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MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, May 10, 1895.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated May 4, 1895.

Present.—Mr. F. H. Price, Acting Mayor and Chairman; Mr. M. Finlay; Hon. R. K. MacBride, C.M.G.; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alwis.

The Minutes of April 5, 1895, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of April 5, 1895, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. Walter Pereira presented a petition from G. Don Adrian, of the New Bazaar Ward, praying for an investigation into certain charges against Assessment Tax Collector C. W. Fernando, with reference to a sale by him of property No. 13, Galkapanawatta, under a warrant of distress under the hand of the Chairman.

Mr. Walter Pereira then moved that the petition be read.

Mr. C. M. Fernando seconded.

Whereupon the motion was carried and the petition was read.

Resolved,—That the papers be circulated.

2. The Council then proceeded to ballot for the election of a Member of the Standing Committee in the room of Dr. Kynsey, absent from the Island on leave, and the result of the ballot was declared by the Chairman to be in favour of Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, Acting Principal Civil Medical Officer.

3. A statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to April 30, 1895, and Progress Reports of Work done during March and April, 1895, were laid on the table.

4. A letter No. 30 of April 5, 1895, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, was laid before the Council for its opinion on the suggestion contained in letter No. 260 of January 31, 1895, from the Director of Public Works, regarding the proposed duplication of the main piping from Labugama Reservoir.

Resolved,—That the Council do go into Committee on the letter.

The Council having resumed; Mr. Morgan moved "that the Council approve of the proposed duplication of the main from Wagga as suggested by the Director of Public Works, and would recommend that such work be extended for a distance of about ten miles. The Council desire, however, to state that they adhere to the conditions specified in the report of the Special Committee of November 23 last."

Mr. Alwis seconded.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved as an amendment, that the question be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Hon. R. K. MacBride, Mr. M. Finlay, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. R. H. Margan, and Mr. A. Alwis—three Members to form a quorum."

Mr. Alwis seconded.

The original motion having, by leave of Council, been withdrawn in favour of the amendment, the amendment was carried.

5. A letter No. 32 of April 6, 1895, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the present appointment of Additional Municipal Magistrate was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the Government be informed that the Council is satisfied with the existing arrangement.

6. A letter No. 35 of April 19, 1895, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the treatment of infectious diseases in Civil Hospitals, and the alleged unsuitability of the Hospital at Kanatta, was laid before the Council.

Dr. Vanderstraaten having explained that the House of Observation was now properly furnished and ready for the reception of the better class of patients suffering from infectious diseases, it was resolved that the arrangements now provided be deemed satisfactory.

Resolved further,—That the Council recommend the amendment of section 246 of Ordinance 7 of 1887 by the addition of the words "or on any ship in the Colombo Harbour" after the word "hospital."

7. A letter No. 39 of April 24, 1895, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, was laid before the Council, intimating that it is proposed to open the Victoria Bridge for traffic on May 24, and inquiring if the Council is prepared to remove the Bridge-of-boats on that day.

The Chairman informed the Council that the necessary arrangements had been made.

Resolved,—That the Council is of opinion that the toll should be placed on the northern side of the new bridge.

8. With reference to the proposed extension of the Municipal limits, it was resolved that the consideration of the matter be deferred, pending the receipt of a reply from Government to the Chairman's letter No. 63 of May 2, 1895.

9. A letter dated April 11, 1895, from Messrs. Julius & Creasy, requesting a re-consideration of the decision agreed to at the last Meeting regarding an extension of time for beginning work on the tramway agreement, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the Council declines to grant any further extension of time.

10. The Sanitary Officer's report for the first quarter of 1895 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Resolved,—That the report be referred to the Standing Committee.

11. The Auditor-General's report for 1894, received with letter No. 20 of April 2, 1895, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the Auditor-General's report be referred to the Special Committee on the Chairman's Administration Report for 1894."

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

12. The City Analyst's report on the town water for April, 1895, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

13. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for May, 1895, were laid on the table.
