Local and General.

Cambridge Local Examination.

From the published list of successful candidates in these examinations we find that T. N. Nathanael, son of Pastor Nathanael of Manepay, has taken Honours in the 11th class, with distinction in mathematics, in the Senior examination, and that C. Arasaratnam of St. Patrick's College has passed the same examination. From the Girl's English High School Vembadi, Miss F. G. N. Tampoe, daughter of T. M. Tampoe, Esq. Magistrate, passed the Senior and Miss J. C. M. Trimmer, daughter of the Rev. G. J. Trimmer, the Junior examination.

Colombo Y. M. C. A. The General Secretary Mr. Louis Hieb has gone with his family to America on furlough. He will be much missed in Colombo and in Jaffna as well. He was a hardworking man who did much for the welfare of the young men of Ceylon. Mr. R. D. Prince, formerly Secretary of the Bombay Association, is to be Secretary in his absence. We welcome Mr. Fringle to Ceylon and hope he will see the Associations prospering under his oversight. Subscriptions for a new building to be erected on the Raguet Court at an estimated cost of Rs. 75,000, have been solicited and those sent in before Mr. Hieb's departure amounted to over Rs. 17,000. The plan is to raise Rs. 25,000 in Ceylon and the rest in England and America. We wish all success to the undertaking.

Obituary. Dr. Edward Chester, the Senior Missionary of the American Madura Mission died at his home in Dindigul March 26th. Dr. Chester first came to the mission field in 1859 and thus for more than forty-two years he has labored for the good of the people of India. He exerted a great influence throughout the District, and benefited the people much through his dispensaries and his medical teaching.

Matrimonial. At Batticaloa Church on the 31st ultimo the marriage of Miss S. K. Watson, a niece of Mr. Salvadorat Nevis, Principal Hindu College with Mr. R. Domastany of Messrs P. Orr and Sons, Colombo was solemnized by the Rev. B. H. Rice.

New Proctors. We have to welcome Messrs. G. N. H. Tampoe and C. Thambayah who have taken their oaths of allegiance and office to practise as Proctors in Jaffna.

The Port Surgeon of Knits. Dr. Sittampalam of the Civil Hospital, Colombo has assumed duties as Port Surgeon of Knits in the place of Dr. Jeremiah who has been transferred to Mihinale.

Silver Medal. In the first year's examination of the Ceylon Medical College, Mr. S. A. Vairakame came out first in the first division and thus won the silver medal.

Personal. Dr. W. G. Rockwood and daughter Mrs. Thiruvannarasu will proceed to England for about the 20th inst. and it is reported here that Mr. Thiruvannarasu will act as Tamil member in the Legislative Council during Dr. Rockwood's absence in England.

Mr. T. H. Kershaw has been appointed as the Attorney General of Ceylon. He comes from the Malay States where he has been the legal adviser.

Mr. Wouters Police Magistrate at Kails, returned to Kails on the 7th inst. from his official trip to the Island of Delft.

Messrs. C.B. Bell and W. R. Cooke left Jaffna on the 3rd inst. the former to join the Uduvassalawa Railway and the latter for a few weeks change and rest at Nawara Eliya.

Sports. A cricket match will come off at Mannar, between the Jaffna and Mannar cricketers. The Jaffna eleven captained by Inspector Perkins will start for Mannar on the 12th inst. and the play will be on the 14th inst. which is proclaimed a public Holiday.

Jaffna Katcheri news. The Govt. Agent, Mr. R. W. Lewis has gone to Delft and from there, it is said, he will proceed to Colombo in time to see the Governor off for England. The Jaffna District Judge, Mr. R. B. Sanders will act as Govt. Agent for three weeks until Mr. J. S. Lewis returns to Jaffna to relieve him. Mr. Lewis will remain in Colombo and do duty as Colonial Secretary until the return of His Excellency to the Island.

Commercial Corporation Ltd. The Directors of this company met on the 7th inst. It has been sanctioned to open agencies at Pt. Pedro and Chavagacheri, chiefly for the sale of cotton goods.

The Jaffna Agricultural Association. The Delegates appointed by the shareholders, have returned from their trip of selection, and from a neat ketch prepared by Mr. M. Rajasooriar, agent of the company, showing the places they visited and the sites they noted for the recommendation of the Directors, a patient and arduous work appears to have been done by the delegates. A meeting of the directors was held on the 7th inst. for the consideration of the report of the delegates.

Jaffnese in South Africa. Mr. Thomas Paul and Mr. C. Ariyanayagam (Photographer) who were employed in South Africa for the last five years have returned to South Manipay, their native place. At the early stage of the War several battles took place very near to their station.
