Dottice is hereby given that a meeting will be held at 12 noon on January 31, 1898, at the Batticaloa Kachcheri, to elect three Unofficial Members of the Local Board of Health and Improvement, Batticaloa, for the years 1898 and 1899, under the provisions of Ordinances Nos. 7 of 1876 and 27 of 1890.

OTICE is hereby given to persons residing within the limits of the Local Board, Negombo, that the Board, acting under the provisions of section 3 of Ordinance No. 9 of 1887, has imposed an annual tax, payable in six days' labour, upon all persons residing within the limits of the Local Board who would have been liable, under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, to the performance of labour for the maintenance of the roads or other public means of communication by land or by water, if the Ordinance No. 7 of 1876 had not been passed. Such labour may be commuted by a money payment of Rs. 2 in the town of Negombo and the islands of Pitipana and Munnakkara, and Re. 1.50 in the island

of Duwa, on or before the 28th day of February, 1898, after that date the payment will be Rs. 4 and Rs. 3 respectively per head.
