The following fees to be paid by applicants for graves:—

Parties may choose the person to perform the burial service, and to him the fee shall be payable by the keeper. If no person be chosen, then the fee shall be payable to and service rendered by such minister as the Chairman shall name.		
For digging a large-sized grave	3	0
For digging a grave for a child under ten years	2	0

The above fees are to be paid at the time of the application, provided that it is open to an applicant to dispense with the services of the Chaplain, in which case the fee of five rupees shall not be due.

For opening the same at the burial of a relation	5	0
