MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on September 22, 1894, at 3 p.m.

Present :—The Chairman, Municipal Council ; the Hon. P. D. Anthonisz ; Dr. J. Attygalle ; C. L. M. Abdul Carim, Esq. ; R. L. Symes, Esq. ; Wm. Abeyasundera, Esq. ; N. Dias Abeyasinha, Esq. ; and D. G. Goonewardena, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of last Meeting.
2. Pursuant to notice the Hon. Dr. Anthonisz moved "That the Council apply to Government to obtain from a competent engineer an estimate of the probable cost of introducing a water system of removing night soil from the Fort of Galle, as recommended by the Director of Public Works and the Principal Civil Medical Officer."
Seconded by Mr. W. Abeyasundera.—Carried.
3. Pursuant to notice the Hon. Dr. Anthonisz moved "That as the public latrines are indifferently kept, causing much annoyance to those who live close to them, to have a Sanitary Overseer appointed to supervise the working of them, and that huts or shelters be constructed for the coolies in charge of the latrines at a convenient distance from their work."
Seconded by Mr. C. L. M. Abdul Carim.—Carried.
4. Pursuant to notice the Hon. Dr. Anthonisz moved "That the Sanitary Overseer be entirely under the orders of the Sanitary Officer, and that he be one who could read and write English, and that he be paid Rs. 20 or Rs. 25 per mensem. The latrine coolies to be under the Sanitary Overseer."
Seconded by Mr. D. G. Goonewardena.—Carried.
After a discussion of this motion the Council resolved that, with the view of securing the services of a competent man, Rs. 30 be fixed as the monthly pay.
5. Pursuant to notice the Hon. Dr. Anthonisz moved "That the sides of the Municipal roads close to the town be gravelled and kept smooth for foot passengers, the sides having at present sharp pieces of broken metal strewed over them causing injury to foot passengers who walk barefoot."
Seconded by Mr. N. Dias Abeyasinha.—Carried
Resolved,—That instructions be given accordingly to the Superintendent of Works.
6. In terms of section 83 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887 the Council proceeded to elect by ballot a member of the Standing Committee in the room of Mr. A. Murray, when by a majority of votes Mr. H. E. H. Hayes was elected.
7. Submitted a report of the Sub-Committee on China Garden improvement. The report was read, and the following resolutions come to :—
 - (1) That the Superintendent of Works be directed to make a survey of the land required for opening a road along the back of the buildings at Havelock place.
 - (2) That the recommendation to erect two bridges over the Keppu-ela from Havelock place to the railway grounds be not adopted, as the Railway authorities refuse to give their consent thereto.
 - (3) That the Superintendent of Works be instructed to furnish plan and estimate for re-building the drain on the eastern boundary of China Garden, and for opening an underground drain from the south end of it through the police grounds and under the Mátara road to the sea.
 - (4) That the Superintendent of Works do furnish a plan and estimate for forming a road along the side of the China Garden drain facing the esplanade from Havelock place to the police station with a walk by its side for foot passengers bordered by a road of shady trees.
8. Submitted Superintendent's report on progress of works in August, 1894.
9. Submitted accounts for August, 1894.

(b) Repaired superficially 1,424 squares of road; trimmed sides 77 lines; cleared side drains 586 lines; and filled ruts and holes in Old Gate road, Kitulaupitia road, Circular road, and Hirimbure road.

(c) Repaired the Miliduwa, Attoya, Hirimbure cross road, Hume road, Kepu-ela and Bope bridges, and supplied eight iron rails for foot-bridge into Victoria park.

(d) Built two scavenging carts and one smallpox cart.

(h) Repaired esplanade drain; building a groin at the mouth of the Pettigala-ela.

(j) Embanking Parana-ela and making a road over the reclaimed ground; used 1,700 coconut stakes; cleared Kepu-ela; underpinning canal wall.

(k) Built a cart shed at Cotton Garden, a betel shed at Havelock place, and one opposite the Police Court; set broken glass on Park wall; underpinning Kepu-ela wall; repaired railings near new gate.

(l) Repaired and improved Fort market.

(m) Supplied iron gratings to arches over doors and windows; bolts to doors; a screen across the room; and railings to outerverandah.

(n) Repaired sea bathing-place near Eolus Bastion.
