MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

KANDY MUNICIPALITY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall on Saturday, July 17, 1897, at 8.30 a.m.

Present :—Hon. Mr. Allanson Bailey, Chairman ; Dr. Frederick Keyt ; W. W. Pole Fletcher, Esq. ; E. Reven, Esq. ; Alex. Philip, Esq. ; J. H. Sproule, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on June 19 were read and confirmed.

2. The following documents were laid on the table :—Statement of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund from close of 1896 to June 30, 1897 ; separate statements of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water-rate Accounts during the same period ; Return of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of June ; Progress Return of Work done by the Public Works Officer, and Health Officer's Return for the same month.

Resolved,—That the several statements, as required by section 90 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, be forwarded, with the Minutes of this Meeting, to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. Mr. E. Reven, pursuant to a notice, asked "if a register is kept of all dairymen and milk-vendors selling or supplying milk to residents within the Municipality, and if steps have been taken to inspect dairy premises."

The Chairman replied that such a register had not yet been prepared ; that no person engaged in the sale of milk having applied for registration as required by section 38 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1896, the Inspectors had been instructed to make lists of the persons engaged in the trade, but that before the lists were complete one of the Inspectors had been dismissed and another had resigned ; that the present Inspectors have been instructed to revise and complete the lists, and that in the meantime inspections of dairy premises were being made, and the owners noticed where necessary to comply with the by-laws relating to cattle stalls, &c. No special regulations had been passed under chapter II. of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896.

4. Mr. Beven, pursuant to notice, inquired "if a register is kept of all laundrymen washing for residents within the Municipality, and if inspections have taken place of laundry premises."

The Chairman stated that the reply to this question was, *mutatis mutandis*, the same as to the previous question.

5. Mr. Beven, pursuant to notice, asked "if arrangements are complete for the register of mortgages of property situated within the Municipality."

The Chairman replied that no application had been received to register any mortgage over property in the town of Kandy; that a specimen of the form of register used in Colombo had been procured; and that if the Council approved of the form, a sufficient number would be printed and bound. The form was laid on the table and approved by the Council.

6. Mr. Philip, pursuant to notice, asked, "in connection with the scheme for widening Victoria Drive, whether steps will be taken to, if possible, remove elsewhere the bathing-places at the side of the lake," and moved for papers, if any, relating to the various matters now engaging attention with a view to improving the carriage way.

The Chairman replied that when the road was widened it would be necessary to remove the bathing-place referred to, and that he would communicate with the authorities of the Malwatta Vihare. The Chairman stated further that there were no papers other than those already laid on the table.

7. Read letter from the Superintendent of Works regarding the roads and paths in Udawattakele.

8. Read Health Officer's report on latrine on No. 83, Trincomalee street.

On the motion of Mr. Beven, seconded by Dr. Keyt, it was resolved that the Chairman be specially empowered under the provisions of section 33 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896, to order the closing of the cesspit and the substitution thereof of a dry-earth closet.

(a) 13 ft. barrel drains rebuilt, Colombo street; repairing 9 manhole covers, Ward street and Colombo street; cleaning grating round the town streets; clearing 2,301 ft. of barrel drains and removing silt, Trincomalee street; Temple street barrel drain watcher.

(b) 16 cubes of metal broken; 83 squares of cooly lines whitewashing and repairing, railway; shifting tiles, cooly lines, Mahaiyawa; 11 ft. bridge repairing, Hantane road.

(c) Removing 13 cubes of landslips and silt from drains, Davy road and Lady Anderson's road.

(d) Clearing 3 miles of roadside drains and jungle, and reducing sides, Lady Horton's road; cutting ant hills, Lady Horton's road; clearing silt from barrel drains, Lady Horton's road; watcher; removed 4 cubes of landslips and silt from drains, Lady Horton's road.

(e) Repairing tools; removed 7 cubes of landslips and drain silt from Halloluwa and Bahirowekanda roads.

(f) Whitewashing 11 squares of privy, Torrington road and Ward street; whitewashing 21 squares of slaughter-house and exposing shed; shifting tiles, Municipal Council buildings; repairing and fitting up planks to King street well; cleaning and painting King street well and bandstand; shifting tiles, bandstand; clearing jungle round Municipal Council buildings.

(g) Watering town streets, Peradeniya road and railway approach.

(h) Whitewashing 10 squares market privy and 30 squares market building; re-building 10 ft. barrel drains; concreting 25½ squares market verandah; painting market ironwork; transporting metal to the market; cutting and removing gravel from market verandah; fitting bolts and keys to beef stalls; 1 square concreting floor of privy.

(j) Weeding and attending to plants.

(k) Clearing jungle and drains and removing silt from bathing tanks.

(l) ¾ mile clearing side drains, jungle, and reducing sides, Lady Gordon's road; 7 cubes of landslips and drain silt removed, Lady Gordon's and Lady MacCarthy's roads.

(m) Cleaning and painting two fountains, Pavilion street and market.

(n) Watcher.

(o) Cutting grass, recreation ground and esplanade; weeding esplanade.

(p) Removing silt from side drains and flushing them in Peradeniya road, Katugastota road, Trincomalee street, Kirk street, Castle Hill street, Colombo street, and Colombo road.

(q) 12 cubes of paving stones, Hantane road; 9 cubes building wall, Hantane road; 36 cubes excavating and 10 cubes blasting rock.

(r) Transporting metal, slaughter-house; breaking floor, exposing shed; 60 ft. concreting drains, building exposing shed; ¼ cube catchpit, exposing shed; ¼ cube of excavating foundation, exposing shed; transporting big stones, slaughter-house.

(s) Mining and blasting Lady Anderson's road; transporting big stones, slaughter-house.

(t) ¼ cube building footbridge lake No. 2; fitting bridge, lake; 2 cubes building barrel drain, House No. 27, Peradeniya road; 13 cubes of earth filling, slaughter-house; ¼ cube foundation building, slaughter-house.

(u) Advance in cash on cement, Rs. 98.

(v) 35 ft. barrel drain re-built, old Matale road, in May; balance due paid in cash Rs. 15; materials, chunam, &c.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on May 29 were read and confirmed.

2. The following documents were laid on the table:—Statement of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund from close of 1896 to May 31, 1897; separate statements in respect of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water-rates accounts during the same period; Return of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate, and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of May; Progress Report of Work done by the Public Works Officer; and Health Officer's Report for the same month.

Resolved,—That the several statements, as required by section 90 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, be forwarded, with the Minutes of this Meeting, to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. Pursuant to notice Mr. R. W. Jonklaas moved "that the supervision of scavenging, whether by Municipal Council coolies or by contractor, be placed in the hands of the Health Officer, and that his allowance be raised from Rs. 500 to Rs. 1,000 per annum."

5. Mr. Jonklaas, with the leave of the Council, omitted the latter portion of the next motion standing in his name, and moved "that a return of artificers now employed by the Council be laid on the table with a note of the work done by each, and the rate of pay."

Seconded by Mr. Vanderwall and carried.

The return, which had already by order of the Chairman been prepared, was laid on the table.

10. Mr. Vanderwall, pursuant to notice, asked whether in making the recent assessment of houses within the Municipality the rule as to "annual value," as defined by section 3 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896, had been observed.

The Chairman replied that the assessors report that the definition had been attended to.

11. Mr. Vanderwall, pursuant to notice, moved "that permanent arrangements be made for sweeping and keeping clean the roads and paths in Udawattakele, including Lady Horton's walk, Lady MacCarthy's road, and Lady Gordon's road."

Seconded by Mr. Gibbon and carried.

12. Mr. Vanderwall, pursuant to notice, moved "for a return showing the number of coolies and cart employed by the Council in latrine work, with a note of the heads of expenditure under which they are charged."

Seconded by Mr. Beven and carried.

The return was laid on the table.

13. Mr. Vanderwall, pursuant to notice, moved "for a return of watchers and overseers employed by the Council, with dates of the appointment of the latter."

Seconded by Mr. Beven and carried.

The return was laid on the table.

14. The Council proceeded to ballot for a Member of the Standing Committee in the place of Mr. Murrays who has ceased to be a Member of the Council. Mr. Pole Fletcher was duly elected.

Health Officer's Report for May, 1897.

With the exception of a few drains and culverts being repaired and cleared, and the public latrines being kept in a more sanitary state, the town of Kandy, regarding nearly every item I mentioned in my last health report, remains in the same insanitary condition.

Owing to the alertness and devotion to his duty of Acting Inspector Toussaint the night soil is now removed and buried; but unless constant supervision is exercised the coolies do not carry out their duties, and I have frequently reported them during last month.

No infectious diseases were prevalent during May.
