



National Parks

Rich in biodiversity, Sri Lanka has several extensive National Wildlife Parks. Within these protected areas, visitors can appreciate the thriving wildlife that include mammals like elephants, leopards, reptiles, birds and amphibians.

History

The Island has a proud and rich history that dates back millennia. Visit the ancient kingdoms of Anuradhapura, Polonnaruwa, Kandy as well as the Sigiriya Rock Fortress and marvel at the ingenuity of the minds that built complex buildings, tanks, stupas and statues hundreds of years ago. The Ruwanweli Seya, the Sri Maha Bodi and other historical sites in Anuradhapura; ancient sites like Lankatilaka Viharaya, Nissanka Mandapa, the Vatadage in Polonnaruwa and the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic have a story of their own to tell.

Beaches

The coastal areas of Sri Lanka are crowned by golden sandy beaches. The southern coast offers popular beaches such as Unawatuna, Mirissa, and Hikkaduwa; the east offers vibrant beaches of Arugambay, Whisky Point, Passekudah and Nilaveli; to the north is the Casuarina Beach; while the west has city beaches such as Mount Lavinia and Galle Face and the more laid back Negombo beaches. Lounge in the sun, play in the sand or take a dip in the cool waters of the Indian Ocean.

Surf Points

At several points off the coastal areas, the waves and weather conditions are perfect to enjoy surfing. Sri Lanka has breaks that can be enjoyed by beginners, intermediates, enthusiasts as well as professionals at Weligama, Hiriketiya, Arugambay and Whisky Point and several other surf points. Deftly manoeuvre your board through the waves and enjoy the camaraderie of your fellow surfers.

Religion

With a great reverence for every religion, Sri Lanka is a country where people of all faith live in harmony. Throughout the island, there are many historical places of worship that are venerated by Sri Lankans and other nationals. Visit the beautiful temples, kovils such as Nallur, churches and mosques that are located around the island.



Kelaniya Raja Maha Viharaya is an iconic place of reverence in Sri Lanka

EVERY January, the streets of Kelaniya resound with the cracking of whips, rhythmic sounds of traditional Sri Lankan drumming and the reverent cries of sadhu, sadhu as the Duruthu Perahera takes to the streets. It is proceeded by two smaller processions - Udamaluwe Perahera and the Dathu Perahera respectively - held on January 17 and January 18.

On January 19, the spectacular Maha Perahera or Randoli Perahera will leave the Kelaniya Raja Maha Viharaya, Throngs of devotees and spectators eagerly line the streets and anticipates the first thunder-like crack of the whip that heralds the oncoming perahera. Then the shimmering fireballs interrupt the gathering darkness.

As the hewisi bands serenade the devotees, standard bearers carry the provincial flags of Sri Lanka. Following them, the Peramuna Rala, a Kanyan chieftan perched atop a caparisoned elephant makes his way through the streets. In his wake troupes of dancers perform traditional Sri Lankan dances. In between different segments of the procession, richly adorned elephants elegantly step in

tune to the music. The dazzling display pays homage to the Buddha, and is accompanied by the pageants for the Gods Vishnu, Vibhishana and Kataragama - the guardian deities of the

A reverent silence spreads over the gathered crowds as the majestic temple tusker comes into view. Borne on its howdah, is the beautifully adorned casket of the sacred relics of the Buddha. As the gentle elephant passes, the devotees raise clasped hands and chant sadhu in worship.

Held annually in the month of January, the Perahera pays tribute to the Buddha, who arrived in Sri Lanka for the first time on the Duruthu full moon poya day over two millennia ago.

A grand procession of cultural arts and traditions of the island nation, it inspires reverence in the hearts of the onlookers.

After travelling through the routes of the city, the sacred relics are once again placed within its chamber. With that, the festivities come to a close until the first full moon of the next year. T

ON the festival day, even before the break of dawn, Hindus spruce up and decorate their abodes with fresh banana leaves and garlands of mango leaves or Mavillai Thoranam. A makeshift hearth is arranged in front of the house to prepare the 'Pongal', a delectable dish prepared using a range of lavish ingredients including red/white raw rice, milk, jaggery, mung dhal, cashew, raisins, and ghee.

Signifying prosperity and fortune, two freshly-cut sugarcane plants are also positioned on either side of the hearth. The floor is adorned with vibrant murals – a unique traditional art called *Kolam*.

As the rising sun signals the dawn of the auspicious hour, from the oldest of the family to the youngest, all gather around the makeshift hearth to witness the milk bubbling from the pot. The delightful sight of creamy milk overflowing the pot heralds good fortune drawing the partwarming cries of 'pongalo pongal', meaning 'overflowing' abundance. Afterwards, the delicious pongal rice is cooked and the first portion


Families visit temples to pay homage to the divinity and to seek their blessings in order to thrive in the forth-coming cultivation season as well.

Pongal rice and sweetmeats are shared among relatives as a way of strengthening relationships and inculcating new bonds.

The day following Thai Pongal is dedicated to the cattle and is known as 'Mattu Pongaf.

The harvest feast is a time to thank, a time to rejoice as well as a time to reflect. Therefore, Hindus do not forget to show their gratitude to the cattle who helped plough the paddy fields and reap the bounty of the land. On the *Mattu Pongal* day, the animals are cared for, their horns painted, necks garlanded and stomachs satiated with pongal delights.

A thanksgiving for a plentiful harvest, Thai Pongal rejoices the true spirit of gratitude while rejuvenating bonds. T






Chudamani Clowes is a London based Sri Lankan artist. The artist shares her thoughts, "In my title Sub-marine I wish to render visible those issues that are invisible and cast under the surface. In this work I compare the migration of coral with that of humans across the oceans to highlight migration's causes, from globalization, human conflict and environmental issues. I want to address the concepts and ideas on migration by using painting, collage and printmaking. My work seeks to examine the phenomena of migration, and the forces of attraction that have led so many to risk these journeys through passages of ungoverned spaces. These are abstract paintings, made with a cornucopia of colours and shapes. Multi-layered and textured, forming a mixed media surface of aquiline colour. I have used a range of techniques such as collage, printmaking and painting. Expect the unexpected in such a sub-aquatic environment, for these are journeys in a kaleidoscope world. Inspect the exquisite colours that shimmer like jewels attracting and hypnotising the traveller. Choosing submarine coral highlights the instability and volatility of the eco-system under threat from pollution and global warming."

Sanjeewa Kumara's exhibition features a fusion of lush, sensual imagery, and the collision between Western pop culture and the Sri Lanka's post colonial legacy.

Kumara states, "Today painting is recognised as a traditional media. But painting still has specific capacities of its own to discover and exploit. But 'picture' implies space one goes into. I am moving more and more in the direction that I don't want to refer to my images as paintings. I myself suggest the term 'picture'. Pictures are evoking imaginary spheres and they go beyond amusement or exotic. The uncanny - the fantastic - the marvellous the hesitation - the supernatural and the Uncertainty is very important to my work".

He aims to synchronise diverse historical elements into a visual pastiche, creating a unique visual language that he terms 'non western western art'. He traces his artistic influence to cave painters, saving, "I love the sense that I'm doing the same thing that people have always done." 

SOUTHERN Sri Lanka is not only popular for its endless number of exotic beaches as well as religious sites such as the *Paravi Duwa* Temple. Traversing further inland from Matara, is the quaint town of Deniyaya. Travellers taking the hairpin bends can experience the cooling climes of the verdant hills and rows of neatly pruned tea estates. The mist-enveloped town has a charming surrounding with cascading beauties in the nearby vicinity.

Taking the bends, one can witness frequent sightings of the flourishing fishtail palms also known as jaggery palms, camouflaged by the dense forest. The verdant mountains, lush greenery and cooling climes provide a surreal feel. Tappers climb the trees that grow to an average height of 40ft to tap the kitul mala. Morning hours are the best time to collect the sap of the palm tree. If you wish to see the making of the kithul pani, it is ideal for you to visit in the early morning hours to see the kitul tappers in action. Once the sap is collected, it is brought down to be boiled to a fluid consistency, which once left to cool becomes the *kitul pani*. The cooled *pani* is packed in bottles and distributed to many places. Those in search of authentic *kitul pani* can enjoy this sweet delicacy with hoppers, curd or yoghurt, a wonderful combo!

While there's plenty more to explore, a good hike to reach the cascading beauty of the Patna is what matters.
