PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ARTHUR ELIBANK HAVELock, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by "The Courts Ordinance, 1889," it is amongst other things enacted that Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court shall be holden by one of the Judges thereof for each of the Circuits into which the Island is by the said Ordinance divided for the purposes of the administration of justice, for the hearing, trying, and determining of all prosecutions which shall be commenced against any person for or in respect of any crime or offence, or alleged crime or offence—

"For the Midland Circuit three times at least at Kandy, and any other Sessions at such other places in such Circuit as the Governor, after previous consultation with the Judges, shall appoint; such Sessions commencing at Kandy on March 10, on August 1, and on December 1 in every year":

And whereas it appears to Us expedient that a Criminal Session of the Supreme Court should, on the day hereinafter mentioned, be holden at Kurunégala, one of the places within the said Midland Circuit in the said Ordinance mentioned:

Now know Ye that We, the said Governor, after previous consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, do hereby direct and appoint that a Session of the Supreme Court, in its criminal jurisdiction, shall be holden at Kurunégala on or about Monday, the Twenty-second day of August, 1892.

WHEREAS by the 5th section of "The Cemeteries Ordinance, 1862," it is enacted that the Governor may, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, when to him it shall seem advisable, by Proclamation establish a General Cemetery for the burial of the dead within such limits as shall be specified and defined in such Proclamation:

And whereas it seems to the Governor advisable to establish a General Cemetery to be used by the residents of the places hereinafter enumerated for the burial of their dead, within the limits hereinafter specified and defined:

Now know Ye that We, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby proclaim that the land set forth in the schedule A hereto, within the limits therein specified and defined, shall be and the same is hereby established a General Cemetery to be used by the residents of the places enumerated in schedule B hereto for the burial of their dead, as from and after the first day of August, 1892.

Rule No. 2.—No animal shall be slaughtered at the slaughter-house except between the hours of 5 P.M. and 6 P.M.

Rule No. 3.—The persons who have used the slaughter-house each day shall, before 6 A.M. the following day, thoroughly cleanse the slaughter-house and premises, and shall bury all blood, refuse, and offal. These duties shall be performed according to the direction of the Assistant Superintendent of Police.

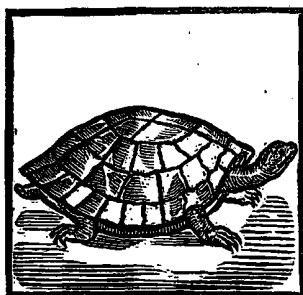

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, June 10, 1892.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated June 4, 1892.

Present:—Mr. C. E. D. Pennycuik, Acting Mayor and Chairman; Dr. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Mr. E. Walker; Major R. E. Firminger; and Mr. C. Perera.

The Minutes of May 31, 1892, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of May, 31, 1892, be confirmed.

1. The discussion of the motion standing in Mr. Walker's name was, by leave of Council, deferred to a later hour.

5. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to May 31, 1892, and a Progress Report of Work done during the same period were submitted.

6. Letters Nos. 80 and 82, dated May 25 and 31, 1892, from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, were read intimating that the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to order that a fee of Rs. 500 be levied annually upon each arack tavern within the Municipality from July 1, 1893, such fee being paid over to the Municipal Council; also that, in view of the report of the Waterworks Engineer, that it will be necessary in the near future to provide additional piping for maintaining the water supply to the City, the Legislative Council will be asked to provide a further sum of Rs. 10,000 to be contributed annually by the Government, on the condition that the license fees and the Government contribution be paid by the Municipal Council into a fund to be vested in trustees for providing additional pipes from the reservoir to Colombo.

Mr. Walker here begged leave to make his motion "that His Excellency the Governor be respectfully requested to appoint a Special Commission (1) to consider the Colombo Municipal Revenue and Expenditure; (2) to apportion the respective interest of the Government and the Municipal Council in the same.

Dr. Kynsey seconded.—Carried.

8. The Sanitary Officer's report for the first quarter of 1892 was submitted.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report be referred to the Standing Committee."

Dr. Kynsey seconded.—Carried.

9. An application dated September 19, 1890, from Don Allis Appuhamy, for the purchase of a strip of land belonging to the Council, in extent 45 square ft., situated in St. Sebastian Hill, opposite premises No. 27, was submitted.

Resolved,—That the Chairman be authorised to apply to the Governor in Executive Council to sanction the sale of the land in question.

10. The Auditor-General's remarks on the Council accounts for January, 1892, were laid on the table.

11. The reports of the Inspectors on licensed carriages and on kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for June, 1892, were laid on the table.
