It is a splendid start in the way of the season's sales.—Two sessions.

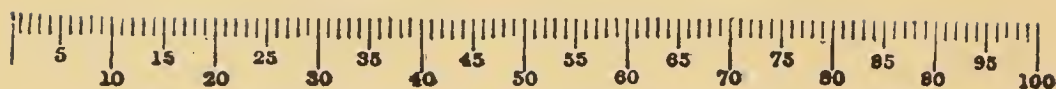

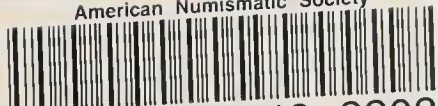
