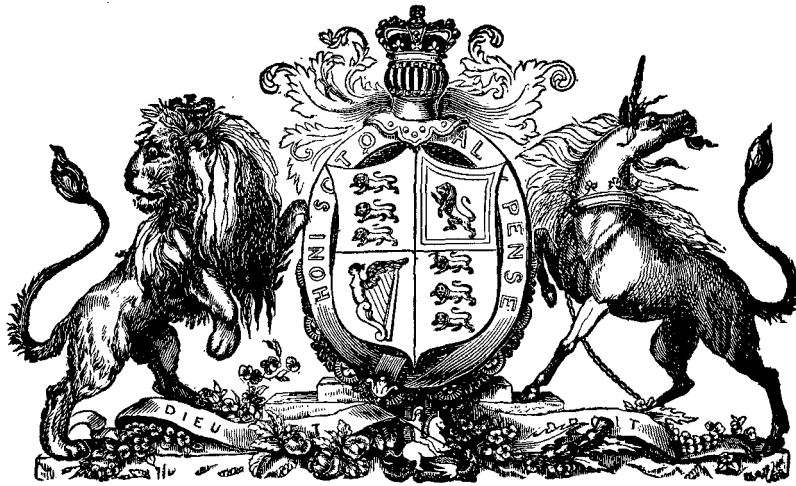

MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, June 12, 1896.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated June 6, 1896.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Captain F. Bayley; Mr. A. Forsyth; Brigade Surgeon Lieut.-Col. A. W. Duke; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgam; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of May 8, 1896, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of May 8, 1896, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Brigade Surgeon Lieut.-Col. Duke moved “that the latrine adjacent to the meat market at Slave Island be removed to another site to be selected and approved by the Municipal Council.”

This motion was, by leave of Council, amended as follows: “that all latrines adjacent to markets be removed to other sites to be approved by the Municipal Council.”

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. C. M. Fernando and carried.

2. Pursuant to notice Mr. R. H. Morgam moved “that a market be established in a suitable spot at Bambalapitiya.”

This motion was, by leave of Council, amended as follows: “that a market be established in a suitable spot at Bambalapitiya on a site to be selected by the Chairman.”

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. Alvis and carried.

3. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. M. Fernando presented an application from Hon. H. L. Wendt, and moved that the same be considered and disposed of.

The notice of motion was, by leave of Council, amended as follows:—“To present an application from Hon. H. L. Wendt, and to move that he be allowed to maintain the boat-house standing on the border of the lake at Vauxhall street in its present position.”

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. C. Perera and carried. The Chairman dissenting.

4. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. M. Fernando inquired what steps had been taken to acquaint the dhobies of Colombo with the provisions of the new Ordinance affecting laundries.

The Chairman explained in detail the action which had been taken.

5. The following recommendations from the Standing Committee of May 22 and June 5, 1896, were laid before the Council :—

May 22, 1896.

- (12) Tenders for lease of the premises occupied by the late Superintendent of Bridge-of-Boats. The highest tender is accepted until the close of the current year, from which time fresh tenders are to be invited.
- (42) Relieving Clerk.
Resolved that the Council be recommended to approve the provisional appointment of an additional clerk in the Secretary's Department on Rs. 30 per mensem from June 1, 1896.

June 5, 1896.

- (8) Papers relating to the purchase of new grab for dredger.
Resolved (the Chairman dissenting) that application be made to the Government for a grant of Rs. 1,500 to meet the expense of a new grab for a dredger used in the lake.
- (12) Papers relating to proposed road to Wekande.
Resolved that Colonial Secretary's letter No. 47 of May 30, 1896, be laid before the Council in connection with the Committee's 8th resolution of this date.
- (15) Application from Madampitiya slaughter-house keeper for an extra cooly.
Resolved that the employment of an additional cooly, provisionally, be sanctioned.
- (16) Further remarks by the Auditor-General on completion report on estimate No. 84 of 1894, and on the accounts of the Works Department for February and September, 1895.
Resolved that the Council be recommended to authorize the charges in question.
- (25) By-laws on bakeries.
Resolved that the Council be informed of the Attorney-General's opinion.

Mr. Alvis moved "that the recommendations contained in paragraphs 12 and 42 of the Minutes of the Standing Committee of May 22, and in paragraphs 15 and 16 of the Minutes of the Standing Committee of June 5, 1896, be adopted."

Mr. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

Mr. C. M. Fernando "moved that the recommendation contained in paragraph 8 of the Minutes of the Standing Committee of June 5, 1896, be adopted."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

Resolved,—That the Council do go into Committee on the by-laws made on May 8, 1896.

Resolved—(1) That the by-laws numbered 1, 2, 3, and 4 be deleted. (2) That in by-laws numbered 5 and 6 the word "used" be substituted for the word "licensed." (3) That in by-law No. 9 the words "before it is licensed" be deleted, and that the words "unless refused by the Government" be substituted therefor.

The Council having resumed, it was resolved that the amendments agreed to in Committee be adopted.

6. Further reports dated May 13 and June 10, 1896, of the Special Committee on tramways were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report of the Special Committee of May 13, 1896, be adopted."

Mr. C. M. Fernando seconded.—Carried.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved "the adoption of the 1st paragraph of the Special Committee's report of June 10, and that the plans and specification referred to in paragraph 3 be circulated."

Mr. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

7. A report dated May 20, 1896, of the Special Committee, on taking over the Liveramentu and other extra-mural cemeteries, was laid before Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Morgan moved "the adoption of the report."

Mr. C. M. Fernando seconded.—Carried.

8. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to May 31, 1896, and a Progress Report of Work done during May, 1896, were laid on the table.

9. A letter No. 46 of May 30, 1896, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the duplication of the main pipe from Labugama to Maligakanda, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera "moved that the receipt of the letter be acknowledged with thanks."

Captain Bayley seconded.—Carried.

10. The question of a site for a cremation ground in the Cinnamon Gardens was deferred.

11. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for February, 1896, received with letter No. 63 of May 28, 1896, were laid on the table.

12. The City Analyst's report dated May 30, on the town water for May, 1896, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

13. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gun-powder for June, 1896, were laid on the table.
