An Ordinance to amend "The Police Ordinance, 1865."

· Preamble.

HEREAS it is expedient to alter and amend in certain particulars "The Police Ordinance, 1865," hereinafter called the principal Ordinance: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Some of the provisions of Ordinance may be brought into operation throughout the island or into any place.

It shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette, from time to time to declare that such of the provisions of this Ordinance as to them may seem advisable shall come into operation throughout the island, or at any place or places as shall appear to them to require the same, though there be no police force established therein.
