#### MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on October 28, 1899, at 1.30 p.m.

Present :-- The Chairman, Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G.; Dr. W. G. Keith; C. L. M. Abdul Carim, Esq.; E. Coates, Esq.; and D. C. F. Obeyesekere, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on September 16, 1899.

2. Submitted report of the Assistant Superintendent of Police, Southern Province, dated August 31, 1899, on the matter of the extension of the Police limits to make them conterminous with the Municipal limits, and connected papers.

Resolved unanimously,-That the Council is of opinion that it is not necessary to extend the Police limits.

3. The Secretary reported that the purchaser at the first sale of the Gintota toll rent for 1900 having failed to comply with the conditions of sale, the rent was re-sold by the Chairman and fetched Rs. 5,750, the one-tenth of the purchase amount paid by the original purchaser being forfeited.

4. The Secretary reported that the following rents for 1900 were sold by public auction and accepted by the Chairman :---

- (1) Rent of fish auction shed and fish market sold for Rs. 3,905.
- (2) Rent of fruit market stalls for Rs. 1,780.
- (3) Rent of trees at Batadowa for Rs. 19.
