Life Changing All Island Tamil Community A/Level Scholarship Funding by UK OBA (Rs 2.05m/£5,200) over 12 months)

Project Description

Launched in 2022, as the first in Jaffna District, the aim of the scholarship Scheme is to help gifted children from disadvantaged families in Sri Lanka, to have a good education. UK OBA sees good education as a way of transforming not just the child, but also uplifting their family, Tamil Community, and ultimately the Country as a whole.

The Scheme has as its target academically gifted children from disadvantaged families in Sri Lanka, who are at risk of dropping off the education, or not entering higher education and settling for low paid jobs thus perpetuating poverty.

The Scholarship Scheme provides the Old Boys of Jaffna Central College with a simple and effective channel for 'putting something back' and contributing to this life changing endeavour. Each student being offered a scholarship by receiving monthly Rs 7000 rupees for their education expenses and monthly Rs 10,000 rupees each for their Hostel fees payable to school.

This was only made possible by investing Rs 2.25m(£5.6k) to renovate the Rigg Hall Hostel.

Key achievements so far

UK OBA was successful in bringing 16 gifted students to study A/Levels from all parts of the country.

A point to note that the best results for this batch at Jaffna Central College was 8A's for the O/Level exams but we managed to bring 2 students with 9A's and 2 students with 8A's.





Long-Term Impact & UK OBA Strategy



We would like to change the educational standard of JCC to match with other leading schools in Jaffna. Increasing the number of students going to university will be a game changer for our college. The UK OBA is planning to increase the scholarship student numbers around 30 by the Oct 2025 intake.

O/Level Scholarship Funding by UK OBA Rs 1.08m (£3,000) over 12 months

In 2022, UK OBA introduced a major drive to uplift the O/Level results in our school.

The new scholarship programme for students taking their delayed GCE O/Level exam in May 2023. The top 30 best students in the year were awarded a scholarship. The process will work with us selecting the top 12 children from the overall year along with the top 3 children from each of the six divisions making up the remaining 18 children. Each student being offered a scholarship by receiving monthly Rs 3000 for their education expenses. This scholarship program is purely based on merit basis and the selection process was managed by the principal and the UK OBA Educational team. Total contribution from July 2022-May 2023 was 1.08 million Sri Lankan Rupees.

For the next batch (2024 exam intake) 10 students have been selected from purely merit basis and the remaining 20 students will be selected from all the divisions as an inclusive scholarship for all students. This will help to increase the level of exam results for underachieving students as well as the students currently getting average marks to get the best results. This includes special paper classes for all students sitting the O/Level exams with e-leaning materials provided by "E-Kalvi".

Empowering JCC students with digital skills (E- Learning), UK OBA is fostering a knowledge-based society at Jaffna Central - Rs1.86m/£4,600 over 12 months.

Project Description

As a substantial initiative to enhance digital literacy in Jaffna Central, UK OBA have started to expedite the implementation of a project aimed at establishing modern computer labs and smart classrooms in Jaffna Central. The initiative also reflects the shared vision of both the School and the OBA to empower the students through digital literacy, thereby paving the way for a brighter future. The main ceremony took place on March 16, 2023, in the presence of renowned JCC old boy emeritus Cambridge scholar **Dr Kirubarajan** (Professor at McMaster University Canada).

The project, funded by UK OBA, is designed to enhance digital skills (E Learning) to JCC students. It involves the installation of computer labs and the development of customized curriculum software for all students. Main breakthrough is the collaboration with **E-Kalvi global**, A major player in providing digital educational materials to schools in need across Northern, Eastern, and upcountry of Sri Lanka. This initiative is a testament to the power of UK OBA's collaboration in fostering educational advancement and digital literacy at JCC.





Key achievements so far 350 E-Kalvi USB 's (Rs 550,000) with teaching materials were provided to O-Level and A-Level students.



UK OBA Also donated 14 laptops (Rs 964,247) to be used for computer lab and Hostel students.







Hostel Students were provided enhanced WIFI connection with computer room setup with laptops for use.



Also, UK OBA also Donated a Printer and printing materials (Rs 350,000) to be used for O/Level & A/Level paper classes. This will be a great addition to the school. This was donated by Jaffna OBA on behalf of UK OBA on 9th April 2023 post the AGM of Jaffna OBA as a start of a new relationship with UK OBA & New Jaffna OBA committee selected at the last AGM.



Long-Term Impact & UK OBA Strategy

As part of the UK OBA's strategy of Empowering JCC students with digital skills (E-Learning) the E-Kalvi USB scheme will be extended from Grade 6 to Grade 10 students for the next stage and then to Primary School students.





Dr. Ahilan University Scholarships managed by UK OBA

(Funds Deposited Rs 3.55m - Rs 180,000 paid students over 12 months)

Project Description

This project is to help the University students who enter the university from Jaffna Central College. This scholarship was initiated by UK OBA with the financial support from Dr Ahilan. We remain so grateful to Dr Ahilan for undertaking this noble cause. Currently following funds deposited in Sri Lanka.

Rs 2.75m deposited with Jaffna OBA earning an interest of Circa Rs 330,000.00 per year Rs 0.8m deposited with Colombo OBA earning an interest of Circa Rs 96,000.00 per year.


Key achievements so far: Following students are the recipients of the Scholarships.

Increasing the number of students going to university will be a game changer for JCC as well as changing lives of the disadvantaged students and their families. The strategy is to offer a full package of scholarships for any bright students joining for O/Level at Jaffna Central will receive financial help from the UK OBA scholarships all the way until them completing the university studies. This will change their future prospects as well as their dependents.

Based on the current interest rates for fixed deposits in Sri Lanka with annual interest receipts of Rs 426,000 this will be extended to 7 students from July 2024.






Renovation of Rigg Hall Hostel at JCC by UK OBA (Rs 2.25m/£5,618)

The refurbishment of Rigg Hall Hostel has now been completed, with the

Principal Mr Indrakumar cutting the ribbon to re-open the hostel on 24 March 2023, alongside UK OBA committee members and Jaffna based old boys.

The re-opening marks the culmination of a project which commenced when 14 members of the current committee members visited the school during Big match and seen the terrible condition of the hostel facilities through their own eyes. This is the first time in the history of UK OBA so many members visited Jaffna at the same time. As parents of our own children and old boys of our Alma mater, we felt to take the responsibility towards the young students living in the hostel. All members agreed to take immediate action regarding the renovation of the Hostel. we are delighted with the results of the work and the hostel is currently used by scholarship recipients from UK OBA in both educational and sports categories.















Long-Term Impact

Ultimately the hostel will be able to accommodate up to 50 students annually. This represents a long-term investment by the UK OBA for the future of Jaffna Central College.

The goal is to attract more talented students from disadvantaged background across Sri Lanka and change their life's.

When the time for the "big match" arrives, alumni from around the world eagerly anticipate our team's performance, hoping for a triumphant victory. It's no easy feat, given the weight of tradition and history that shows how both colleges have fiercely battled to secure wins or salvage matches. Being part of this long-standing historical event, known as the "Big Match" or "Battle of North" is a source of immense pride for both teams and their alumni.

Monitoring and Addressing Challenges

The UK Old Boys and Girls Association (UK OB&GA) diligently monitored the circumstances and teams in recent years. Drawing upon the wisdom of past cricketers and alumni, we identified various challenges and sought solutions. We are delighted to announce our current UK OBA committee consist of six proud Under 19 cricket Captains of our school in the history.

1. Equipping Our U19 Cricket Team

Our U19 Cricket team faced a unique challenge. While we were competing in Sri Lankan Schools Cricket Division 3 Tier A, the St. John's played in Division 2 Tier A. Our teams faced different levels of opponents, with ours considered weaker. To level the playing field and enhance our players' experience, we organised and sponsored matches against several prominent teams in the island:

Nalanda College, Colombo – 1st division (Home game)
St Anthony's College, Kandy – 1st division (Away game)
Trinity College, Kandy – 1st division (Away game)
Mahanama College, Colombo – 1st division (Home game)
Badulla District Schools selected team (3 days home game)
Centralities Sports Club (3 days home game)

We had also arranged additional matches, but due to unforeseen circumstances, we couldn't fulfil these fixtures:

Royal College, Colombo (Clashed with SL School's fixture) Maliyadeva College, Kurunagala (Ecological reasons)

These games provided our players with invaluable experience, both mentally and physically, in dealing with high-pressure situations against stronger teams. This not only improved their cricketing skills but also fostered friendly relations and camaraderie with other schools in South and Central Sri Lanka. We extend our heartfelt thanks to Mr. Ranjithkumar from Colombo, a cherished alumnus of JCC, who facilitated these matches, and our School's POG Mr Kingsley and the school administration for their steadfast support for the UK OBA.





2. Sponsorship of Tournament Participation

Our commitment to U19 Cricket team's development extended to covering all expenses incurred during their journey to success, including:

50 Overs Sri Lanka Cricket U19 Tournament (Our team reached the Semi-Finals).
2 days Sri Lanka Cricket Tournament (They became Champions and were promoted to Division 2).

The total cost of items 1 and 2, covered by our UK OBA, amounted to Rs. 2,116,828.







3. Motivation Classes Ahead of the Big Match 2023

Recognising the need to fortify the mental resilience of our U19 players, we organised motivation classes before the Big Match in 2023. These sessions aimed to equip the players with the resilience to face the high-pressure environment and perform exceptionally. This not only prepares them for the Big Match but also equips them to participate in competitive tournaments and face strong opponents.

Our esteemed alumnus and professional motivator,

Mr. Janarthanan (Jana), generously volunteered to run these mental awareness and motivation classes. These sessions were initiated and sponsored by our UK OBA, and we extend our sincere thanks to Jana. We are committed to continuing this as an ongoing initiative for the years to come.

The expenses were covered by our OBA and amounted to Rs. 24,250.

4. Continued Contribution to Sports Excellence
