The basic principle upon which Rotary International performs its work is known as the object of Rotary. There were six objects and Goals until 1935 when the Mexico City Convention of RI adopted four. In 1951, at the Convention in Atlantic City, New Jersey, U.S.A., the stated purpose of the organization was streamlined by adopting a single object with four parts.

The object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and in particular, to encourage and foster.

FIRST

The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service

SECOND

High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupation, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

THIRD

The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life;

FOURTH

The advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

Founder of Rotary – Paul P. Harris

Paul P. Harris (1868-1947), a lawyer, was the founder of Rotary, the world's first and most international service club. Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide who promote high ethical stands in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world.



Born in Racine, Wisconsin, U.S.A. on 19 April 1868, Paul as the second of six children to George N. Harris and Cornelia Bryan Harris. At age three he moved to Wallingford, Vermont where he grew up in the care of his paternal grandparents. Married to Jean Thomson Harris (1881-1963), they had no children. He received an LL.B. from the University of Iowa and received an honorary LL.D. from the University of Vermont.

Paul Harris worked as a newspaper reporter, a business teacher, stock company actor, cowboy, and travelled extensively in the U.S.A. and Europe selling marble and granite. In 1896, he went to Chicago to practise law. One evening Paul went with a professional friend to his suburban home. After dinner, as they strolled through the neighbourhood, Paul's friend introduced him to various tradesmen in their stores. This reminded Paul of his New England village and it occurred to him "Why not have a fellowship composed of businessmen from different occupations, without restrictions of politics or religion?"

On 23 February, 1905, Paul Harris formed the first Club with three other businessmen: Silvester Schiele, a coal merchant; Gustavus Loehr, a mining engineer; and Hiram Shorey, a merchant tailor. Paul Harris named the new club "Rotary" because members met in rotation at their various places of business. Club membership grew rapidly.

Many members were from small towns and in the Rotary Club they found an opportunity for camaraderie. When Paul Harris became president of the Club in its third year, he was convinced that the Rotary Club could be developed into an important service movement and strove to extend Rotary to other cities.

The second Rotary Club was founded in San Francisco in 1908. In August 1910, when there were 16 clubs, the National Association of Rotary Clubs was organized. When clubs were formed in Canada and Great Britain, the name was changed to the **International Association of Rotary Clubs** in 1912, and was later shortened to **Rotary International** in 1922. Paul Harris was the first president of both the National Association and the International Association.

When President emeritus Paul Harris passed away on 27 January 1947 his dream had grown from an informal meeting of four to some 6,000 clubs brought together through the service and fellowship of Rotary. Today, there are more than 29,200 clubs in 172 countries and geographical regions. Worldwide, Rotarians lend their time, expertise and resources to a number of vocational programs, and community and international service projects. Today, the Rotary Foundation scholarships program is the world's largest privately-funded international scholarships program, approximately 1,000 scholarships are awarded annually. Through its Polio Plus Program, Rotary International has raised US\$226 million to purchase vaccine for all the world's children and hopes to celebrate its 100th anniversary, in 2005, in a polio-free world.

Paul was also prominent in other civic and professional work. He served as the first chairman of the Board of the National Easter Seal Society of Crippled Children and Adults in the U.S.A. and of the International Society for Crippled Children. He was a member of the board of managers of the Chicago Bar Association and its representative at the International Congress of Law at the Hague, and a committee member of the American Bar Association.

He received the Silver Buffalo Award from the Boy Scouts of America for distinguished service to youth, and was decorated by the Governments of Brazil, Chile, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, France and Peru.

We also have the extensive international net work to expand our humanitarian actions to all parts of the globe.

As we work together in 2000-01, let us never forget that our mission is to CREATE AWARENESS and TAKE ACTION in our clubs, our communities, and throughout the world.

REMINISCENCE OF ROTARY IN JAFFNA.

Brief History of Rotary.

The first Rotary Club in the World was organized in Chicago, Illinois, U.S.A on 23rd February 1905 by Paul Peter Harris, a young lawyer, who gathered together in a spirit of friendship and understanding a group of men, each of whom was engaged in a different form of service to the public at large. That basis of membership - one man from each business and profession in the community - still exists in Rotary. At first, the members of the new Club met in rotation at various places of businesses of the members and this suggested the name "Rotary".



Origin of Rotary in Jaffna

In pursuance of an irresistible request made by Jaffna Rotary Diamond Jubilee Souvenir Committee spearheaded by the young and energetic Rotarian AJG Jeyachandra, I undertook the task of tracing and writing about the origin of Rotary in Jaffna. But before that let me delve into the birth of Rotary in Asia.

The unwritten will of the greatest visionary of Rotary, Paul Harris, had its impact through the valiant efforts of James Wheeler Davidson in the history and development of Rotary in Asia. Mr. Davidson, a Rotarian and a dedicated member of the Rotary Club of Calgary, Canada, devoted a significant part of his life to spread the message of Rotary in the Orient. Commissioned by Rotary International, he started on a mission in 1928 accompanied by his wife Lilian and daughter Marjory to organize Rotary Clubs in the Middle-East and the Orient. It took almost three years and quarter million dollars of his own funds to execute the project.

He succeeded in introducing Rotary in 22 countries in the Orient. In the very last article, Paul Harris wrote and published in "The Rotarian" of February 1947, he has paid rich tributes to this Rotary's early ambassador by saying that "he is one who should be credited with having planted the seeds of Rotary far and wide and having thus brought about the establishment of Rotary as a world wide movement".

Rotary made its first great jump from the country of its birth to Asia in 1919. The first Asian Rotary Club was formed in Manila, the capital of Philippines. Shanghai, Kolkata and Tokyo followed it a few months later. These four Clubs remained lonely outposts for a considerable period. During the World War II many Asian Rotary Clubs including the Manila went underground.

The birth of Rotary in Sri Lanka dates back to 1929. Past district Governor Park Nadesan in his article to the souvenir issued on the occasion of the first conference of Rotary International held in Colombo in April 1985, recalls with happy memories of the halcyon days when his father the illustrious Sir Sangarapillai Pararajasingham was one of the charter members of the Rotary Club of Colombo.

True to the ideals of Rotary, which still exists in the formation of Rotary Clubs, a new Club could be brought into existence only through the courtesy of a sponsoring Rotary Club. The Rotary Club of Colombo which came into existence in July 5, 1929, was the sponsor of the Rotary Club of Jaffna. Thanks to the efforts of Rotarian Abraham Gardiner who was while being a member of Rotary Club of Colombo was also the district Governor. The district at that time included the whole of India and Sri Lanka.

In the Ides of November 1940, District Governor Abraham Gardiner visited Jaffna and while being here, discovered that there were excellent scope for a Rotary Club in the city. He therefore, approached the leading men of the locality and very shortly a preliminary meeting was held and a decision to organise a club made. A provisional committee

under the leadership of Rotarian, M.Prasad, the then Government Agent of Jaffna went into the forming of a Club. The charter list was closed on 7th December and the Club was duly organized as a provisional Club. The Club was assigned Charter No.5369 and was admitted to membership in Rotary International on the 8th of April 1941, and received its Charter on Saturday the 20th September 1941. The first Charter president of the Rotary Club of Jaffna was the distinguished Government Agent, M.Prasad. The colonial Governor of Sri Lanka, Sir Andrew Caldicot in felicitating the Club sent the following message. *" A Rotary club if it is healthy, is its own encouragement. Once the Club gets the push of its first results it will surely progress on its own momentum. I feel certain that you of the Jaffna Club have already begun to feel that push and that my message to you may therefore be one of congratulation rather than exhortation."*

The Jaffna Rotary Club started with twenty members initially, and grew in numbers year after year. Today we stand on the shoulders of the Rotary giants of the past. Let us have them see farther, because they stand on the shoulders of Rotarians of this decade, who are doing their level best to improve the quality of life wherever it may be. Out of all those who carried the everlasting torch of Rotary, the following held the position of presidency in our Club:

Special tributes may be paid to Rotarians Prasad, Nalliah, Dr.Gurusamy, Sathianathan, Doulatram, Kanagaratnam, Rajalingam Mahendran, Selvanathan, Sivalingam and Panchalingam for having held the portfolio of presidentship more than once.

To our knowledge, the Rotary Club of Jaffna made a landmark in the history of its existence only during the Presidentship of Rtn. Saravanapavan. It was during his period of leadership that the Jaffna Rotary Club won all the seven coveted awards of the Districts 3220, given by the Rotary International in recognition of outstanding services to the Club as well as to the community. It was claimed to be an unique event ever achieved by a club on a single Rotary year, anywhere in the world. I reproduce below a news item that appeared in the "Rotary News" a monthly Regional Magazine of Rotary International for Asia Zone II (January 1995) which highlighted some of the projects executed during his term of office.

First Conference

The first Interact Conference of Jaffna schools, and Leadership Training Seminar for Interactors, organized by the Rotary Club of Jaffna (Dt 3220) were held at the Jaffna Hindu College and St.Patrick's College respectively. Nearly 615 members drawn from 17 Interact Clubs attended the two-day meet, along with 18 student observers from the Union College Tellippallai, where an Interact Club was subsequently inaugurated.

PDG Suresh Melwani was the Chief Guest and Mr.K.Parameshwaran, Registrar of the University of Jaffna was the Guest of Honour. Rtn.E.Saravanapawan, President of the Rotary Club of Jaffna, presided, and released the Interact Directory. A highlight of the second day's programme was the formation of the interact emblem and the rotary theme "Be a friend" by the interactors in uniform. At the seminar, subjects such as Road safety, Environment Protection, Nutrition, Book Sense and Rotary Foundation were discussed.

As a departure from the past, this year all the members were given the benefit of the seminar, normally confined to Interact office-bearers. The participants spontaneously raised nearly Rs.6,000/- and donated the amount to the Rotary Foundation.

Our Club's six decades of service to our community and our country are bright with many examples of Rotary in action. Looking back on the accomplishments of the past, the Rotary Club of Jaffna embarked upon in due measures in originating and completing the various service projects it undertook.

Some of our major projects were —

1. Construction of a sick room and stage in the school hall at the Nuffield Deaf and Blind School at Kaithady
2. Donation of three violins, two sewing machines, one duplicating machine, three work benches and one set of carpentry tools to the said Deaf and Blind school at Kaithady.
3. Donation of a Tractor to the Trade School run by the Youth Council for Social and Economic Welfare.
4. Construction of bus passenger shelters at important positions in the Jaffna district Presentation of Rotary Challenge Shield annually to the best Scout Group in Jaffna.
6. Distribution of clothing and other items of gift to the inmates of the Home for the Aged at Kaithady, Hindu Orphanage at Thirunelvely, flood victims, Jaffna General Hospital, Udupidy Orphanage, Kala Nilayam Refugees' Camp at Killinochi and Ceylon Association for the Prevention of Tuberculosis.
7. Construction of a drinking water well at Manipay for the members of the less privileged in the community.
8. Conduction of free medical clinics to those who sought assistance.
9. Although free eye clinics were conducted monthly at various centres in the district by eminent Eye Surgeons in the names of Doctors S.Anandarajan and S.Kugathanan this project has since recently been discontinued as the current thinking was that it is not ethical to carry on projects solely belonging to other service organizations.

However the Rotary Club of Jaffna acknowledges with grateful thanks for the valuable services rendered by these surgeons and their associates to the community at large.

Besides all that have been mentioned above, our members both past and present have eloquently and silently rendered many a service of immeasurable value in their individual capacities. Our Club recalls their services with profound gratitude.

With the birth of the third Millennium year, we are on the threshold of meeting many a challenges in achieving the goals we may envisage. But I am sure that the present President A.Panchalingam and the incoming young and energetic President C.N.Vithiyatharan, both have the will and energy to continue or even better the cherished ideals of Rotary in this part of the world.

Rotary is a positive, dynamic, world- wide, international organization to promote the good of mankind, to have tolerance, to create goodwill and understanding between the people and nations of the world, to usher in an era of peace. *War to end war is futile.* So said the Indian Rotarian and the famous speech writer for the Indian Prime Ministers, PP PHF T.S.Ramanathan of the Courtallam Rotary Club in an article published to celebrate the Rotary District Conference. What a truism!

I offer to all those who are fortunate enough to be with us to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee Year 2001, my felicitations and my hearty good wishes to render many more years of dedicated service.

- 1990 Jan** - Inauguration of the first Rotaract Club in Jaffna. With the same enthusiasm Rtn. Selvanathan organized seven Rotary Village Corps in the Peninsula.
- 1990 Jun** - Won all the District awards. Normal life in the North and East of Sri Lanka became disrupted due to the out-break of war between the Government security forces and the Tigers.
- 1990 July** - Interactors collected and donated a substantial number of food items and clothing to the internally displaced people in the region.
- 1991 Feb** - Organised and conducted the first Leadership Training Seminar for Interact Officers at Kokuvil Hindu College. A sum of Rs.2,90,000/- was received from the Rotary

Foundation, by the Northern Province Cancer Society. This was a matching grant moved during the previous year by the Rotary Club of Hands worth. Dr.S.Jeganathan, President of the Northern Province Cancer Society **was given Paul Harris Fellow recognition.**

- 1991 April** - Mr.& Mrs Ambalavanar of Nallur, donated a buildable land at Athiady to our Club to put up a Rotary House. Celebrated the 50th Anniversary of the birth of Rotary in Jaffna at the Jaffna Hindu College premises. Held oratorical and eassay contests in English and Tamil to mark the occasion.
- 1991 May** - Donated Rupees One Lakh to the University of Jaffna in respect of a scholarship for a worthy scholar admitted annually to the University .
- 1991** - Sri Lanka severed its South Tamil Nadu link in The Rotary District and became a separate R.I. District 3220. Rotarian K.R.Ravindran becomes the new District Governor. Immediate past District Governor was Rtn.D.M.Swaminathan. Rtn.K.Sivaraj becomes the President while Rtn.E.Sara continues to hold the post of secretary for the second term as well. He also visits the South Asian Branch office at New Delhi.

- 1991 Aug** - Sponsored a palmyrah leaf Training project at Nallur by the grace of Palmyrah Development Board. Organised a Scientific Dress Making project to provide training for youths with the assistance of the National Youth Council in Jaffna.
- Sept.** Urumpirai RVC successfully completed a six month training course on the usage of banana fibre.
- Dec** - Organised a tree planting campaign. Engaged in tree planting. Jointly organized by the Jaffna Municipal Council and the Rotary. Another project was launched for displaced people under the Rehabilitation Scheme. RI president Rajendra Saboo visits Colombo. Some of our members who were in Colombo at that time and a young member straight from Jaffna attended the District Meeting. RI President Rajendra Saboo presided.
- 1992Jan** - Inaugurated the Rotaract Club of Jaffna Mid-Town, the second Rotaract Club to be organized in Jaffna. Distributed 250 shirts worth about Rs. 50,000/- among the needy in the Refuge Camps and Orphanages. This was sponsored by the Shabra Unico Ltd. First Rotary District Conference of the new RI District 3220 held at BMICH Colombo. Five members of the club attended.
- Feb** - Held AIDS prevention campaign.
- Apr** - Kokuvil RVC held Banana Fibre Exhibition on the 14th and 15th.

- May**
- Sponsored the event for legalizing unregistered marriages which was assisted by the ACLG, Jaffna. Organised a Career Guidance Seminar for students in the area. This was sponsored by the 'Uthayan' Newspapers Ltd
 - Published our Club Bulletin 'Chakkaram' each quarter of the year
 - In spite of the ban on essential commodities, printing materials, newsprint etc., the Interact Club of Jaffna Hindu Ladies' College published a club bulletin called 'Parithy' which was the first of its kind to be issued by an Interact Club of Jaffna.

- 1992/93**
- Veteran Rotarian PP V.T. Sivalingam becomes the President once again.
 - Issued a Commemorative First Day Cover to celebrate the 125th Anniversary of the birth of the Founder of Rotary, Paul Harris. The function was held on 19th April at the Jaffna Hindu College Camp Post Office.
 - Commenced the maintenance of the garden at the entrance to the Jaffna General Hospital OPD.
 - Organised and conducted the Leadership Training Programme for Interact Officers at the Jaffna Hindu Ladies' College. All Interact Presidents were presented with President's Collar for the first time in Jaffna.

- Apart from the weekly meetings of the Club, monthly Guest Speaker's day was conducted effectively. Organised a Vocational Excellence Award Ceremony. Awards were given to Mr.L.Gengatharan (MetalCraft), Mr.Benjamin (Theatre Make-up), And Mr.Sritharan (Wooden block making).
- Sponsored a Medical student to obtain training in Drug Abuse Preventive Campaign. Conducted awareness lectures on the same subject in the leading schools in the area

1993/94

- P.Selvanathan a past president becomes president for the second time. -Formation of Interact club at Urumpirai Hindu College.
- Vocational Excellence Awards Ceremony. Awards were given to Three men of professional excellence in their respective fields.
- Conducted Leadership Training Seminar for Interactors at Canagaratnam MMV. memorable Registration consisted of distribution Interact tie and Interact constitution.
- Sponsored the Annual TT tournament of the TT Association of the University of Jaffna.
- Conducted free medical camp at NRTB, Kondavil and Earlalai Community Centre.
- Conducted the first free eye cataract surgery camp at Kopay Govt Hospital in May 1994. A medical team headed by Consultant Eye Surgeon Dr.S.Kugathan assisted us.

The G.A.Mr.K. Manicavasagar graced the occasion. Subsequently two cataract camps were conducted successfully.

- Membership rose to 32 with six members being inducted during the year.
