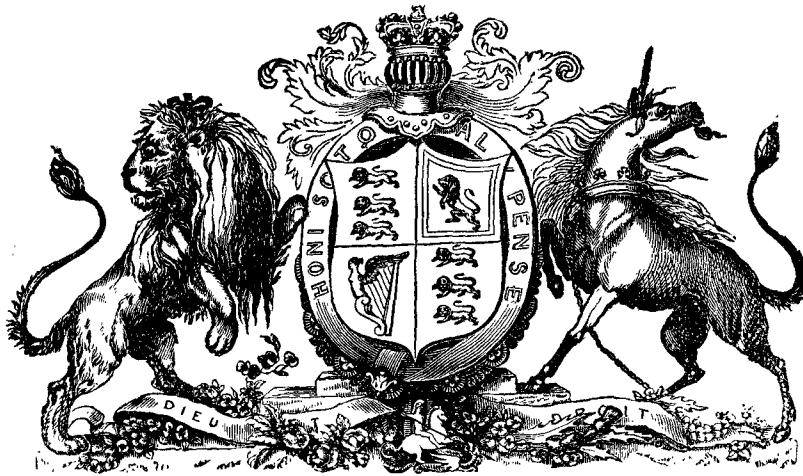

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NOTICES UNDER THE WASTE LANDS ORDINANCES.

Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring
Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Kahambiliyahenyaya, Batadombagahadeniyekuttiya, Olupeliyehena, &c., situate in the village of Horapawita in the Kandaboda pattuwa of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

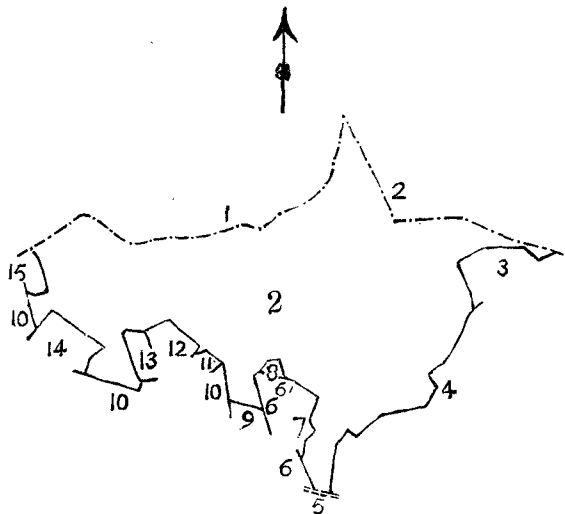

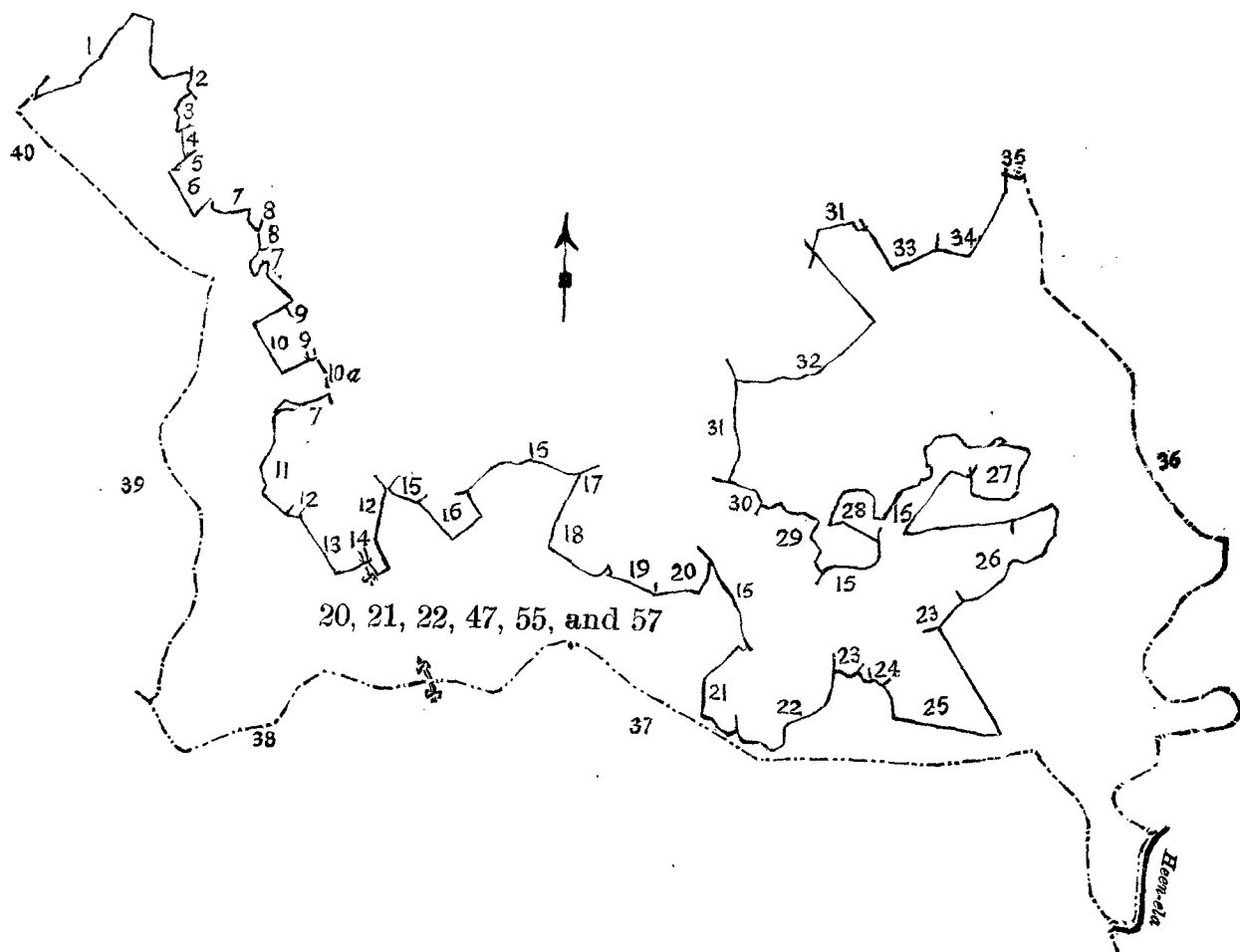
