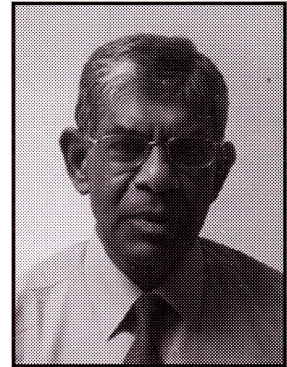


Message from the Chief Guest

THE RULES OF THE 7-A-SIDE FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT 2012

The success of the tournament depends on fair play, sportsmanship, co-operation and keeping with the spirit of the tournament. **Mahajana College OSA (U.K)** Organising Committee requests all Old School Associations (OSAs) / Tamil Schools (TS) / Clubs to respect and abide by the rules of the tournament. All teams are expected to report to the tournament committee (at the ground) on the day of the event not later than 9.00 **am**.

1. Eligibility

- 1.1** Players selected for the school team should have been attended their respective schools, or are children of former students as declared by the OSA's. or Members of the Club
- 1.2** A player shall not represent more than one OSA/Tamil School /club in an event.
- 1.3 UNDER 19:** Players selected for the teams must have been born **On or after 1st September 1992.**
- 1.4 UNDER 16:** Players selected for the teams must have been born **On or after 1st September 1995.**
- 1.5 UNDER 14:** Players selected for the teams must have been born **on or after 1st September 1997.**
- 1.6 UNDER 12:** Players selected for the teams must have been born **on or after 1st September 1999.**
- 1.7 Over 40:** Players selected for the teams must have been born **on or before 1st September 1972.**

2. Identification and Proof-of-Age:

On request of the tournament committee all **Mahajana** (UK) Challenge Cup participants must be able to identify themselves by the following:-

- 1) Age Declaration form or
- 2) Current Passport or
- 3) Valid drivers licence (applicable to Over-40s)

N.B: Citizen Card will not be accepted.

3. Team

- 3.1** Each Team should submit a list of maximum of **Twelve** players for their team to any of the Mahajana tournament committee at least 15 minutes before the time of kick-off.
- 3.2** If there is a clash of colours the team drawn second shall change strip (bibs acceptable)

- 3.3** No person may play for more than one (OSA/Tamil School / club) team except for **under-12, under-14, under-16, under-19** for which **Rule 3.4** below shall apply.
- 3.4** Under 14 or Under 16 or Under 19 or Adult teams may draft up to **three** additional Substitutes from their Under 12, Under 14, Under 16, & Under 19 teams respectively, with the following restrictions:
- i) Such substitutions must not interfere with the tournament schedule.
 - ii) Under **no** circumstances may **under-12** team players play for **under-16** team, **under-19** or **Adult** team and **under-14** team players play for Under 19 or **Adult** team.

4 Substitution of Players:

4.1 Only players whose names appear on the Official Team List will be allowed.

4.2 Teams wishing to substitute a player shall:

- a) Bring to the attention of the **Mahajana** tournament committee who is in charge of the ground, where the match is being played that they wish to substitute a player.
- b) Supply the **Mahajana** tournament committee the shirt number/name of the player to be substituted.

4.3 Method of Substitution:

- a) The **Mahajana** tournament committee will draw the attention of the match referee of the intended substitution.
- b) A substitute player shall enter the field of play only on indication by the referee.
- c) Any player entering the field of play without the indication of the match referee will be appropriately penalised by the referee.
- d) A player who has been substituted (player who comes out) during a game will not be allowed to take part further in any part of the game.

5. Match

5.1 A preliminary round will be played on a All-Play-All basis.(Teams in each group play each other in that group.)

5.2 If any team in a group of **TWO** fails to turn up, Team three from the nearest group of **THREE** will be substituted for them.

5.3 Duration of the match is as follows:

Preliminary rounds:	10 - 3 - 10 minutes
Quarter Finals	10 - 3 - 10 minutes
Semi Finals	10 - 3 - 10 minutes
Final :	15 - 5 - 15 minutes

5.4 The game will be played under normal FA law except that;

- a) There shall be **no offside.**
- b) Maximum of three substitutes will be allowed for each match.

c) If a player is sent off from the field by the referee he cannot be replaced for the match and he cannot take part in the next match.

5.5 Points will be awarded as follows: **WIN 3 points, DRAW 1.**

5.6 If a team fails to turn up at the appointed playing pitch and time a “**WIN**” will be awarded to the opposing team present at the pitch. For the purpose of goal difference the game will be awarded the equivalent score to the absent team’s previous defeat or if not applicable a 3-0 **WIN** will be awarded.

6.0 Tie Group

6.1 In the event of teams having equal points, the following criteria will be applied to declare the winner.

Goal difference.(i.e. - number of goals by the team less number of goals against the team).

If not resolved

Highest number of goals scored in the group.

If not resolved

Highest number of goals out of three penalty kicks.

If not resolved

“Sudden death” penalty kicks.

If not resolved

“Toss of a coin”

7.0 General

7.1 The **Mahajana** football committee will be the sole adjudicators of the timing of matches and of penalties imposed. The captains/managers of each team should liaise with the football committee to confirm start times of their matches.

7.2 If the games are abandoned completely due to rain or for any other reason, there shall be no awarding of the **Mahajana** (UK) Challenge Cup.

7.3 The **Mahajana** football committee reserve the right to transfer or re-schedule games to another pitch from those allocated originally, if required.

8. ARBITRATION:

8.1 On the field of play the **REFEREES** ‘ decisions shall be final.

8.2 In the event of any dispute, or clarification of the rules of the tournament, the decision of the **Mahajana** Organising Committee shall be final..

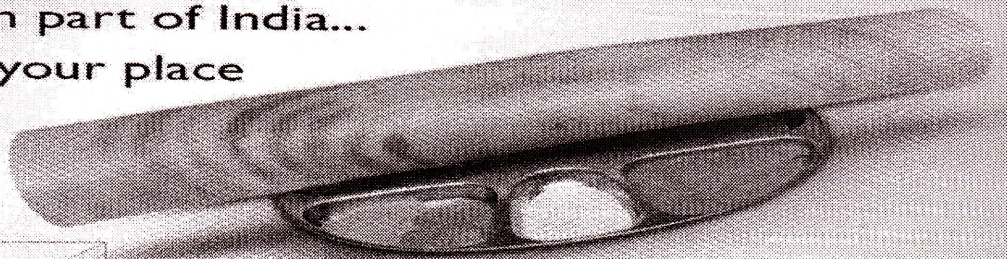
