of the post office.

When postal packets may be forfeited.

(b) Any postal packet in respect of which a declaration of value is required, the contents of which do not agree with the declaration of the sender, may be forfeited, and any postal packet, the true wholesale market value of which, as defined by Ordinance No. 18 of 1896, has not been declared by the sender, may be dealt with as undervalued goods under section 43 of the Customs Ordinance, No. 17 of 1869.

Amendment of section 44.

3 For section 44 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted:

Postage to be deemed stamp duty.

44. The rates or duties which shall be expressed or denoted by any postage or telegraph stamp shall be denominated and deemed stamp duties, and shall be under the care and management of the Commissioner of Stamps for the time being; and all the powers, provisions, clauses, regulations, directions, fines, forfeitures, pains, and penalties contained in or imposed by any Ordinance now in force or to be hereafter enacted shall (so far as the same may be applicable and may be consistent with the provisions of this Ordinance), in all cases not hereby expressly provided for, be of full force and effect with respect to the stamps to be provided under and by virtue of this Ordinance, and to the paper on which the same shall be impressed, or to which the same shall be affixed, and shall be observed, applied, enforced, and put in execution for the raising, levying, collecting, and securing of the rates or duties denoted thereby, and for preventing, detecting, and punishing all frauds, forgeries, or other offences relating thereto, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if such powers,

Proviso.

Amendment of section 87.

Power to enter on lands, put up posts, &c., cut down trees, and do other acts necessary for the construction of the electric telegraph. provisions, clauses, regulations, and directions, fines, forfeitures, pains, and penalties had been herein repeated and specially enacted with reference to the said last-mentioned stamps and rates or duties respectively. Provided, however, that it shall not be necessary to cancel or initial any postage or telegraph stamps.

- 4 For section 87 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted:
 - It shall be lawful for any officer in the employ of the Government in the postal department, and for the servants, workmen, and labourers employed by or under such officer, at all times, and with all necessary carriages and animals and other means, to enter upon all or any lands, and to put up thereon any posts which may be required for the support of any electric telegraph wire; and to fasten or attach to any tree growing on such land any bracket or other support for such wire; and to cut down any tree or branch which may in any way injure, or which is likely to injure, impede, or interfere with any line of electric telegraph; and also severally to do and perform all other acts. matters, and things necessary for the purposes of establishing, constructing, repairing, or improving any electric telegraph, or in any way connected therewith, or for performing any act, matter, or thing under the provisions of this Ordinance.

No. 11 of 1899.

An Ordinance for making final provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1898.

WEST RIDGEWAY.

Preamble.

HEREAS by an Ordinance No. 18 of 1898 it was enacted that a sum of Rs. 1,296,855.07 should be charged upon the revenue of this island for the Supplementary Contingent Services of the year One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-eight, in addition to the sum of Rs. 16,588,042 provided by the Ordinance No. 14 of 1897: And whereas an expenditure of Rs. 46,744.03 was incurred and brought to account for the Contingent Services of the year 1898, for which provision is not made by the aforesaid Ordinances: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 46,744'08 charged upon the revenue of this island of the year 1898 for the final Supplementary Contingent Service of that year. 1 That a sum not exceeding Forty-six thousand Seven hundred and Forty-four rupees and Three cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this island of the said year 1898, for the services hereinafter mentioned; the said expenditure being in conformity with the schedule hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract:

No. 12 of 1899.

An Ordinance for making provision for the Contingent Services for the Year 1900.

WEST RIDGEWAY.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Contingent Expenditure required for the service of the Government of this island for the year One thousand Nine hundred, and not otherwise provided for, has been estimated at the sum of Twenty-one million Seven hundred and Twenty-six thousand and Five hundred and Thirty-two rupese: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 21,726,532 to be charged upon the revenue of this island for the Contingent Services for the year 1900. 1 A sum not exceeding Twenty-one million Seven hundred and Twenty-six thousand and Five hundred and Thirty-two rupees shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue and other funds of this island for the Contingent Services for the year One thousand Nine hundred, and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the details of the Estimates specified in the schedule hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract:

Amount of labour to be supplied under the Ordinance No. 31 of 1884.

Treasurer to pay the above at such times as the Governor by warrant shall order.

And to receive credit in his accounts for the payments made in pursuance thereof.

- 2 And whereas by the 31st section of the Ordinance No. 31 of the year 1884, intituled "An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, entitled "An Ordinance to consolidate and amend the Laws relating to Public Thoroughfares in this Colony," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor to propose the estimates prepared in pursuance thereof, or such of them as to him may appear expedient, in the Ordinance for making provision for the contingent expenditure of the colony for the ensuing year, to be dealt with in like manner as any other estimate to be so proposed: And it is thereby also provided that the amount of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance No. 31 of 1884, for the performance of any work or works for which an estimate or estimates may have been so proposed by the Governor, and approved of by the Legislative Council, shall be distinctly stated in the Ordinance enacted for the same, and that the same shall not exceed two-thirds of the whole amount of labour due from the district or districts within which it may be required to be performed: It is enacted that the amount of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be in conformity with the estimates specified in the schedule hereunto annexed.
- 3 The Treasurer of the said island shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore-mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the revenues of the said island.
- 4 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.
