An Ordinance to further amend "The Municipal Councils' Ordinance, 1887."

Preamble.

SAMORE.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Municipal Councils' Ordinance," No. 7 of 1887, hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance," as amended by Ordinance No. 26 of 1890: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Addition of new section to section 160 (a) of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887 as amended by Ordinance No. 26 of 1890.

1 After section 160 (a) of the principal Ordinance as amended by section 12 of the Ordinance No. 26 of 1890, the following section shall be added and numbered 160 (b), namely—

The municipal council, with the sanction of the Governor in Executive Council, may contract with any person or persons, corporation, or company to supply the municipality with electric or other light, and to construct all necessary works therefor, upon such terms and conditions as may be approved by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

Short title.

2 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Municipal Councils' Amendment Ordinance, 189," and shall be read as one with the principal Ordinance as amended by Ordinance No. 26 of 1890.
