6. (1) All forms of process shall be kept in the native language of the division.

(2) The registers of causes and minutes of evidence may be kept and recorded either in English or in the native language of the division, provided that whenever any record is kept in English, and any party to such record requires a copy of any portion of the proceedings therein, he shall be entitled to receive from the President a translation of such portion from the English into his own language without being called upon to make any payment therefor.
