PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

As the President of the Jaffna Central College Old Boys and Girls Association UK, I am honoured and privileged to welcome you all to our 35th Founders Day Dinner Dance. First and foremost, I would like to thank my talented, enthusiastic and young team for their support, especially the Social Committee for the time and effort they have invested in making this event a success.

Due to us not being able to run this important event for the past two years because of Covid, this event is all the more a special occasion and one that brings our old boys and girls across the country together.

This year our committee set out on achieving three main goals academically:

- a.O-Level scholarship programme
- b. A-Level scholarship programme
- c. Accessible E-Learning resources.

The top 30 O-Level students in the year were awarded a monthly scholarship of Rs. 3000 for their educational expenses. In order to determine the O-Level scholarship programme awardees, the top 12 students from the overall year along with the top 3 children from each of the 6 divisions were selected. The success of this programme has meant that we will endeavour to carry this on every year.

The JCC 1987 A/L batch is sponsoring 13 students through the Pon Vipulananthan Memorial Scholarship Programme. Alongside this, the JCC UK OBA organising a sponsorship for an additional talented 10 A/L students from other schools willing to study in Jaffna Central College. They will receive the sum of SL Rs. 7000 per month for 28 months, total of Rs. 196,000 per student. JCC OBA UK will spend Rs 1.96 Million for 10 A/L students for a period of 2 years. This is an outstanding goal to raise the standard of our school.

We are able to run these scholarship programmes by generous donations by our old students. I would like to thank all those who contributed, especially Agash Sivalingam who kindly donated £5000 towards these initiatives. The goal of these scholarship programmes is to grow them year on year to bring glory to our Alma Mater.

We are also in the process of producing online E-Learning resources to help our overall mission of improving our school's academic results. Through this, every student will benefit by accessing necessary information and achieve better grades and University entrance in their desired field.

The importance of focusing and rewarding academic achievement has been seen in our students'

exceptional results this year. Eight students achieved a fantastic 3A's in their A-level examinations, including 2 district toppers in Biosystems Technology and Physical Science. We are really proud of the effort that UK OBA and old Boys made to develop the scholarship programmes. We would like to thank the Principal, Staff, Parents and especially Students for the hard work and effort they have put in to achieve the grades.

Though we are increasingly taking steps to become a formidable academic school, our school has always prided itself in its cricketing abilities. Hence, it is also important for us to support our sports teams to achieve winning results. The UK OBA arranged matches for our U19 team with four of the top Division 1 school teams from Colombo and covered the expenses. These four schools were Royal College, Nalanda College, Mahanama College and St. Anthony's College. The main purpose is to train and prepare our boys for the all-important matches such as the Big Match against St. Johns. It will also help to rebuild the traditional connections with schools across Sri Lanka.

The dream of buying a bus for our school started in 2004 when the JCC UK OBA collected £5000 and put it in a fixed deposit. That interest was used for transportation purposes. Then in 2019, Jaffna OBA re-ignited the passion for this bus project and collected Rs. 500,000. In 2020 the Bus Society was inaugurated and each batch collected funds. Last year, the UK OBA contributed a further £10,000 towards the Bus Society which allowed our school to buy a new Bus this year. On behalf of the UK OBA, I would like to thank all those who contributed funds to fulfil this great ambition.

I extend immense thanks, on behalf our UK OBA, to our sister organisation VOGA, UK for always rendering amazing support for us. Our joint event, such as the BBQ this year, has been a massive highlight. A special thanks to President Geetha and her Executive Committee members for their selfless dedication towards our association.

To help the longevity of our UK OBA, we have also focused on different avenues of our membership programme to recruit the children of our old students. In order to do this, we are organising group activities including our younger generation to participate in our OBA activities.

We could not achieve these Goals without tremendous support by Old Boys and Friends of our School. I sincerely THANK YOU ALL for your support and assistance to walk through this journey. I wish you all a pleasant and enjoyable evening.



Sports Merit of JCC OB&GA UK 2022



2022 is another unique year for our OBA to excel in sports. Central Teams (representing our OBA) always shine in their respective sports wherever they participate since our OBA was inaugurated in 1987.

Former young stars, now veteran sensations, are still going strong in Cricket and Football. FOC champions from 1990 till 1994, TSSA 1st Cricket champions in 1992, TSSA 1st football champions in 1993, then during the years, we won several championships of TSSA in the open and in over-40 age group at Cricket tournaments.

Following the same achievement path, our over-50 team won the 1st age group tournament this year at TSSA, another milestone. 



Educational Merit of JCC OB&GA UK 2022

This year our committee set out on achieving three main goals academically: an O-Level scholarship programme, an A-Level scholarship programme and accessible e-learning re-sources. We deemed this incredibly important in order to attract top students across the dis-trict, now and in years to come, which will help Central become an academic force to be reckoned with.

GCE O/L Scholarship Programme

The top 30 O-Level students in the year were awarded a monthly scholarship of Rs. 3000 for their educational expenses. In order to determine the O-Level scholarship programme awardees, the top 12 students from the overall year along with the top 3 children from each of the 6 divisions were selected on a merit basis. This scholarship programme was started in June earlier this year to support students prepare for their upcoming exams. The success



of this programme has meant that we will endeavour to carry this on every year.

GCE A/L Scholarship Programme

For A-Level students the JCC UK OBA are organising a scholarship programme alongside the Pon. Vipulananthan Memorial Scholarship that is sponsoring 13 current students by the JCC 1987 A-Level


batch, to bring in another 10 O-Level students with top results (6As or more) from other schools to Central to study for their A-Levels. They will receive Rs. 7,000 a month for 28 months and will therefore be receiving Rs. 196,000 each for their educational ex-penses. Therefore, the JCC UK OBA will be providing a total of Rs. 1.96 Million support this coming year for our A-Level batch. We are



able to run these scholarship programmes based on generous donations and I would therefore like to thank all those that contributed, especially Agash Sivalingam who kindly donated £5000 towards these initiatives. The goal of these scholarship programmes is to grow them year on year to bring glory to our Alma Ma-ter.

Achievements

The importance of focusing and rewarding academic achievement has been seen in our stu-dents' exceptional results this year. Eight students achieved a fantastic 3A's in their A-level examinations, including 2 district toppers in Biosystems Technology and Physical Science. We are really proud that the effort the UK OBA and old boys have put into creating scholarship programmes has helped. We would like to thank the Principal, staff, parents and students for the hard work and effort they have put in to achieve this.





E-Learning Resources

Whilst the scholarship programmes provide more short term plans to get good results year on year, the idea of creating e-learning resources is our long term plan to make educational resources accessible to all students regardless of their financial backgrounds. This initiative, started by Mr Raviraj, was begun last year but was unfortunately disrupted due to the dis-turbed economic and political climate in Sri Lankan. We look forward to working on it again without disruptions next year. We plan to collate e-learning modules on an online library that will allow students to access these at home and school in order to recap topics they may be struggling with, in their own time. This online library will also include access to past papers and teaching materials from different masters allowing children to learn topics in an understandable and personalised manner, at their own pace. We believe this will provide a huge academic boost to Central students across all ages and will help achieve our over-arching goal of getting all Centralites a place at university, thereby, doing our Alma Mater proud and raising its educational standard.



The path of our Journey



The Jaffna Central College, which is two centuries old and the best school in Jaffna. produced many intellectual, professional experts and athletes regardless of caste race and religion. Even today we remember

with joy and gratitude that our parents admitted us in Jaffna Central College abbreviated as JCC amid many sacrifices and paved for us to walk in the society with a proud that we are Centralities.

While we were in our school, we were Flying like a free birds enjoying freedom and happiness without any worries. The deadly civil war trimmed our wings and made us to flee from our home land like nomads. Though our hearts were filled with worries due to loss of our friend's circle, I am happy to say that the Eternal experiences we gained at JCC remains as a driving force to rise up as phoenix birds.

As the way, the time moves so fast. But the unforgettable memories of Central college rooted firmly in our hearts are forever.

It was a pathetic situation that the school which has 200 years old history and had the school bus first in the north now doesn't have a bus, while other smaller schools owning the school buses on their own. This motivated some of our old boys in London to buy a bus for our Alma mater in the year 2004 In order to resolve this issue, they attempt to buy a new bus for school was carried forward by connecting with our alumni from other countries under one umbrella through LOBA. But unfortunately their efforts didn't turned out fruitful and that old boys from London only manage to collect around 1.1 million Sri Lankan Rupees which was not sufficient to buy a bus. Therefore they decided to donate that collected amount of Rs.1.1 million to JCC oba Jaffna and invest that in a fixed deposit and utilise

the interest to meet the cost of hiring bus for school. But the loyal members of JOBA especially Solomon, Rajavarothaym, kapilanesan, Nishaharan, ketheesan, Rev. Fr. Roshan and few others the then office bearers of JOBA were not happy by not owning the school bus.

The lack of school bus made them frustrated with a great concern and triggered them to initiate the bus project again in 2018 As a part of the project, they drew a proposal which was sent by them to the JCC Alumni association of all countries As they did not get proper response from respective global alumni, the Jaffna Old Students Association started self-funding by depositing Rs.50,000/= donated by then vice president Mr Rajavarothaym as initial deposit.which slowly swayed and stopped with Rs 500,000/= after amidst many hurdles.

At the same period, 1988 batch friends had a get together in 2019, March in Jaffna. This is the period of Big Match 2019 too. JCC Jaffna Alumni Association and some old students in 1988 batch, whom are keen in buying bus for school had a productive discussions and decided to form a club or trust or association to buy and maintain the bus.

At that period lots of old boys from around the globe visited Jaffna for big match At the same time an anti bus propagandas also actively went through by posted in social medias and by phone calls to one to one by some old boys. Therefore We have planned to identify the old boys whom are really have an idea to buy a bus for school. As a part of this identification campaign, Annadurai, Poongundran and Jameel of 1988 batch, met Nivas of 1989 batch, at his residence. who had visited Jaffna at that time, In this meeting Mr.Niyas infused confidence that their batch will give full cooperation to buy a bus and also he suggested to collect the fund in a batch basis and he opined that our journey will be meaningful if we connect all batches to gether under one umbrella.

Based on his advice, our efforts were started again in association with the JCC OBA Jaffna. At the same time, the members of 1988 batch whom are willing to buy a bus for the school gathered together by Mr Jameel, the current president of JCC Bus Society limited able to collect Rs.7 lakhs Sri lankan rupees few weeks. This Gives us hope foreseeable. In such a situation, we formed a what'sapp group and absorbed few people as founders who are willing of buying a bus. Various discussions analytical steadies, field studies were held with the representatives of Jaffna Old Students Association and the Principal of Jaffna Central College to find out where we made a mistake to gather old boys under on umbrella. Finally we found the secret of success.

That are transparency, accountability, dependability, responsibility and efficiency and especially batch basis representation which gave us massive morale support. As soon as we found the reasons of fail, we started to work for drawing constitution and register the association as a legal organisation. This responsibility went through few people and finally came to me. But process of forming an organisation legally was not easy as thought. There are so many legality and restrictions to register a new welfare organisations in Sri Lanka. Also it was a pandemic lock down. No chance of meeting an officials directly. All the work should have been done by online or by phone. All the departments directed me post to pullers. Finally with the blessing of God, friends, the Jaffna Alumni Association and the Principal, the mile stone of The JCC history "JCC bus society" was formed in accordance with the legislative drafts of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

All the old boys who are willing to buy the bus were absorbed as a member irrespectively to the country or alumni In this system called bus society. A legally registered JCC Bus Society created a sense of hope transparency and trust among the old students and made them to come forward by themselves to joined under one umbrella for the noble task.

The formation of the society with all the freshness of the idea for purchasing a bus for the school achieved in a very short period of three months, joined hands with several batches were raised the fund of approximately 10 million rupees. Thanks to the generosity of donors. The school today has an air-conditioned luxury bus with permanently secured parking space and permeant office with All facilities inside the school premises. In this journey we cannot forget the participation of JCC old boys and girls association London (LOBA) Not only initiated and involved in the initial fund collection of Rs. 1.1 million for the purchase of the bus, which was been deposited to JOBA account and later transferred to Bus Society account, but also contributed a substantial amount of £ 15,000 collected from many batches of alumni and deposited it in the Bus society account. "Old is always gold". We greatfuly remember and salute our senior old boy and well wisher of our Alma mater Mr. Vairamuthu Nadarajah (85 years) Jcc. 1957 batch from UK and a member of LOBA, who made Rs 50,000/= SL rupees as first ever deposit to Bus Society Savings account. No end for the relationship between LOBA and JCC Bus Society limited. Still the the LOBA closely associated with us.

I as a Public Relations Secretary of JCC Bus Society limited having a great pleasure of exploring the journey of our new bus in your 35 th year Celebrations Congratulations LOBA for your 35 year success and may almighty shower his blessings upon you to go further. We salute all the gentlemen of JCC.

9A Scholarship Programme Run by JCC Jaffna OBA for A/L From 2018.

In 2018, the JCC Jaffna OBA decided upon an initiative to further the support for students academically via the "9A Scholarship Programme". This involved supporting a student who got 9As in O/L 2018 until their A/L 2021 by covering their full tuition fees and educational expenses by imbursing them with Rs.5000.00 for 28 months. This scholarship valued Rs140000.00 was kindly sponsored by Mr.K.Kalavannan (UK). As a result of the help of this scholarship, the student achieved 3A's with a district rank 4 and qualified to study Medicine at the University of Colombo.

This successful initiative was furthered in 2019 with Dr.S.Sabeel and Mr.R Rajeevan from the UK sponsoring two students who got 9As in O/L 2019. These students received the same support as the student from the prior year with each scholarship valuing Rs.140000.00 to supporting them until their A/L 2022. Due to these scholarships, both students have qualified for places to study at university in the field of engineering and science which is a great success. Alongside this, the incentive of scholarships and the increased general support led to eight students from our A/L 2022 batch achieving 3As which is a milestone we are proud of in Central history after a very long time.

The successes of these programmes led to increased support the following year. The Pon.Vipulananthan Memorial Scholarship was begun by JCC 1987 A/L batch which sponsored thirteen students including 3 students who achieved 9As in O/L 2020. Three new tablets were also awarded to the 3 students who achieved 9As by the JCC 1987 A/L batch. On top of this, the value of each scholarship was increased to Rs.196000.00 as a result of imbursing the students with Rs.7000.00 for 28 months. In order to commemorate this momentous occasion, Vice-Chancellor of the University of Vavuniya participated and opened the scholarship programme as chief guest.

These scholarship programmes have proved a massive success and have helped bolster the academic attainment of students at Central. Excitingly, the Committee of the Pon.Vipulananthan Memorial Scholarship has decided to provide fifteen students who get good results from JCC in O/L 2021 with scholarships. Alongside this, JCC OBA-UK has decided to provide scholarships for 10 students who get good results (6As or more) in O/L 2021 from outside of Central such that good students from other schools are incentivised to join Central and help make our Alma Mater proud. With this being one of the biggest scholarship initiatives a school has organised, we look forward to continuing academic successes over the coming years.
