#### MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### COLOMBO MUNICIPALITY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, October 12, 1894, at 3 p.m.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated October 6, 1894.

Present:—Mr. C. E. D. Pennycuick, Mayor and Chairman; Hon. Sir John J. Grinlinton; Capt. F. Bayley; Mr. M. Finlay; Mr. T. Smith; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis

The Minutes of September 14 and 28, 1894, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of September 14 and 28, 1894, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved "That the mode of supplying water to the inhabitants of Colombo at this season of drought be considered."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.

- The consideration of this motion was deferred until item No. 7 should be discussed.
- 2. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to September 30, 1894, and a Progress Report of Work done during September, 1894, were laid on the table.
- 3. The following recommendations from the Standing Committee of September 21, 1894, were laid before the Council:—
  - (1) To "declare" the new mutton market at Slave Island, and to fix the fees to be levied for stalls. New mutton market at Slave Island declared a public market under clause 1 of Ordinance 26 of 1890. Resolved that the Council be recommended to levy the following fees under clause 227 of Ordinance 7 of 1887,—viz., Rs. 20 per mensem for each mutton stall.
  - (2) Question of permanent suppression of private Mutton Markets at Slave Island. Resolved that the Council be recommended to suppress under clause 237 of Ordinance 7 of 1887.
  - (4) Papers relating to legal opinion required about duplicate pipe from Labugama.

    Resolved that the matter be left for the decision of the Council.

(5) To provide a supplemental vote on "Miscellaneous Account," and for repairs to boiler of dredger, &c.,

in terms of section 114 of Ordinance 7 of 1887.

Resolved that under clause 114 of Ordinance 7 of 1887 the Council be recommended to transfer from vote No. 159 in Budget for 1894, "Dredging Lake," the sum of Rs. 1,200 for a new boiler for dredger No. 1, and the sum of Rs. 200 in augmentation of the vote for Miscellaneous Account.

Resolved further that the Council be recommended to transfer from vote No. 45 in Supplemental Budget (Rs. 3,485 for improvement of Trunk roads), which it will not be possible fully to utilize this year, so much as is required for any addition to the salary of the Chairman which may be made in pursuance of the resolution of the Council of September 14:-

"That the Council regret they have not the power to grant the compensation suggested in the letter, but that they would be glad if the Governor in Executive Council would exercise the powers vested in him by the 48th clause of the Ordinance 7 of 1887, and fix the salary of the present Chairman at such rate and in such manner that he may be placed on the same footing as regards compensation as other Members of the Civil Service.

Resolved,—That the fees proposed in paragraph 1 for the Slave Island mutton market be approved.
Resolved,—That the private mutton stalls in Slave Island be suppressed as recommended in paragraph 2.
Resolved, with reference to paragraph 4,—That in view of a letter received on the 11th instant from the Colonial Secretary and now read, it has become unnecessary for the present to obtain a legal opinion.
Resolved—That the recommendations in paragraph 5 be sanctioned.

4. Two tenders for the lease of the Grandpass market for 1895 were laid before the Council.

Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna moved "that Abeyesinghe Mudaliyar's tender of Rs. 5,163 be accepted."

Mr. A. Alvis seconded. Mr. C. M. Fernando moved as an amendment "that the highest tender of Rs. 5,283 be accepted."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.

The Council divided on the amendment :-

Whereupon the amendment was lost. The orginal motion was carried.

Eight tenders for the lease of the Edinburgh vegetable and fruit market for 1895 were laid before the Council.

Resolved,-That the consideration of the tenders be deferred till the next Meeting.

6. An application dated October 8, 1894, from some of the subordinate officers of the Municipality (Messrs. Arthur Raffel, Charles Arndt, and others) for an increase of pay was laid before the Council.

On the motion of Hon. P. Coomaraswamy, it was resolved that the application be laid before the Council with the Budget for 1895.

- On the suggestion of the Chairman, this item was deferred until 8, 9, and 10 had been dealt with.
- 8. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for June, 1894, received with letter No. 101 of October 4, 1894, were laid on the table.
- 9. The City Analyst's report dated October 6, 1894, on the town water for September, 1894, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
- 10. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for October, 1894, were laid on the table.

The Chairman here withdrew, and Mr. C. Perera moved "that Hon. Sir John J. Grinlinton do take the Chair." Capt. Bayley seconded.—Carried.

7. The report of the Sub-Committee appointed at the Meeting of May 25, to consider the Chairman's Administration Report for 1893, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Resolved,—That the Council do go into Committee on the report.

Resolved,—That to paragraph 15 of the report be added the following:—

"15a. What the Committee wish to suggest is the prevention of foul matter from entering the lake. The Committee think that this suggestion could be carried out without much expense. There is no great danger to be apprehended from allowing storm and rain water to enter the lake; but what is necessary is to prevent the contamination of the lake from sewage proper and house-refuse flowing into it. Tho Committee suggest that steps should be taken to prevent these foul substances being carried into the lake by means of the drains now flowing into it."

Resolved —That paragraph 19 he omitted the complaint made therein having been since righted. Resolved,—That paragraph 19 be omitted, the complaint made therein having been since righted.

The Council having resumed, Hon. Sir John J. Grinlinton moved the adoption of the report as amended in Committee of Council.

Mr. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

Hon, P. Coomaraswamy's motion (item 1) was, by leave of Council, withdrawn.
