The launch of the new reprint of the first and second parts of 'History of Ceylon', a seminal work on the history of Sri Lanka, took place on the 24th July 2015 at the Senate Room of University of Kelaniya. The work, 'University of Ceylon: History of Ceylon', was published by the University of Ceylon and this is its Sinhala translation by the Vidyalankara University's Research Unit.

The event was held under the auspices of the Chancellor of the University of Kelaniya, the most venerable Aggamaha Panditha Velamitiyawe Dharmakeerthi Sri Kusaladhammabidhana thero and the Vice-Chancellor of the university. Inauguration ceremony of the International Workshop on Molecular Biology Techniques Related Infectious/Genetic Diseases & Human Identification was held on 06th July 2015 at the Molecular Medicine Unit, Faculty of Medicine, Ragama. Prof. Sunanda Madduma Bandara, the Vice Chancellor of the University of Kelaniya was the Chief Guest of the event. Prof. Nilanthi de Silva. Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, Prof. M.J.S. Molecular biology has become an important field in almost all disciplines of life sciences, especially in medicine and there is a rapid development of related technologies applicable to medical sciences. Therefore, objective of conducting this workshop was to provide an extensive training in

some of these tools and techniques especially those used in the field of infectious and genetic diseases and also in human identification. Fifteen, professionals from the ICGEB member status and 6 local scientists participated the workshop, Latest advances in molecular diagnostics (applicable to infectious, genetic and blood disorders), human DNA fingerprinting and production and purification of recombinant enzymes/antibodies (for molecular diagnostics) and human identification were covered by the workshop. Lectures with hands on experience covering above areas were delivered in the workshop by experienced professionals. The experience gained by this workshop will undoubtedly be helpful for participants to improve their laboratories.

The sponsors of this workshop were the International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (ICGEB) and the Research Council of the University of Kelaniya. This workshop was held from 06th July to 17th July 2015.




The Annual General Meeting of the Alumni Association of the University of Kelaniya

Another Step in Reaching the Peak... Human Resources Development

Every organisation regardless of it's being a government or private is responsible for developing its Human Resources for making the best use of it. University of Kelaniya as a result of correctly recognising this national need is investing on developing its human resources without solely depending on public funds. While the allocated public funds are being used, self-raised funds are also mostly used for several projects aiming at enhancing the quality of life of its staff and students.

An Insurance Scheme for Academic and Non-academic Staff

The absence of an insurance scheme for the university staff was a long felt need although there had been many efforts in the history that were not came to an end. However now it possess a wellstructured insurance scheme offered by Sri Lanka Insurance Corporation with attractive benefits, Kelaniya University Teachers' Association (KUTA) with the support of the Vice-Chancellor took a very determinant initiative for establishing this. First it was proposed only for the academic staff but later on as suggested by the Vice- Chancellor it was open for non-academic staff too. After several rounds of discussions with many insurance firms finally the Sri Lanka Insurance Cooperation, the most reliable insurance giant in the industry by being a government organisation offered a



scheme with attractive benefits on which the university agreed upon. "This is the first time among the Sri Lankan universities which was able to launch an insurance scheme with an outside reliable insurance firm, we are proud to be your insurance partner and now we can use your university as a benchmark in persuading other universities to buy insurance" was mentioned by Mr. Deepal Nawagamuwa, Regional Sales Manager, Sri Lankan Insurance at the insurance policy awarding ceremony held at the university premises. In addition, most importantly university partially funds academic both and non-academic staff's annual insurance instalments while the rest is

borne by the individuals. This is open not only for the university employees themselves but their families too.

Welfare Fund for Internal Students

There is also a Welfare Fund maintained by the university for its students. This fund is totally built up with the earned money of the university. The sole objective of establishing this fund is to financially support the students to uplift their levels of welfare at present. Students are eligible to receive financial aids whenever they met with accidents during academic sessions and also for any special surgeries and treatments recommended by the Chief Medical Officer the University

approved by the Council of the University. Further when students' deaths take place by natural causes or accidents family members are paid a financial allowance to support their funerals. These facilities provided by the university are greatly appreciated by the students as they are now aware that they have not been left out by the university whenever they struggle with uncertainties that would probably had led to discontinue their higher education.

Voluntary Fund for Staff and Students

Moreover, the university has established another voluntary fund to financially support academic and non-academic staff and students at a funeral. Both staff and students are paid a financial allowance of LKR 10,000.00. Academic and non-academic members are paid at anyone's death in their families while students are paid only when they lost one or both of their parents.

An MoU with Michigan State University, USA











A Memorandum of Understanding, which was initiated by the Department of Biochemistry and Clinical Chemistry, Faculty of Medicine, University of Kelaniya and College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Michigan State University, East Lansing, USA, was signed at the Vice Chancellor's office on 07th July 2015. The aim of this agreement was to foster international cooperation in education and research between the two institutions, specifically on developing nanotechnology based diagnostic tools for medical applications. MoU with Universidad De Sevilla, Spain









Kalana Mithuru Sevana - Student Counselling Unit University of Kelaniya

Emotional and psychological problems disturb academic achievements of students. The practice of student counselling at the University of Kelaniya was started in 1986. This can be recognised as marking of the establishment of student counselling within the Sri Lankan University system. This was initially operated under student welfare services and later was re-named as **KALANA MITHURU SEVANA** (KMS) which started to function as a separate unit since 02nd June 1998.

The primary purpose of the KMS is to promote a healthy environment for students of the University and enhance student learning. It facilitates and supports the mission of the University. KMS provides regular developmental, preventive, and therapeutic services to students. KMS empowers students with the knowledge, skills, attitudes and mind-set needed to identify their problems and to make the use of their own strengths and resources to solve problems by themselves.

The Unit offers confidential personal counselling to assist students through trained counsellors. Any student of the University may approach the KMS if they want to talk to someone about their problems.

The KMS also engages in programmes that promotes intellectual, emotional and social development of students and offers opportunities for personal development that will lead to enhanced learning. This would finally assist them to reach their potential academic goals through enhancing their psycho-social competencies and life skills. The Unit also organises induction and awareness programmes, workshops and guest seminars, as the major means of reaching the students community.

Prof. (Mrs) Mangalika Hettiarachchi (founding director of KMS-1998), Senior Professor, Department of Zoology and Environmental Management, had taken steps to develop the unit and served as the director from 2001 to 2014.

At present, Dr. Susima Weligamage, (Senior lecturer, Department of Finance - Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies), serves as the Director of the Counselling Unit and Ven.
