DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Courts Ordinance, 1889."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Courts Ordinance, 1889," hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof; as follows:

Amendment of Ordinance No. 1 of 1889. 1 After section 84 of the principal Ordinance, the following section shall be inserted and numbered 84 a, namely:

Unofficial police magistrates.

It shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time, by notice in the Government Gazette, to appoint any justice of the peace to be an unofficial police magistrate for any district or districts, and any justice of the peace so appointed shall thereupon have all the powers and authority by "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898," vested in police courts, save and except the power and authority to take proceedings with regard to, or hear, try, or determine, any offence which by that Code or by any law of this Colony is summarily triable before a police court

Date of operation.

2 This Ordinance shall come into operation at such date as the Governor shall by Proclamation to be published in the Government Gazette appoint.
