## PROCLAMATIONS BY THE GOVERNOR.

In the Name of Her Majesty VICTORIA, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland Queen, Defender of the Faith.

### PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ARTHUR ELIBANK HAVELOCK, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by the 11th section of "The Road Ordinance, 1861," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation to alter and vary any district or division into which this Colony has already been divided under the authority of the Ordinance No. 8 of 1848, or into which it may at any time hereafter be divided for the purposes of the said Road Ordinance of 1861 aforesaid, provided that any such alteration of a district shall take effect only from the First day of January thence next ensuing :

And whereas the present divisions of the District of Chilaw, in the North-Western Province, are as they have been from time to time defined by divers Proclamations under the provisions of Ordinance No. 8 of 1848 and "The Road Ordinance, 1861," aforesaid, and it is expedient to alter and vary the divisions of the said district :
