MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, September 11, 1896.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated September 5, 1896.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Hon. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Mr. A. Forsyth; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of August 21, 1896, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of August 21, 1896, be confirmed.
