MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

GALLE MUNICIPALITY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on August 25, 1894, at 3 p.m.

Present:—The Chairman; R. L. Symes, Esq.; Wm. Abeyesundera, Esq.; C. P. Hayley, Esq.; Hon. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G.; D. G. Gunawardena, Esq.; Dr. W. Dias; H. E. H. Hayes, Esq.; N. Dias Abeyasinha, Esq.; and C. L. M. Abdul Carim, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on July 21 last.

2. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. L. M. Abdul Carim asked "at what salary the present Secretary was appointed to his post, when his salary was reduced, and how much the Council has saved by such reduction up to date?"

The Chairman replied that the Secretary was appointed in 1882 on a salary of Rs. 2,500 and horse allowance Rs. 500. In 1887, Government allowed him to draw his pension in accordance with the Act of Parliament 4 and 5, William IV., chap. 24. His salary was then reduced to Rs. 555.56, which was the difference between his pension from Government and Rs. 2,500 salary. Subsequently his salary was increased to Rs. 972.22, which, with his pension, made up the total amount of emolument he was in receipt of while in Government employ. The Council has by this arrangement saved during the last six and a half years Rs. 12,638.86.

3. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. L. M. Abdul Carim moved "that the remarks made by the Auditor, which have been endorsed by the Chairman in his memorandum on the Auditor's report, regarding the Secretary's pay be taken into consideration."

Seconded by Mr. N. Dias Abeyasinha.—Carried.

After consideration of the facts brought out in the Chairman's answer to Mr. Carim's question, it was unanimously resolved, on the motion of Mr. Carim, seconded by Mr. R. L. Symes, that a bonus of Rs. 1,000 be paid to the Secretary.

4. Submitted a letter from the Band Master of the Galle Volunteer and Public Band representing that he had received notice from the Honorary Secretary of the Volunteer and Public Band that his services will be discontinued from the 1st proximo, and asking that the Council will confer with the Committee and prevent his being discontinued from office.

Resolved,—That the Band Master be informed that the Council considers it undesirable to interfere with the discretion of the Band Committee under whose control the band has been placed, and who are responsible for the efficiency and discipline of the band.

5. The question of the sale of licenses to sell opium in 1895 having been brought up for consideration, it was resolved that the conditions under which the sale for the current year was held be approved for 1895.

6. Submitted Auditor's report for July, 1894.

Resolved,—That the completion report of works be certified by the Chairman and the Member of the Ward in which the work has been completed.

7. Submitted Sanitary Officer's report for the quarter ended March 31, 1894, which had been previously circulated among the Members of Council.

8. Submitted Superintendent's reports on Progress of Works for July, 1894.

9. Submitted accounts for July, 1894.

10. Submitted a letter from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary dated August 11, 1894, No. 24, intimating that His Excellency the Governor doubts the fairness of publishing the Chairman's remarks on Dr. Dias' report, while suppressing the report itself, and stating that in His Excellency's opinion it would be more just if the Chairman's letter were left out altogether from the proceedings intended for publication.

The Chairman explained that the letter in question was only placed on the Minutes because it had been called for and read at the Meeting.

Resolved,—That the Chairman's letter herein referred to be removed from the Minutes of Proceedings.

11. The Hon. Dr. Anthonisz, Chairman of the Sub-Committee on Fort Sanitation, informed the Council that at a Meeting held on the 23rd instant it was resolved that the Council be requested to sanction the expenditure already incurred, amounting to Rs. 67-10, on an experimental use of the dry-earth system in six houses unprovided with back entrances, and to authorize the Committee to incur further expenditure to extend the experiment.

Resolved,—That the expenditure already incurred be sanctioned, and that authority be given for such further expenditure as may be found to be necessary.
