HIS EXCELLENCY SIR ARTHUR ELIBANK HAVELOCK, K.C.M.G., having left the Colony in the ss. "Massilia" last evening, HER MAJESTY'S Commission appointing Sir EDWARD NOEL WALKER, K.C.M.G., to be Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Ceylon, was publicly read in the Council Chamber, and the usual Oaths were administered to him by the Hon. the CHIEF JUSTICE, in the presence of the Executive Council, under a salute of thirteen guns.

PROCLAMATION!

WHEREAS HIS EXCELLENCY SIR ARTHUR ELIBANK HAVELOCK, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof, has quitted this Colony on leave of absence: It is hereby proclaimed that by virtue of Her Majesty's Commission, bearing date the First day of December, 1890, directed to Sir Edward Noel Walker, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, he has this day assumed the Administration of the Government of this Island, and has taken the Oaths in Executive Council accordingly: Of which all persons concerned are required to take due notice.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Fourteenth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-three.
