Pacific Ocean—Sandwich Islands—Oahu—Honolulu approach—Intended Light on Leahi (Diamond Head).

The British Admiralty has given notice (No. 150 of 1898) that information has been received that a light

will be exhibited from a lighthouse to be erected on Leahi (Diamond Head), eastern approach to Honolulu:

Leahi (Diamond Head) light will be a third order dioptric fixed light with sectors showing white over an arc of 184° and red over two arcs of 13°, one on each side of the white sector; it will be elevated 147 ft. above the sea, and visible in clear weather from a distance of 20 miles.

The lighthouse, an open framework tower, will be situated about 250 yards westward of the signal station.

Approximate position: lat. 21° 15′ 35″ N., long. 157′ 48′ 40′ W.

Mud Flat Buoy discontinued.


Notice is hereby given that the mud flat buoy, No. 2 in the published list of 1898, will be removed on or about
