MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

KANDY MUNICIPALITY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall on Saturday, September 25, 1897, at 8.30 a.m.

Present.—Hon. Mr. Allanson Bailey, Chairman; Dr. Frederick Keyt; Edwin Beven, Esq.; R. W. Jonklaas, Esq.; Alexander Philip, Esq.

1. The Minutes of the Meeting held on August 28, 1897, and of the Special Meeting held on September 13, 1897, were read and confirmed.

2. The following documents were submitted:—Statement of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund from close of 1896 to August 31, 1897; separate statements of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water-rate accounts during the same period; Return of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of August; Progress Report of Work done by the Public Works Officer, and Health Officer's Report for the same month.

Resolved.—That the several statements, as required by section 90 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, be forwarded, with the Minutes of this Meeting, to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. The Chairman laid on the table the following papers:—List of cattle sheds, &c., list of laundrymen and dairymen employed by the inhabitants of the Municipality, and a return showing latrine accommodation, return of number of police paid for by Council, and a return of work done by Health Officer. It was ordered that the papers be circulated, and that in future the diary of the Health Officer and the monthly return of the distribution of Municipal Police be circulated with the usual monthly statements.

4. Mr. Philip gave notice of the following motion for the next Meeting of Council :—"That commencing from January 1, 1898, the Municipal Council of Kandy do make payable, at the Municipal Office, Kandy, the assessment tax and water-rate in a similar manner to that adopted by the Colombo Municipality."

5. Mr. Philip, pursuant to notice, asked that the dates be stated on which the Minutes of Proceedings of the General Meetings of the Municipal Council of Kandy during 1897 have been forwarded to Government in terms of section 90 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887.

The Chairman laid on the table a statement of the dates required.

6. The questions and motions standing in Mr. Vanderwall's name were postponed with leave of Council.

7. Mr. Philip, pursuant to notice, moved, with reference to Minute No. 7 of the Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held on Saturday, April 24, 1897, "That steps be taken to obtain a report, with statements of accounts, showing the manner in which the celebration of Her Majesty Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee was carried out, and what scheme or schemes have been adopted to commemorate the occasion."

Seconded by Mr. Beven and carried.

8. The Chairman, pursuant to notice, moved "that the number of licenses for the sale by retail of opium and bhang within the limits of the town for 1898 shall be four."

Seconded by Dr. Keyt and carried.

9. Considered judgment of the Police Magistrate of Kandy in case No. 5,735. Resolved, on the motion of Mr. Beven, seconded by Mr. Jonklaas, that (1) the pond near Torrington road below the lake spill and (2) the stream below the reservoir up to the Rifle butts be set apart for the purpose of bathing.

(a) Watcher, Temple street barrel drains; fixing gratings, town streets; cleaning gratings, town streets; repairing 8 ft. barrel drains, *Brownrigg street*; 2,000 ft. clearing silt from barrel drain, *Trincomalee street* and *King street*; 14 cubes of gravel transported; 14 cubes of gravel-spreading on pavements, *Colombo* and *Brownrigg streets*.

(b) 2½ miles of clearing side drains' jungle, and reducing sides of *Gregory road* and town streets; 14:50 cubes of metal transported; 14:50 cubes of metal-spreading, *Hantane road*, *Colombo street*.

(c) Half a mile of clearing side drains' jungle; reducing sides, *Alutgantota road*; 5 cubes of landslips and drain silt removed from *Alutgantota*, *Davie*, and *Lady Anderson's roads*.

(d) 6 cubes of landslips and drain soil removed, *Lady Horton's road*; 14 cubes of earth felling to *Torrington road*; sweeping *Lady Horton's road*, &c.; jungle watcher.

(e) 2½ miles clearing side drains' jungle; reducing sides, *Halloluwa road*; 5 cubes of gravel transported, *Bahirowekanda road*; 5 cubes of gravel-spreading, *Bahirowekanda road*; 2 cubes of metal transported; 2 cubes of metal spreading, *Slaughter-house road*.

(f) Repairing *Torrington road* privy seats; 26 squares, *Torrington slaughter-house* and exposing shed; 26 squares whitewashing, *Torrington slaughter-house* and exposing shed; shifted tiles, *Municipal buildings* and privy.

(g) 36 squares whitewashing market buildings and privy; cleaning and painting iron work, market; repairing market stalls; making a cover to clock.

(h) Weeding and attending to plants in town streets.

(j) Seven pickaxes.

(k) One tin force-pump.

(l) One mile of road clearing, side drain, jungle, reducing sides; 2 cubes of landslip and drain soil removed; sweeping *Lady Gordon's road*, &c.; repairing tools.

(m) Removing canoes to *Halloluwa ferry* and *Lewella ferry*.

(n) Watcher, boat; 8 cubes of silt from traps; store and lime watcher.

(o) Cutting grass, recreation ground and esplanade; cutting ant hills.

(p) Clearing silt from side drains and flushing *Peradeniya road*, *Katugastota road*, *Trincomalee street*, *Kirk street*, *Castle Hill street*, *Colombo road*, *Colombo street*.

(q) 34 cubes of excavating and breaking barrel drain and removing bricks; cleaning bricks; 15 cubes of metal transported for barrel drain, building invert, cementing, concreting *Colombo street*.

(r) Watcher, 1; building cistern (manhole), 4 ft.; laying kerb stones. Paid for contract Rs. 1,000, *Hantane road* retaining wall.

(s) 2 squares concreting floor of slaughter-house; 44 ft. opening drains, concreting, and building same, slaughter-house; 2½ cubes of retaining wall built, slaughter-house; transporting big stone, slaughter-house works; mining and blasting stone for slaughter-house works; 9 cubes filling earth to retaining wall; repairing wooden truck; 1 cube of gravel transported, slaughter-house; 1 cube gravel-spreading and stone foundation, slaughter-house.

(t) Mining and blasting; transporting big stones, *Lady Anderson's road*; 3 cubes excavating foundation; 20 cubes retaining wall built; 4 cubes of earth filling to retaining wall; 3 cubes excavating foundation; 3 cubes foundation built.

(u) Transporting big stones; half a cube of retaining wall built on the *Peradeniya road*.

Health Officer's Report for August, 1897.

Water Supply.—I still think this is impure, and would be glad to accompany any Sub-Committee appointed by the Council over Farieland and Roseneath estates, so that I may point out my reasons for saying so.

Scavenging, &c.—Scavenging has been satisfactorily performed during the month, except in the case of the public market and slaughter-houses. These places are now to be handed over to Inspector Toussaint, who thus will have control of the scavenging in all the town; the greatest improvement can now be noted in the appearance of the streets.

Night Soil.—The night soil has been properly removed to Katugastota; a new pit and well for washing the carts require to be constructed there. The Chairman visited Katugastota with me during the month, and said he would order both works to be proceeded with, but neither have yet been taken in hand, though both are urgently required. The Chairman also inspected some paddy fields I pointed out to him, saying he would try and acquire them for the Municipality for night soil to be buried in them.

Latrines.—The public latrines have been kept clean and sanitary with the exception of the Police Court latrine. This has now been placed under charge of Inspector Toussaint, and is kept in a sanitary condition. The latrine accommodation is to be doubled in the town, and I have also asked the Chairman to have a new public latrine built on the site of the old sheep slaughter-house, as it is badly required there. Cesspits should be closed up throughout the town and dry-earth closets substituted. I believe this is to be done in the alleys. The cesspits throughout the town are simply repulsive and filthy.

Alleys.—These remain in a most insanitary, overcrowded, and filthy state, are badly lighted, badly ventilated, and badly drained. Some of them are most disgraceful.

Drains.—A general survey of the drains in Kandy is being made; the drains in Colombo street are being repaired. Iron man-traps with locks should replace the present wooden ones. This would stop night soil and rubbish being thrown into the drains. Surface drains require to be properly built in Malabar street from the U. S. Library to the Queen's Hotel, and in railway approach road.

Slaughter Houses.—These have not been kept in a sanitary state, but new arrangements have been made for looking after them. I saw the Chairman personally about them, and told him my recommendations. A wall requires to be built round the sheep slaughter-house; the drainage from it is most defective.

Public Market.—Some paving has been done, and it has been painted, but new tatts are required badly. All the stalls require painting, and most of them repairing. I pointed this out months ago. The provisions sold in the market have been good.

Cattle.—It is extremely hard still to get suitable cattle and sheep to be supplied for slaughtering; however they are better than they used to be, and every endeavour is being made to get the best procurable.

Bakeries.—The Inspectors and myself are trying to get the bakeries into the state the by-laws require them to be in, but the process is very low and tedious.

Dairies.—Acting Inspector Ferdinands has made an inspection of all dairies, cattle stands, &c. I attach his report. No attempt has been previously made to put them into a sanitary state until I reported how I found several of them. It will take a long time before they are improved. When all are in a sanitary condition I will report to the Municipal Council.

Cooly Lines.—It is almost impossible to get these kept in a sanitary condition. I have seen the Chairman personally about them.

Queen's Hotel Stables.—These and the ground in their vicinity remain as previously reported by me—they are most insanitary.

Infectious Diseases.—No infectious diseases were prevalent during August.
