Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on August 27, 1896, at 4 p.m.

- 2. The subject of giving some additional remuneration to Mr. J. W. Erskine, for his services while acting as Superintendent of Works, was brought up for consideration, when it was moved by the Chairman "that Mr. Erskine be paid half pay of the present office and horse allowance, less the amount already drawn, viz., Rs. 260, for his services as Acting Superintendent."

(e) Repaired Leyn Baan street and Lighthouse street side drains; filled up a breach in the main drain of Lighthouse street; paid for stone slabs; repaired side drains in Great Moderbay street.

(f) Paid compensation for land taken up for a drain; prepared kitul spouts; provided 1,000 stone slabs for the Pettigalla-ela work; repaired two drains near the fish market; cleared drains; building retaining wall to Kepu-ela;

built five culverts; repaired Pettigalla drain.

(g) Repaired railings to Fort new gate; paid for 10 cubes stone; repaired fire engine; built a platform opposite green market; built a barrier opposite railway station; painted rampart seats; refixed and painted barrier;

(h) Cost of materials to screen trees from the wind; provided iron chain and padlock to gate; cost of labour.

(j) Built a new latrine at Pettigalawatta; cost of survey of land at China Garden.

(k) Repaired twenty scavenging and hand carts, four water carts, two latrine carts; bought three wheelbarrows; built a new latrine cart.

Sanitary Officer's Report for the Quarter ended June 30, 1896.

The General Health was better than during the previous quarter. The epidemic of malarial fever has died The General Health was better than during the previous quarter. The epidemic of malarial fever has died out, but the old victims get relapses upon the action of some exciting causes. Cases of chickenpox were reported from the different wards. Two cases of smallpox occurred at Ettiligoda. The first case was one Hettihewage Seadoris, who returned from Bombay on May 31, and developed smallpox a few days after his arrival here. The patient was isolated as soon as information was given, and the necessary precautions were taken to prevent an epidemic. The second patient, the father and nurse of first patient, however, escaped vaccination, and developed smallpox after the usual incubation period; while the inmates and neighbours vaccinated escaped smallpox.

Reference to my last report will show the most urgent sanitary improvements required in the different wards. In Wards Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 5 there is a scarcity of privy accommodation, and consequently the waste lands and the

In Wards Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 5 there is a scarcity of privy accommodation, and consequently the waste lands and the seabeach are used as a convenience, thereby causing a nuisance. To prevent this nuisance notices should be served

on householders to provide privy accommodation.

House drainage in these Wards is altogether neglected.

Scavenging and Street Sweeping were not satisfactory. The proposed contract system will give better results. Municipal Latrines were kept clean.
