

1. What is the meaning of the term "Swaha" used in Hindu religious rituals?

The term Swaha in Sanskrit refers to a true and correct action. Hence when offering of aahuti in havan kunda are performed according to Vedas with chanting Veda hymns and mantras it clearly infer that we are doing proper endeavour, the consequence of which will remain with us to save us from distress

The word Swaha furthermore delivers the concept that whatever is in our heart, the same is in our speech. The expression Swaha also demotes that we must not make use, any items or good entrusted in our custody by someone for our own purpose at any circumstances.

The axiom Swaha in addition means the purest views of heart and mind. So when the learned Rishis, perform the divine Yajyen chanting Veda mantras the end result is blessed by the Almighty.

2. What is ment by the Saptha rishis?

Atharva-veda mantra 9/9/2, 3, refers that the Saptha Rishis are two eyes, two ears, two nostrils and mouth, ancient rishis who studies Vedas, does yagya and after rigid performance of practice of ashtanga yoga attained Asampargyat Samadhi.

3. What is really the metal called 'ranga' used in Hindu rituals?

'Ranga' is not a metal but an alloy (combination of different metals) of tin (Sn), copper (Cu) and antimony (Sb)

4. What is the meaning of the phrase 'Sat Cit Ananda?

The meaning of the phrase Sachidananda is as follows; sat+ chetan+ anand which are explained as the three qualities of almighty God.

Sat-Cit-Ananda

Sat,"being" or "truth" emphasizes the unchanging nature of Brahman as pure unqualified existence precedes all other existences and experience so that the effect must be necessarily be carried within the preceding cause. Cit, "consciousness", emphasizes the conscious nature of Brahman experience;

Brahman is the ultimate way of knowing the self luminous essence of knowing which makes possible all other derivative experience. Ananda, 'bliss', which empathize the sublime value of the experience of Brahman.

Sat implies that which remains eternally, that is, in past, present, and future and cannot be ruined. Chetan represents aliveness.

Anand denotes that whose feature is of high spirits.

5. What is referred as the point of centre in the practice of meditation?

In the modus operandi of meditation there are three spots to concentrate to achive the goal. The meditator has the freedom to choose any one point at his own.

- i. Agya chakra which is between two eyebrows.
- ii. Tip of the nose (Nasagrae)
- iii. Heart

6. What is meant by the term gothra and the significance of it?

The meaning of the word 'gothra' is a passageway, family line, genealogy, pedigree descendants, family tree etc. where a learned acharya on whose name the line of path of gothra has been made. As for example, there was 'Kowdinya rishi' on whose name Kowdinya gothra stands. Manusmriti Sloka 3/5 narrates that the bridge who is away from the six generations of parents is only to be married to a bridegroom. Rigveda mantra 10/85/21 states that marriage of a bridegroom and a bride must not be performed within the same gothra. According to Rigveda Mantra 10/85/21 marriage should always be solemnized with girl from different gothra.

7. Is soul a separate entity or a part of God?

Soul is eternal and immortal and not a part of god.

8. How and when was Manusmriti written?

At the period of the establishment of the earth, the knowledge of the four Vedas initiated in the heart of four Rishis. They in turn passed this awareness to the Rishi Brahma. He later bestowed this knowledge to Manu. Thus the era Manusmriti was written narrates to the commencement of the earth.

Has anyone proved the transfer of a soul from one body to another scientifically? No one has so far has proved the transfer of a soul from one body to another scientifically. But there are numerous evidences to infer the reorganize of soul from one body to another

9. Do all Hindus really chant Vedas?

Normally religious practices are carried out in the temples and other religious sites and at homes of many Hindus. Learned devotees chant hymns of Vedas. Anyhow one could be a Hindu without being religious in any conservative, conventional or institutional sense or intelligence of the term. To be a Hindu is to be culturally, rather than religiously, considered or characterized in some way. A great number of Hindus down the centuries have in some way by passed the Veda in living their lives. Many Hindus have been, and are quite unfamiliar with those sacred utterances; they have never had a copy of Veda at home or read it from it

10. Where is the Bhagavadgita taken from?

The Bhagavadgita is from part of book 6 of Mahabharata, and in 18 sections of 700 verses, It explores first Arjuna's crises of consciences; and the philosophical explanations and advice of Lord Krishna.

11. What is the oldest Upanishad of the Sama Veda?

The oldest Upanishad of the Sama Veda is the lengthy and significant Chandogya Upanishad. Chandogy Upanishad is a prose composition and encompasses the last two sections of the Chandogya Brahmana, which runs to ten sections in all.

12. What is Gayatri mantra, where is it mentioned and give the simple empirical meaning of it?

Gayatri mantra is as follows; and this hymn is found Rig Veda 3.62:10

"Aum Bhur bhuvah svahah Tat savitur varenyam Bhargo Devasya dheemahi Dheeyo yonah prachodayaat" Path to Dharma -37- தர்ம நெறி - Sri Sankar Publications – January 2011-ஜனவரி(மார்கழி/தை) Aum, earth, atmosphere, heaven. Let us think on that desirable splendour of Savitr(the Inspirer). May he stimulate us to insightful thoughts.

As the Sun annihilates darkness, the Gayathri Mantra destroys ignorance. This Mantra invokes the power and radiance of the Sun to energize all earthly life, to destroy our sins and to reveal the Supreme Self to us. Lord Krishna says in the Bhagvad Geetha that "Amongst the Mantras, I am the Gayathri".

13. About what does the famous Kama Sutra describe?

The Kama Sutra is written in thirty six chapters under seven headings dealing with kama(sex) in the general sense of the enjoyable awareness that arises from 'hearing, (investigation) touch,(handling) sight,(displaying) taste,taste and smell in appropriate contact with their distinctive objects, controlled by the mind in conjunction with the spiritual Self

14. Is the source of Vishnu Sahasranama from Mahabharata?

The Vishnu Sahasranama, containing 142 verses is extracted from the Anusasanika Parva.. of the Mahabharata, in the dialogue between Bishma and Yudhisthira

15. Give an idea of the pattern of hymns of Rig Veda?

The 1028 hymns of the Rig Veda comprise about 10600 stanzas. The hymns 'contain on the average ten stanzas, generally of four verses or lines, but also of three and sometimes five-though particular hymns are longer, of course-the longest having 58 stanzas- and others shorter, with the shortest being only a stanza long-. The line, which is called Pada –quarter-and forms the metrical unit, usually consists of eight, eleven or twelve syllables. A stanza is, as a rule, made up of lines of the same type; but some of the rarer kinds of stanza are formed by combining lines of different length. There are about fifteen metres, but only about seven of these are at all common. By far the most common are the Tristubh (4x11 syllables), the Gayatri (3x8) and the Jagati(4x12), which together furnish two-thirds of the total number of stanzas in the Rig Veda. (Extract from; Macdonell 1971; xvii)

16. Give the meaning of Siva Sahasranama archana?

Siva Sahasranamam (Thousand names of Lord Siva)

There are many versions of Siva Sahasranama, out of which the one seen in Anushasanika Parva of Mahabharata is given below.

Vande pannaga bhooshanam mrugadharam, vande pasoonaam pathim,

Vande surya sasanka vahni nayanam, vande mukunda priyam,

Vande bhaktha janasrayam cha varadam, Vande shivam sankaram.

I salute who wears snake as ornament, Who caries a deer in his hand,
