KANDY MUNICIPALITY.

Commutation Rate, 1896.

NOTICE is hereby given that all persons liable to perform labour within the limits of the Municipality of Kandy under section 130 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, who have either not commuted the same by payment of Two rupees before the 28th February, or who have failed to perform six days' labour as per notice dated March 7, 1896, are requested to attend at Castle Hill quarry, Gregory road, on Monday, April 27 next, at 7 o'clock A.M., to perform twelve continuous days' labour (Sunday excepted), or in lieu thereof to pay before the above date, at the Municipal Office, double the rate, viz., Four rupees.

Persons liable to labour not performing the twelve days' labour, or not paying the double rate before the 27th of April, will, on being arrested and convicted, be liable to one month's imprisonment or to a fine, at the discretion of the Chairman, of Ten rupees.
