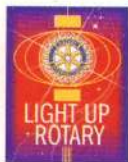

Gift of Hearing

Project value:

This is a new signature project begun in 2012/2013 with the support of Mr. Gunter Volkman of Denmark who provided high quality hearing aids and audio equipment for hospitals to RC Kandy from two world-renowned Danish firms. As of July 2013, the club has distributed 1,705 hearing aids to needy people around the country and has gifted 11 audiometers, a tympanometer and a special printer to selected hospitals. Several other Rotary Clubs of the District have participated in the distribution of both hearing aids and equipment. Hearing aids were also given to President Mahinda Rajapakse and Mrs Rajapakse for charities which operate under their auspices. The worth of the project to date is estimated at around Rs. 129 million. Help them Walk Again

The Rotary Club of Kandy works with the Centre for Handicapped, Kundasale to provide limb, wheelchairs and prosthetic and orthotic devices to needy people all over Sri Lanka. The limbs are custom-made at the Centre. The Centre also disposes a mobile unit which travels to other parts of Sri Lanka for preliminary work and final fittings. In 2013/2014 limbs or mobility devices were made available to around 220 people at a total

The cost of the project was Rs. 315,700/-. The funding for the project was received from the Interact Club of Westcliff High School for Girls in the UK. Three Rotarians and 6 members of Inner Wheel participated.

Ten million rupees has been disbursed through the Doshodaya Development Finance Company (DDFC) and the Regional Development Bank to finance loans to small and micro business men and women in various parts of the island for use in starting up or improving business ventures. More than 140 people have benefitted from these loans thus far. In a new departure 18 handicapped people and two poor women have been given small loans of Rs. 25, 000/- each to help them earn a livelihood. Nine individual loans have also been disbursed on guarantees by club members.

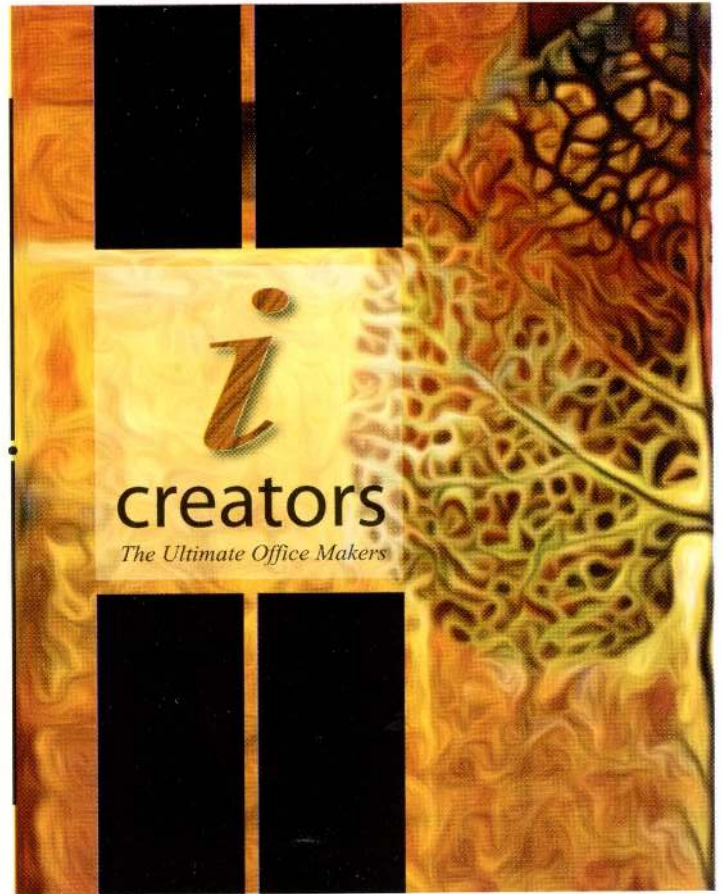

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ROTARY CLUB OF KANDY

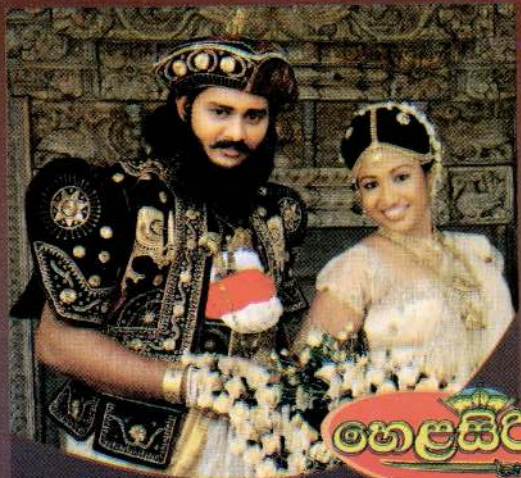

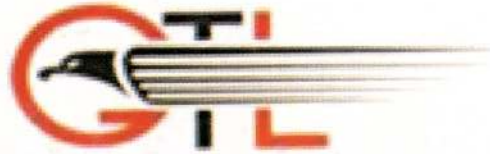

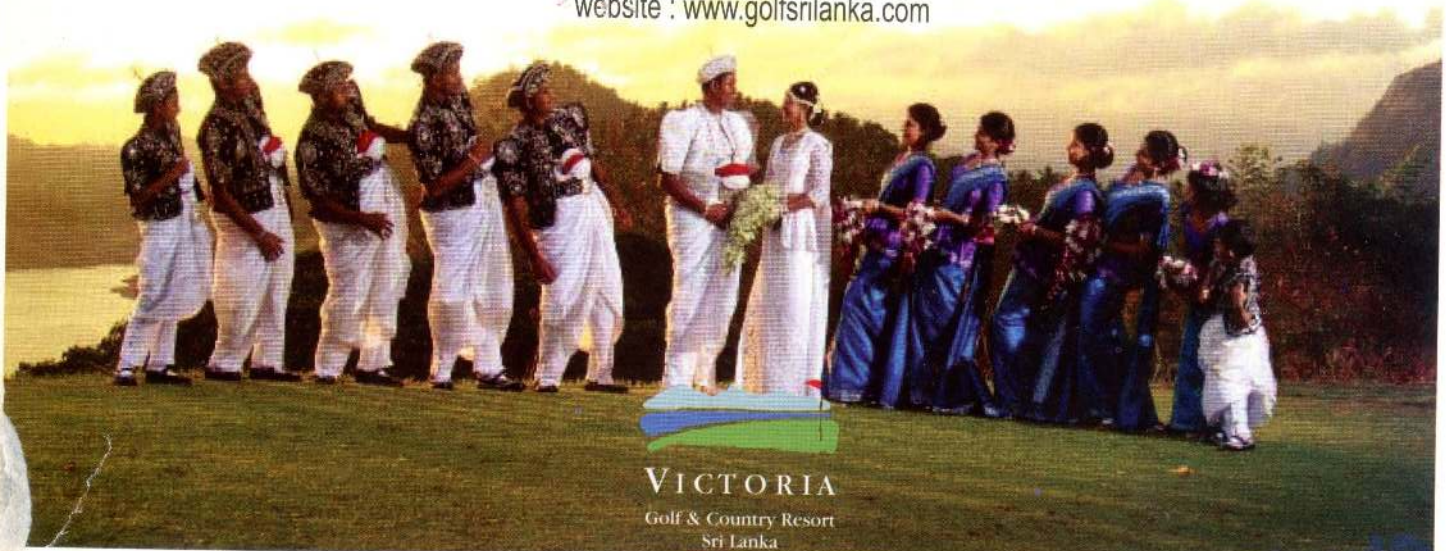
