#### DRAFT **ORDINANCES**

# MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:

> An Ordinance for making final provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1897.

Preamble.

THEREAS by an Ordinance No. 13 of 1897 it was enacted that a sum of Rs. 1,138,481.06 should be charged upon the revenue of this island for the Supplementary Contingent Services of the year One thousand Eight hundred and Ninetyseven, in addition to the sum of Rs. 15,406,340 provided by the Ordinance No. 17 of 1896: And whereas an expenditure of Rs. 82,823.59 was incurred and brought to account for the Contingent Services of the year 1897, for which provision is not made by the aforesaid Ordinances: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 82,823.59 charged ns, 82,823 so charged upon the revenue of this island of the year 1897 for the final Supplementary Contingent Service of that year.

That a sum not exceeding Eighty-two thousand Eigh hundred and Twenty-three rupees and Fifty-nine cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this island of the said year 1897, for the services hereinafter mentioned; the said expenditure being in conformity with the schedule hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract:
