## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall on Saturday, March 23, 1895, at 8 o'clock p.m.

*Present*:—Hon. Allanson Bailey, Chairman; Dr. Frederick Keyt; J. B. Siebel, Esq.; J. H. Sproule, Esq.; J. N. d'Esterre, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on February 16 were read and confirmed.

2. The following documents were laid on the table:—Statement of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund from close of 1894 to February 28 last; also separate statements in respect of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water Rate accounts; Progress Reports of Works done brought up to the same date; Return of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate, and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of February; also Health Officer's Report.

Resolved,—That the several statements, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, be forwarded, with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, to the Colonial Secretary, together with the Health Officer's report.

3. Read memorandum dated March 15 from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding copy of a letter to Mr. R. D. Ormsby, informing him of his nomination by His Excellency the Governor as a Member of the Municipal Council in room of Mr. H. J. Deslandes.

4. Read letter No. 2, dated February 18, from the Colonial Secretary, intimating that His Excellency the Governor has sanctioned the proposed amendment of the schedule to the Ordinance No. 29 of 1894, extending the water-rate limits.

5. The meeting proceeded, under section 88 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, to elect by ballot a Member of the Standing Committee in room of Mr. H. J. Deslandes, who has left the Island on leave.

On the votes being examined the Chairman declared Mr. R. D. Ormsby to have been elected a Member of the Standing Committee.

6. Considered the following recommendation of the Standing Committee. That the following sums be written off as irrecoverable :—

 Rs. 325 appearing due by Sinnaiah Chetty for manure sold. Proceedings taken in court. Declared an insolvent.  
 Rs. 158-74 appearing as due by Allis Baas—cost of constructing a privy on premises No. 8, Asgiriya road, and costs of case decided against the Council.  
 Rs. 205 appearing due by A B C D Club—made up of charges erroneously made for exclusive use of recreation ground for matches in addition to annual charge.

### Health Officer's Report for February, 1895.

The general health of the community is only fairly good. Owing to the want of rain a lot of sickness exists among the natives, notably dysentery. For the same cause the drains do not get flushed properly, and there is, in consequence, some foulness about certain parts of the town.

The slaughter-house and market are kept in a good condition sanitarily. Some pieces of diseased meat and fish have from time to time been seized and condemned.
